

This detail set is manufactured from photo etched brass sheet and is meant for use on the Italeri kit. Use a sharp modelling knife or scalpel to separate components from frame, ensuring that this is done on a firm flat surface, as near to the part as possible. Tag scars can be cleaned by holding part in pliers and using a fine file. To fold part, support up to line of fold in pliers, and fold in one go using the blade of a screwdriver to fold.

For assembly use superglue or epoxy using only epoxy on clear parts. Before painting, ensure that parts are fully defluxed by cleaning with liquid and rinsing in clean water. Dry parts thoroughly and prime with self etching primer or matt enamel paint. Position of parts in diagrams is for guidance only. For colouring and final positioning, consult reference material. Recommended is "AH-64 Apache in Action" by Squadron / Signal publications.
