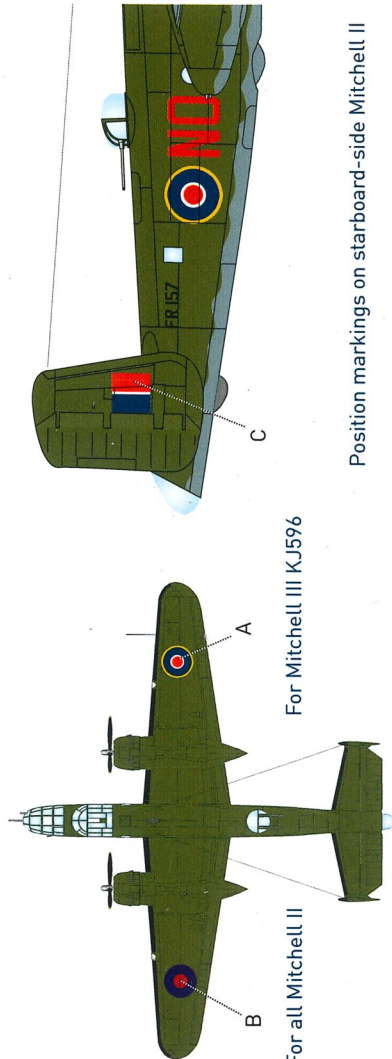

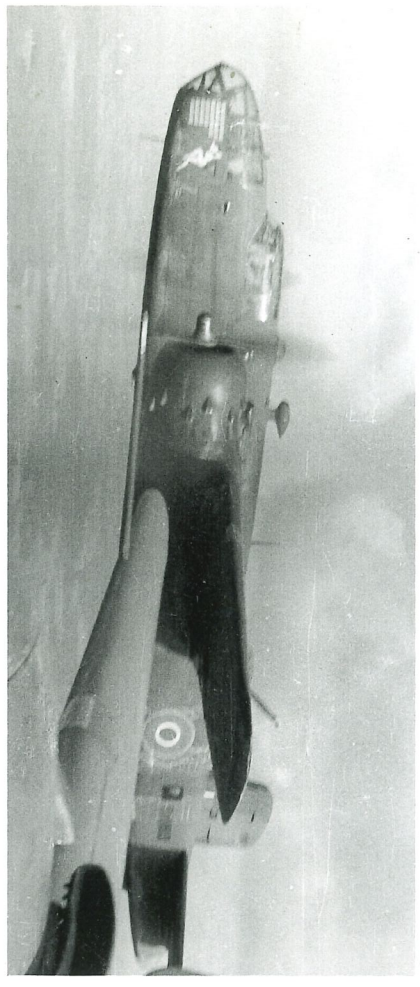

still visible on fuselage.

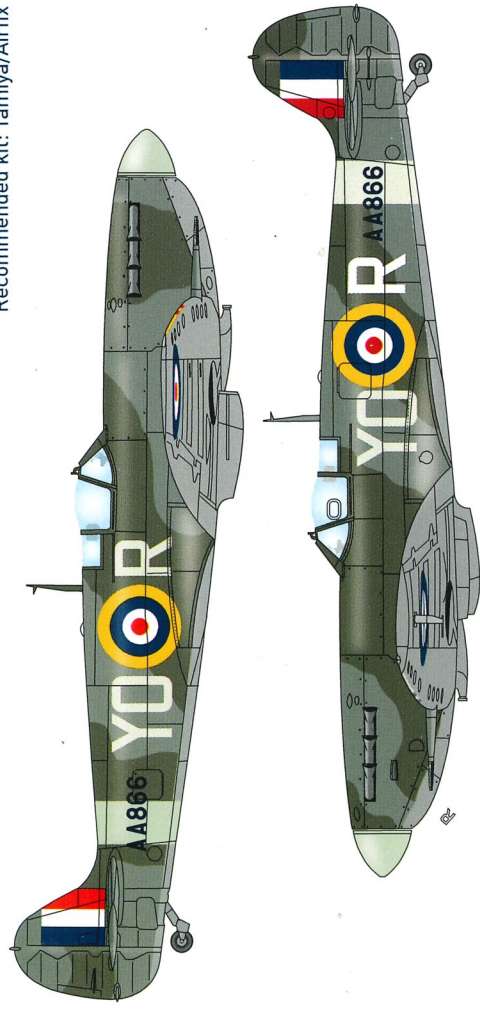


'Bergy' started his MN875 on 23 febr. 1945 at B.80 Helmond, The Netherlands.  
Note, four? blade propeller, rockets and wingtank.



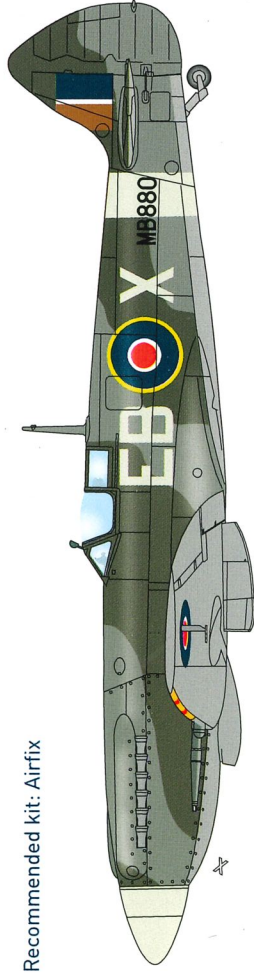

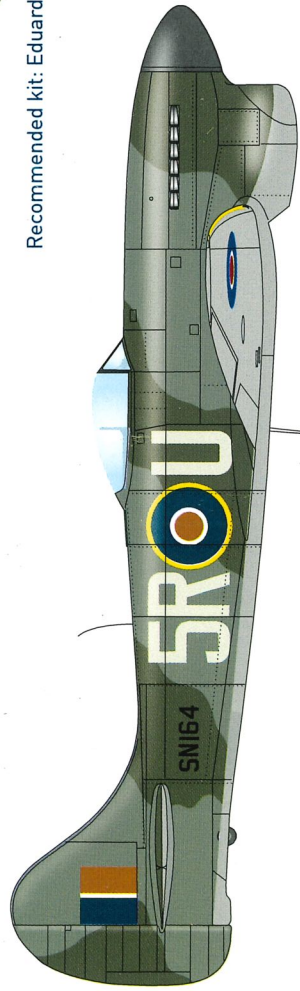

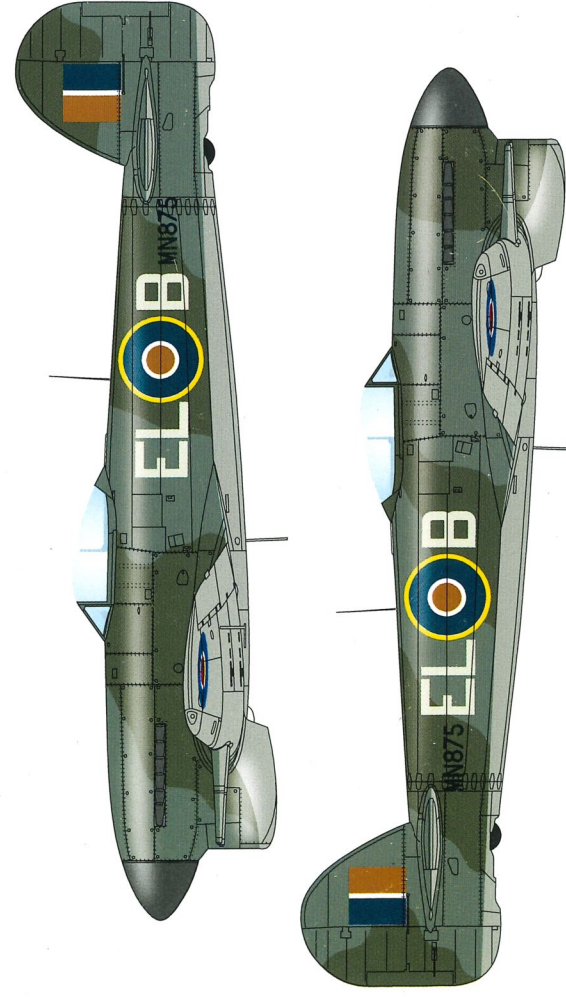

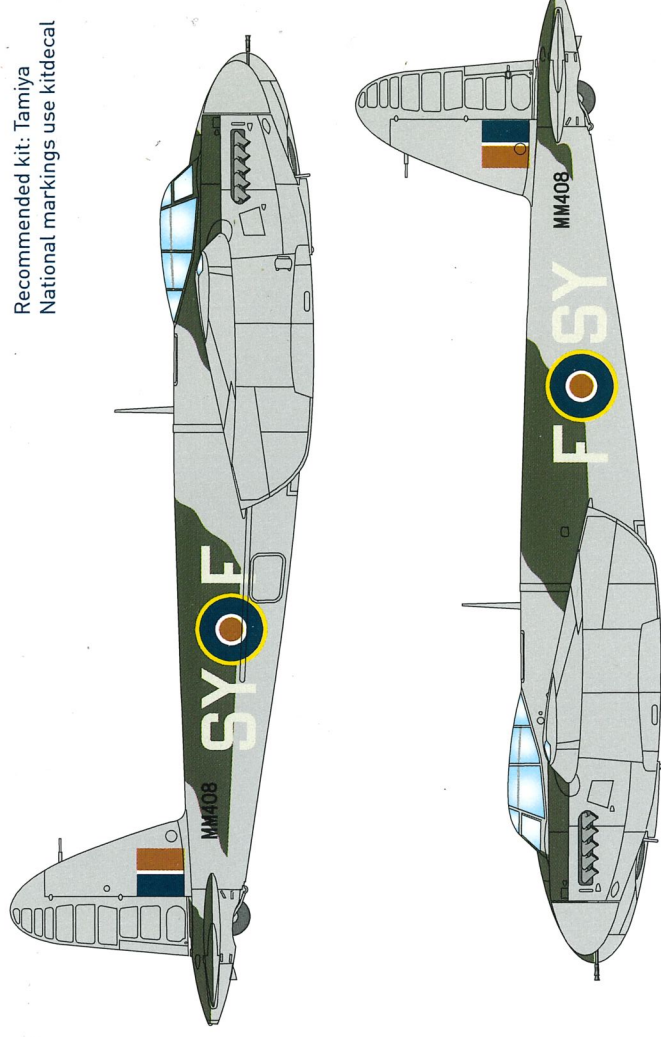

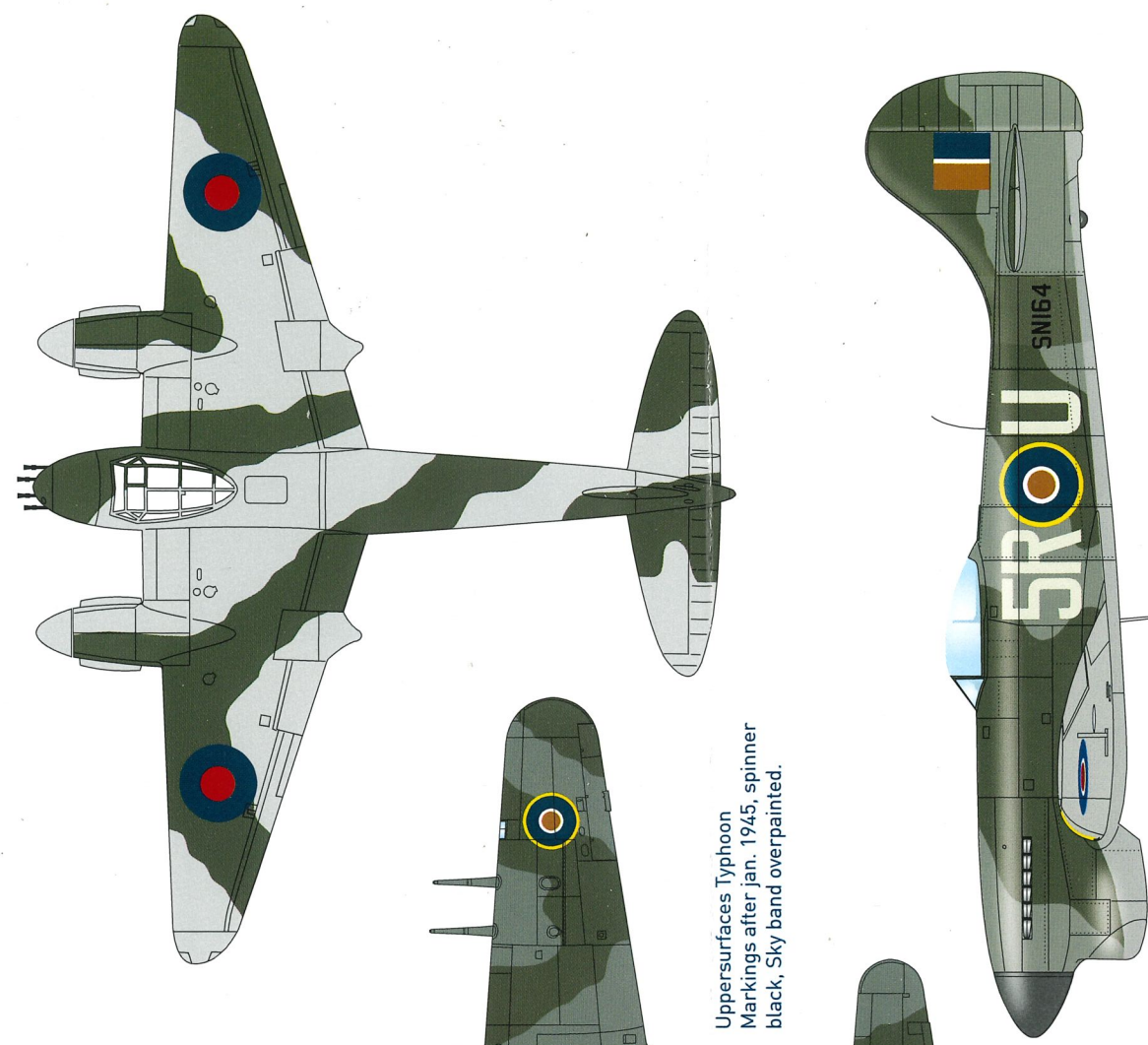

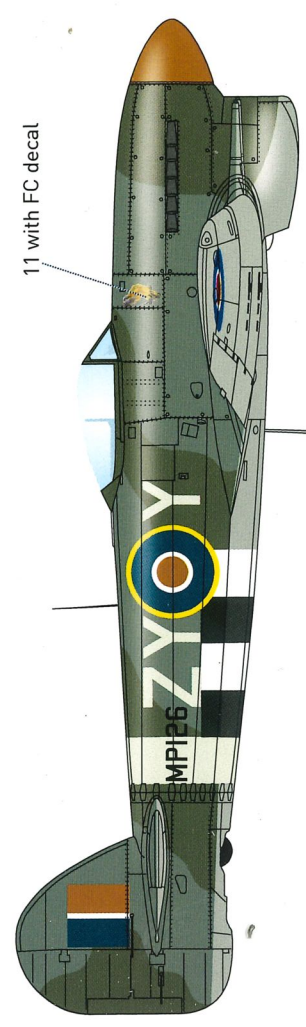

Hit by flak, Wiersum was forced to make a wheels-up landing near Bocholt and was taken POW. Painted in RAF Day Fighter Scheme of Ocean Grey, Dark Green and with lower surfaces in Medium Sea Grey. Black and white 'invasion' markings only on lower surfaces wings and fuselage. Four blade propeller.
