

■ IDF M113 ZELDA ARMORED PERSONNEL CARRIER

Highly modified to IDF official and often unofficial requirements, the Zelda starts its life as a standard M-113 APC, but soon takes on an identity all its own and sometimes highly personal as befits an armored vehicle carrying a woman's name, Zelda.

The IDF employs thousands of M-113 Zeldas as fighting machines, to transport troops, service the other armored units and be a universal do-all to the army.

If you review all the available pictures of Zeldas in action, it is difficult to find any two that look alike!

Some have added spaced-out armor; many have exterior fuel tanks; practically all of them have additional machine guns mounted or stowed for quick use. Additionally, the IDF troops have a penchant for hanging almost all their worldly belongings on the sides and tops of Zelda.

Just as the exteriors have been heavily modified, the interiors have received well thought-out stowage racks, bins and lockers all designed to keep the contents from rattling around inside the vehicle. Seating for a squad of troops is standard in Zelda, but many special purpose Zeldas have seen their bench seats removed for additional storage space of supplies or ammunition.

The Israelis have had many years of battle-tested experience in which to perfect their modifications to the M-113.

Many "ideas" developed by the IDF have since appeared on the M-113 APC's of the US and other nations using this weapons system. Considering how much equipment has been added to the basic M-113, it is a wonder that the engine and power-train can provide enough power to move this vehicle at a decent rate of speed.

Your Academy kits of Zelda contains many optional parts from which you can assemble any one of several different types such as the spaced-armor version or the command communications vehicle.






18 Cupola & Armament Assembly






19 Engine Grill Assembly









Parts Locating Diagram






























