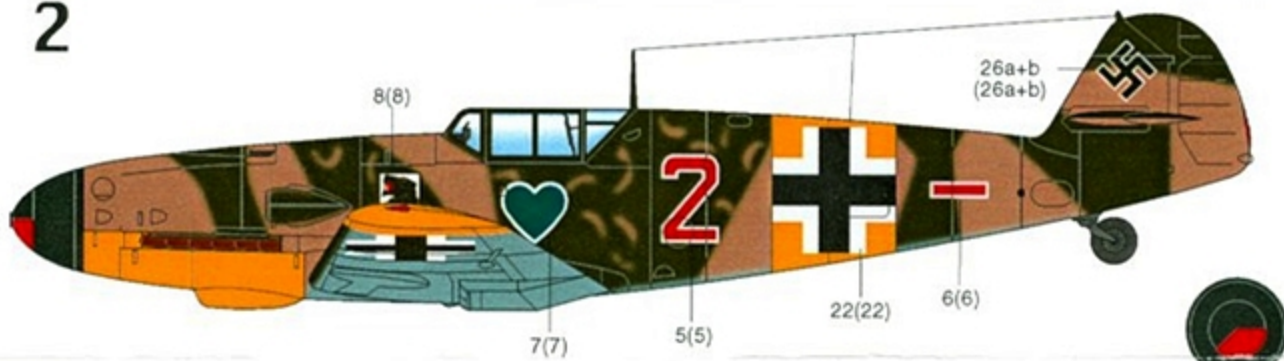

BF-109F of III. /JG3 "UDET", spring 1942. Flown by Technischer Offizier. Photos show a non-standard upper wing pattern of possibly 70/74/02 with RLM 76 under surfaces. Fuselage appears to be a standard 74/75/76 with 74/75/02 splotches. Upper section of fin and rudder seem to be heavily mottled, or perhaps a solid dark color (74?). Fuselage band and lower wing tips in RLM 04. Black or Black Green (RLM 70) spinner. RLM 70 propeller blades.

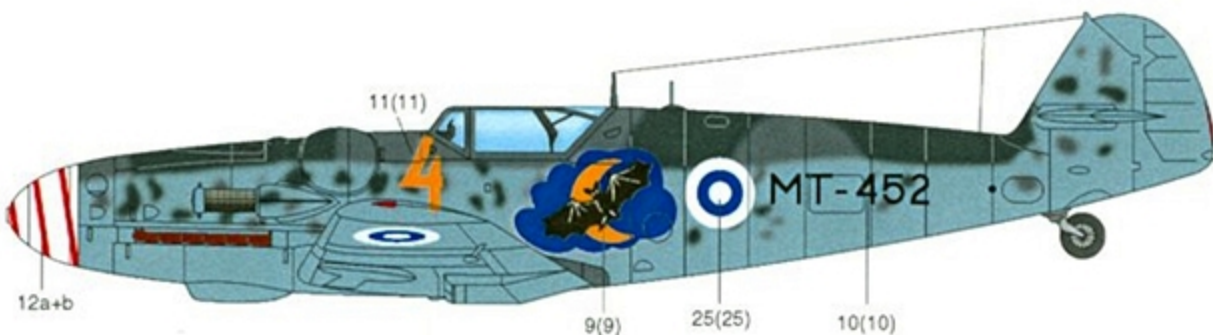

BF-109G-2, II./JG 54 "Grünherz", Siwerskaja, Russia, fall 1942. Non-standard field applied camouflage of RLM 79/80, exact pattern unknown. Lower surfaces probably RLM 78. Lower cowling, lower wing tips, and fuselage band Yellow. Spinner Black (or possibly 70), part of spinner frontal area is Red.

BF-109G-6, MT-422, Finnish Air Force, HLeLv 31, Utti, 1948. Typical German camouflage of RLM 74/75/76, heavily mottled with 74/75/02 White spinner, Red spiral. Note late style canopy.

BF-109G-6, MT-422, Finnish Air Force, HLeLv 31, Utti, 1948. Olive green (F.S. 34096) and black upper surface camouflage, lower surfaces lt. blue grey (F.S. 35414). Spinner front white, RLM 70 back. Prop blades 70 with yellow tips.
