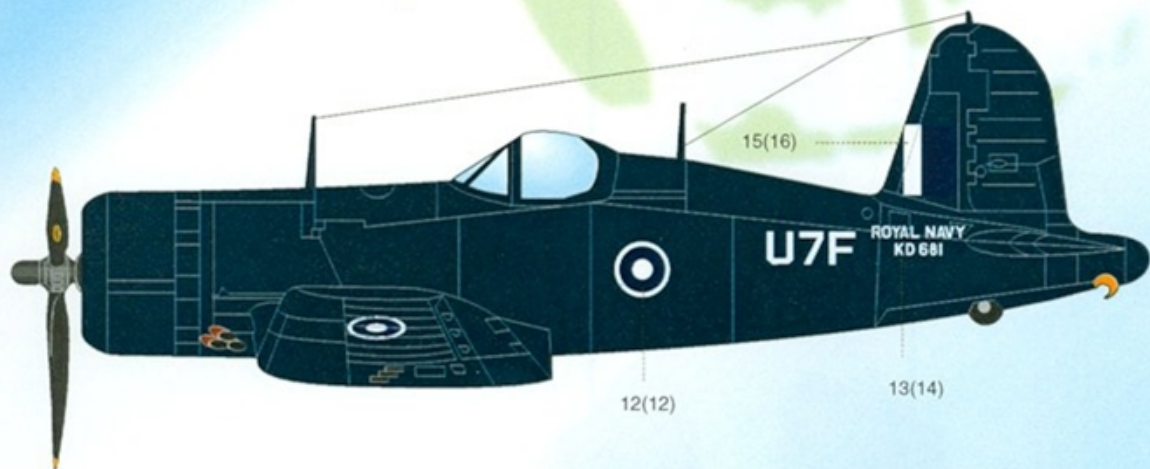
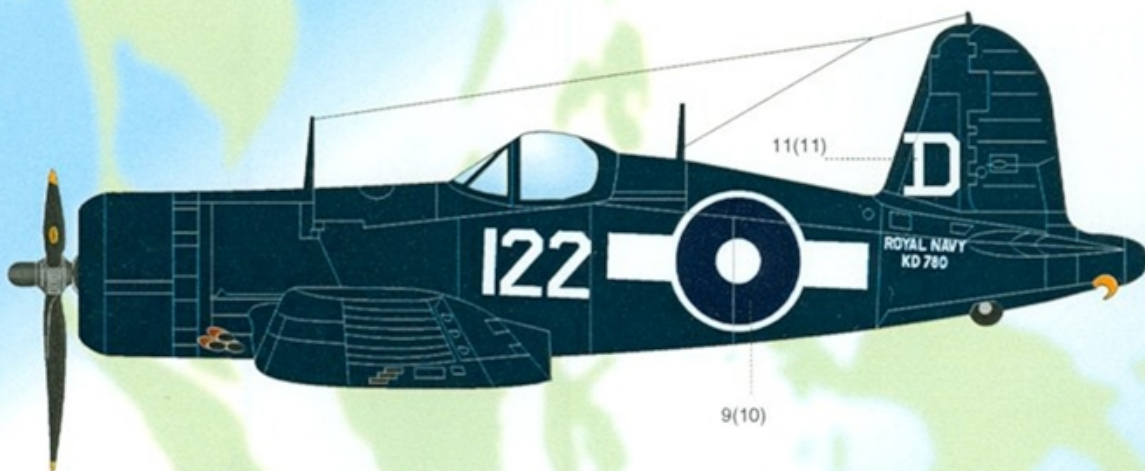

Corsair II JT586. Lt (A) PS Cole DSC RNV. Senior Pilot of 1830 Squadron HMS illustrious, British Pacific Fleet, April 1945. 125/Q participated in the lead up to Operation Iceberg, the invasion of Okinawa, with strafing attacks on Formosan airfields. Standard Slate Gray/Extra Dark Sea Gray camouflage was applied to all upper surfaces and Sky to under surfaces.



Corsair II JT427. Major RC Hay RM. Air Coordinator, HMS Victorious, British East Indies Fleet, January 1945. JT427 is depicted with official SEAC markings at the time of the air strikes on the Palembang oil fields. Standard Slate Gray/Extra Dark Sea Gray camouflage applied to upper surfaces and Sky to under surfaces. Natural Metal prop hub.

Corsair IV KD780, 1846 Squadron, HMS Colossus, British Pacific Fleet 1945. 122/D embarked on HMS Colossus for the far east in February 1945, but saw no action. Overall glossy Dark Sea Blue scheme was applied for the Eastern theater.



Corsair IV KD681.S/lt. JD Garden. 1846 Squadron, HMS Colossus, British Pacific Fleet, early 1945. U7F displays a different coding and roundel presentation to 122/D above. Various BPF squadrons had a mixture of roundel styles while on active service. Overall paint finish is glossy Dark Sea Blue.
