

Painting & Decal Guide

In Nov. 2007, very unusually-painted F-16C was soaring into the sky of Texas. It is painted to celebrate 111th FS's 90th anniversary, which is established in 1917.

In 2008, several markings are added to this aircraft and showed itself to public.

Note the RAM plate
on the both sides of
the nose.



★ marked decal is added in 2008,
so do not apply these if you are building
the 2007's aircraft.



Painting & Decal Guide

This aircraft is painted to celebrate 111th FS's 50th anniversary and telling its history by its colors and markings.

The yellow wing and midline / flaps/chevron, wing roundel represents pre-WWII era, "NS-A" does its WWII era with the roundel of that age, blue color for Korean War, and the gray color does the air superiority blue of the jet era.

Now 111th FS does not fly F-16s no more, because it is deactivated and transition to be 111th Reconnaissance Squadron, operating the MQ-1 Predator since Jun. 2008.

As for the armament ordinance, this aircraft is shown as a clean condition or a couple of inert AIM-9 on the wingtip, all without any underwing / fuselage pylons attached.


This aircraft is F-16C block 25 84-1293, which is powered by PW engine and has small intake.

We suggest Tamya's kit, "1/32 F-16C Thunderbirds" is the best choice in the market and this product is designed to fit to it. We can not guarantee this product would fit to Hasegawa's old kit and Academy's block 40/50 kits. As for the decal for chevrons supplied, you can cut it into two pieces if you feel necessary.


Finish your model with gloss lacquer.

Applying Decals

1. Get all desired decal sheet.
2. Dip the decal into clear water for about 10 seconds. Warm water works better.
3. Place it onto a clean glass paper to remove unnecessary bubbles.
4. Slide the decal from the backing sheet to the cleaned surface of the model. Adding a drop of water between them helps to move decal into position.
5. Use cotton, tissue paper or clear cloth to press decal gently to remove air bubbles.
6. Apply lacquer ONLY ON THOROUGHLY DRIED DECAL.
