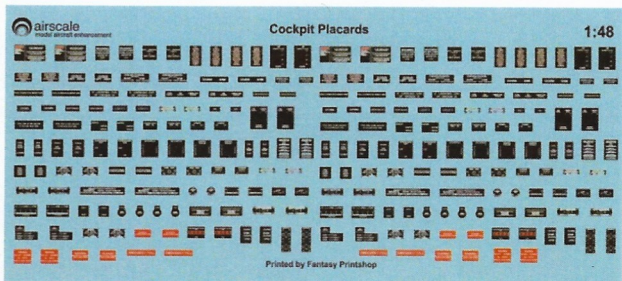


Cockpit Placard Decals

Generic: WW2 Allied Cockpit Placards

Scale: 1/48

Product: AS48 PLA



Individual Cockpit Dataplate decals in 1:48 scale are designed for kit, modified or scratchbuilt cockpits and represent many Placards and Dataplates found in aircraft serving with Allied air forces in WW2.

Suitable for both US and British aircraft these Dataplates are found throughout the cockpit instrument panel, sidewalls and ancillary equipment such as Radio's, Throttle & Flap quadrants and Oxygen or Air cylinders.

Instructions

Cut out decals one at a time as required using a sharp blade.

Soak airscales decals in water to use.

Tips: Mount directly onto kit or scratchbuilt parts. Decals adhere better to gloss surfaces. If required, use decal setting solution to adhere to raised details. Test fit to ensure alignment. Cut out or trim decals using a very sharp blade to avoid tearing. Store decals in a dark, dry place.

Placards and Dataplates Included:



General Warnings

Airframe limitation notices to warn against performing actions at speed e.g. opening Bomb Doors, lowering Landing Gear, opening Cowl Flaps etc.



Notices

Instructions or switch position indicators or markings relating to adjacent instruments



Dataplates

Labels attached to airborne equipment; generally indicating item type, version and serial or re-order information



Specific Warnings

Guidance to avoid damage to airframe, pilots or ground crew



Labels

Reference points to instruments, equipment or ancillaries
