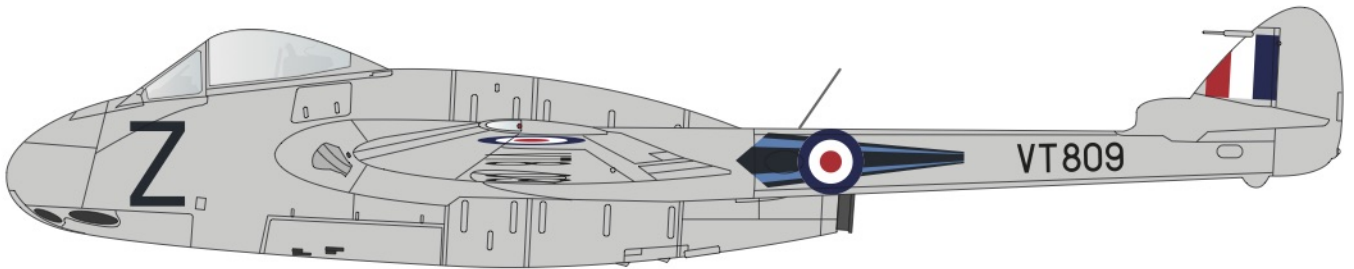

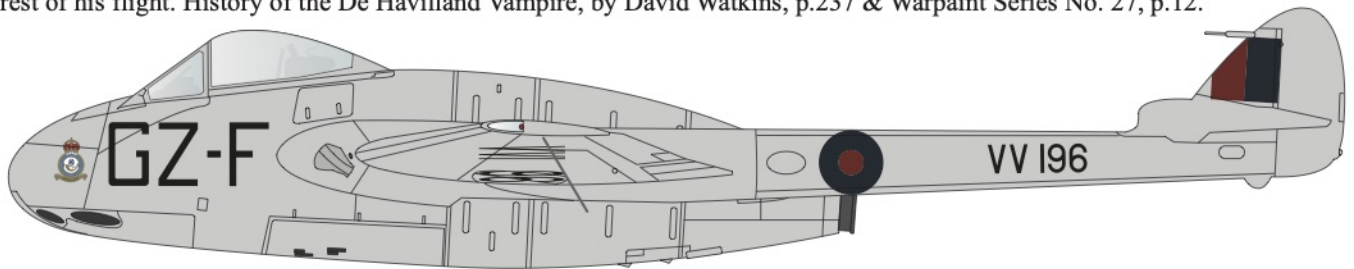

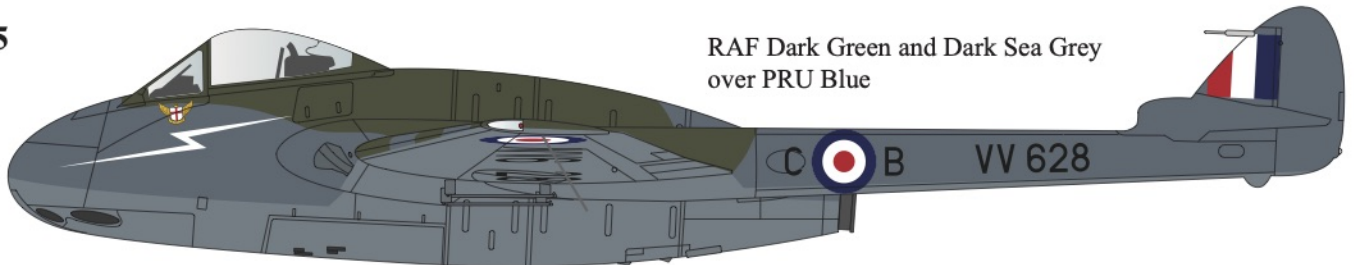

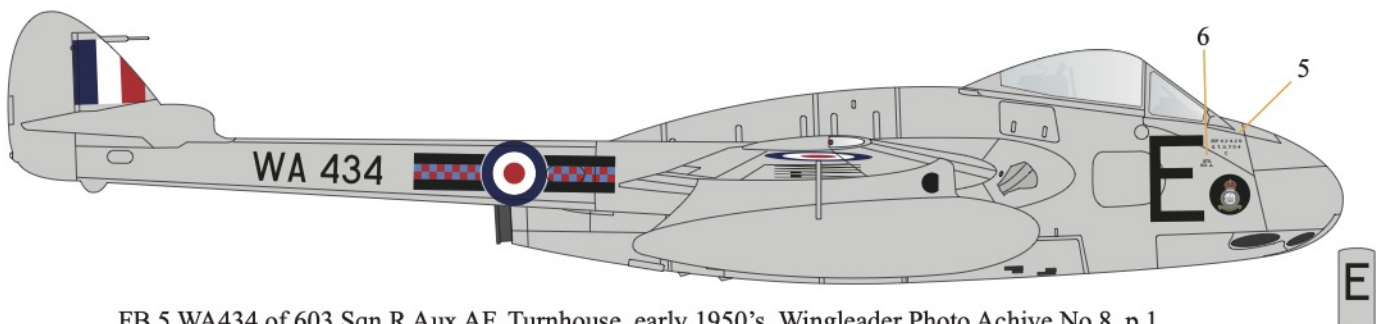

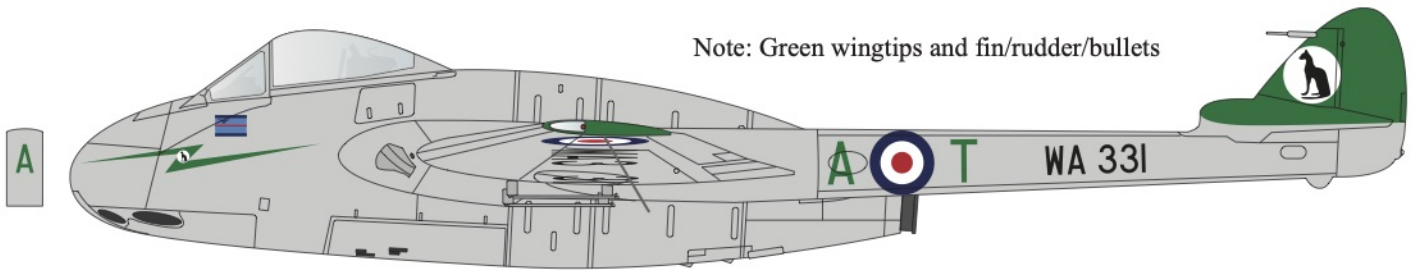

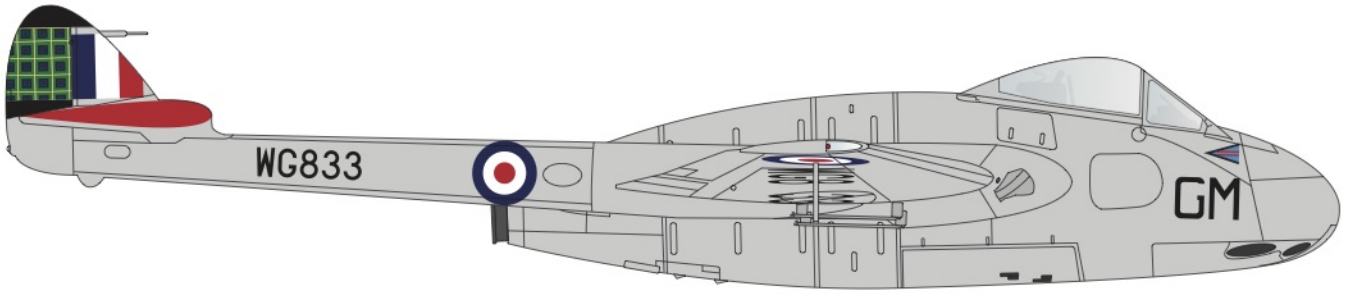
FB 5 WA434 of 603 Sqn R Aux AF, Turnhouse, early 1950's. Wingleader Photo Achive No.8. p.1.

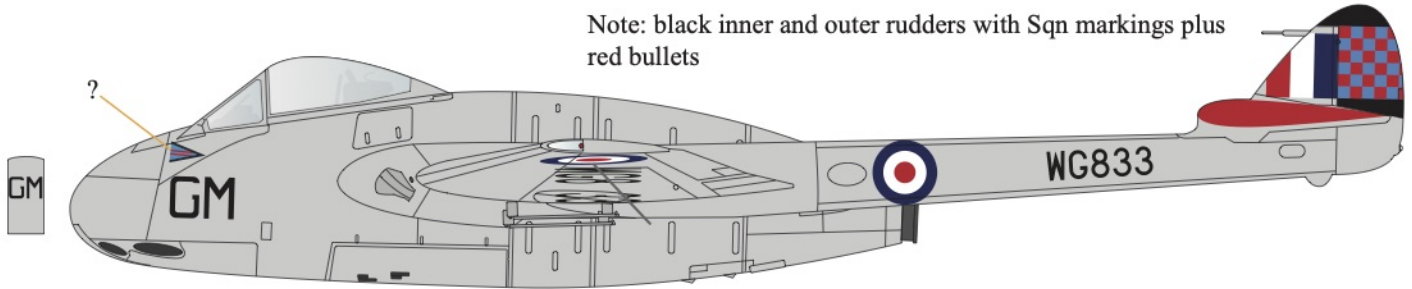

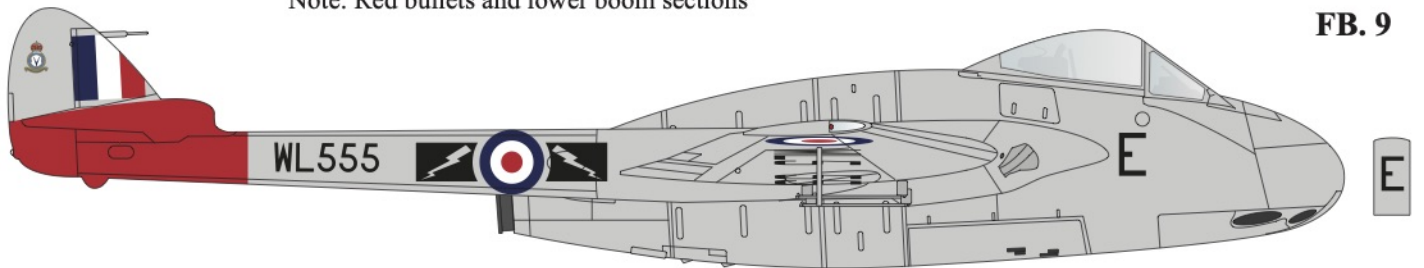


Note: black inner and outer rudders with Sqn markings plus red bullets

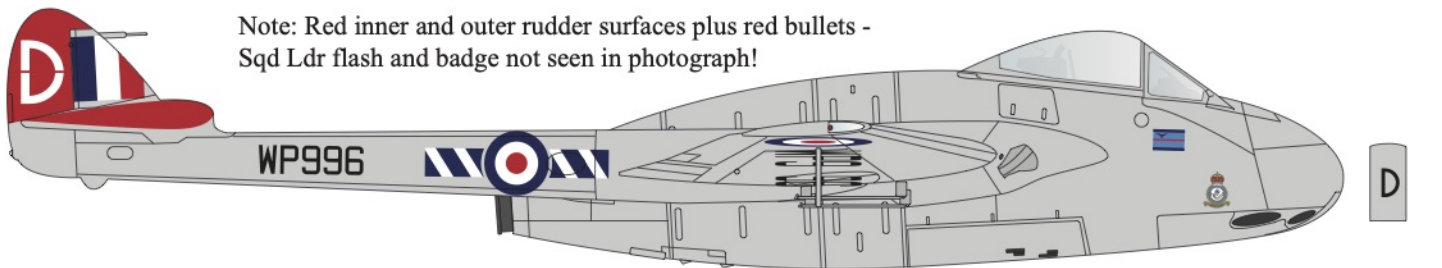

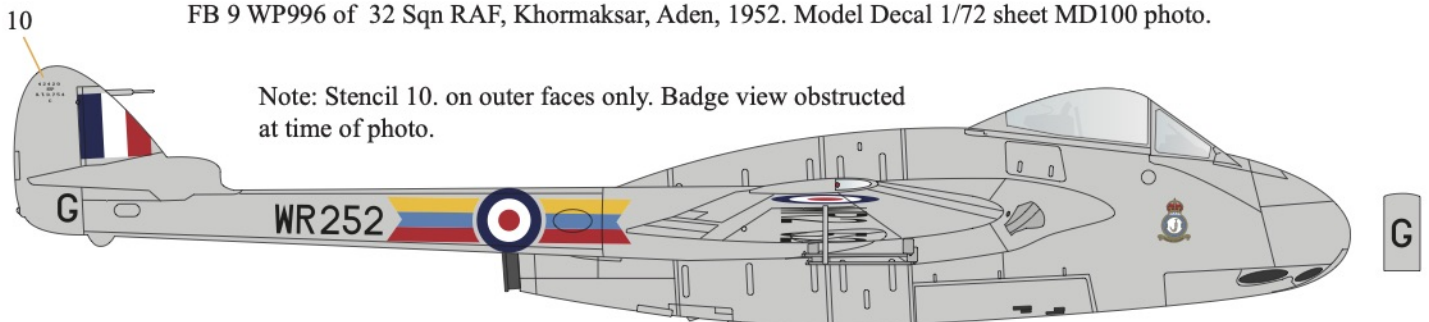

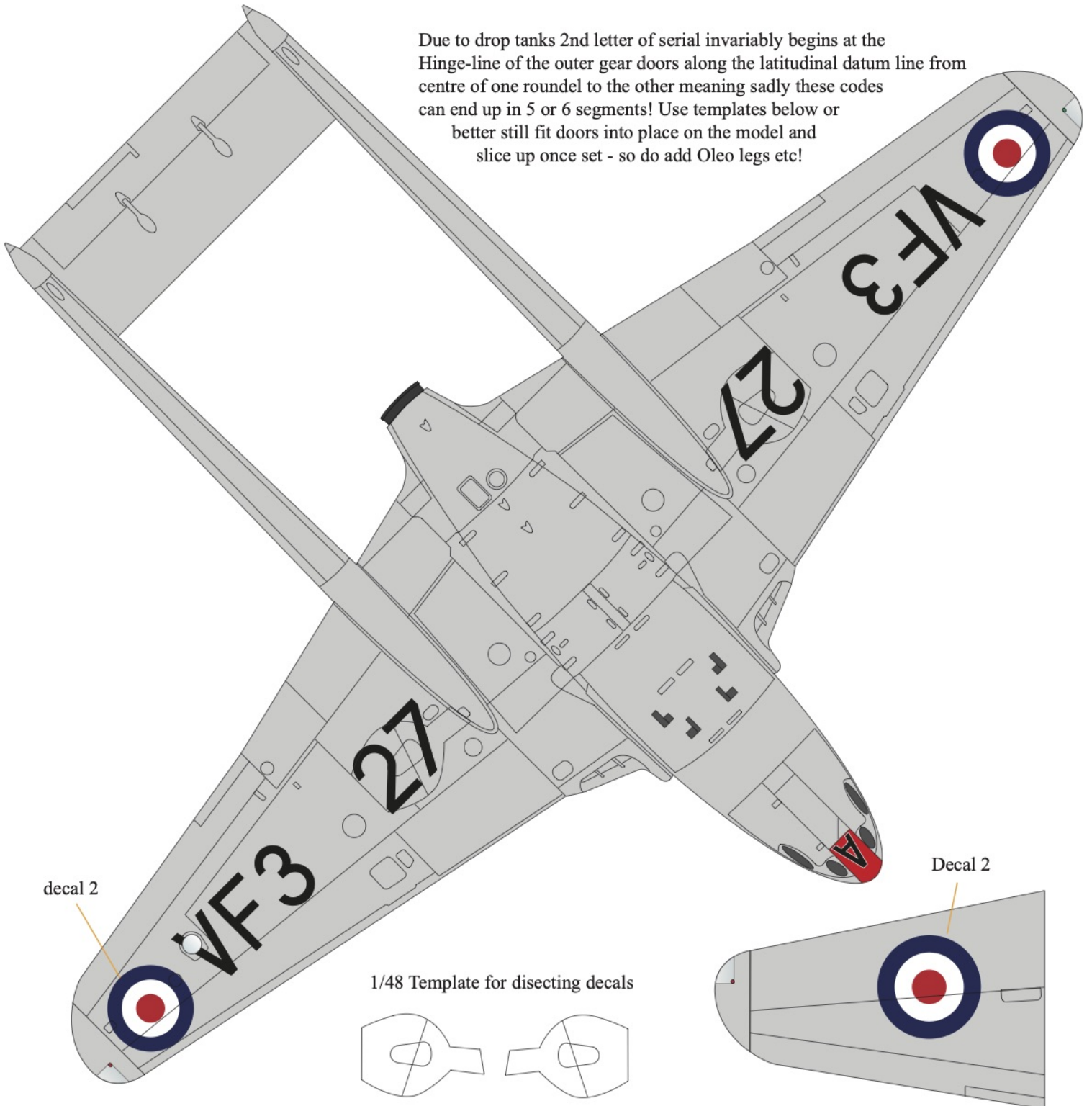


Decal '1' - upper wing 36" Type D



Decal '2' - upper wing 30" Type D (plus spare set to replace Airfix kit and other after-market sheets where just the upper wing size is provided)

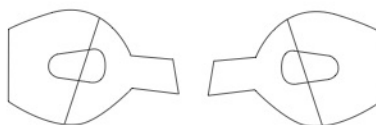
Due to drop tanks 2nd letter of serial invariably begins at the Hinge-line of the outer gear doors along the latitudinal datum line from centre of one roundel to the other meaning sadly these codes can end up in 5 or 6 segments! Use templates below or better still fit doors into place on the model and slice up once set - so do add Oleo legs etc!

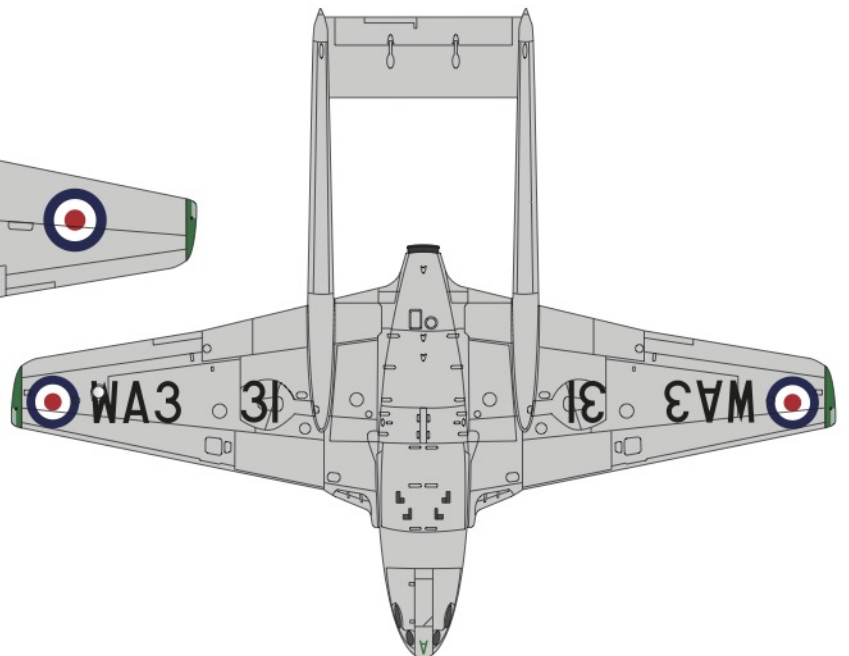
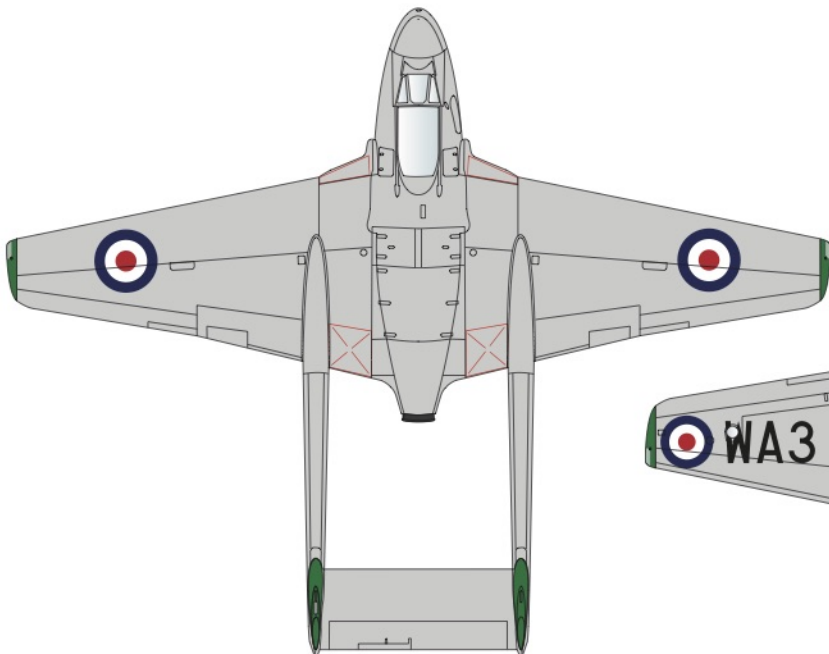
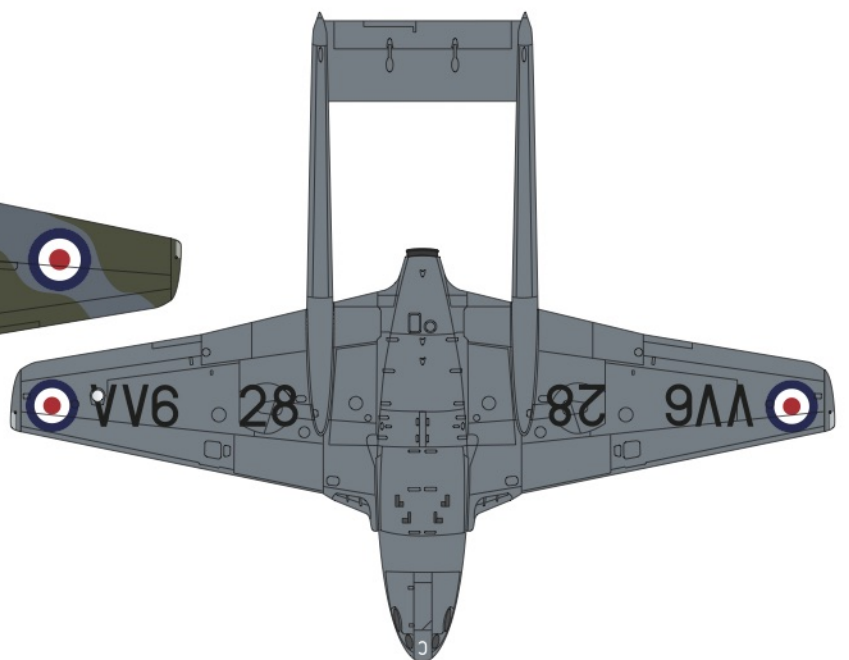
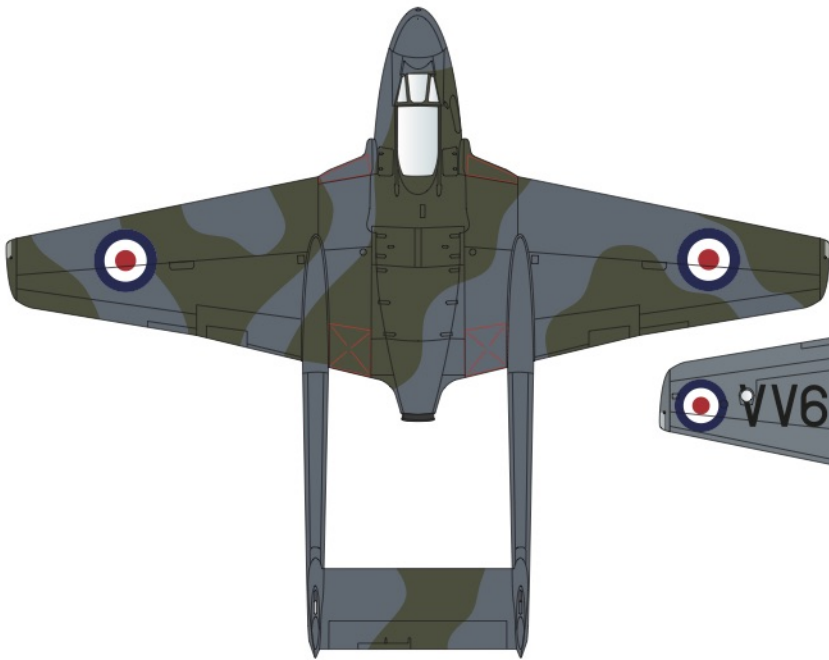
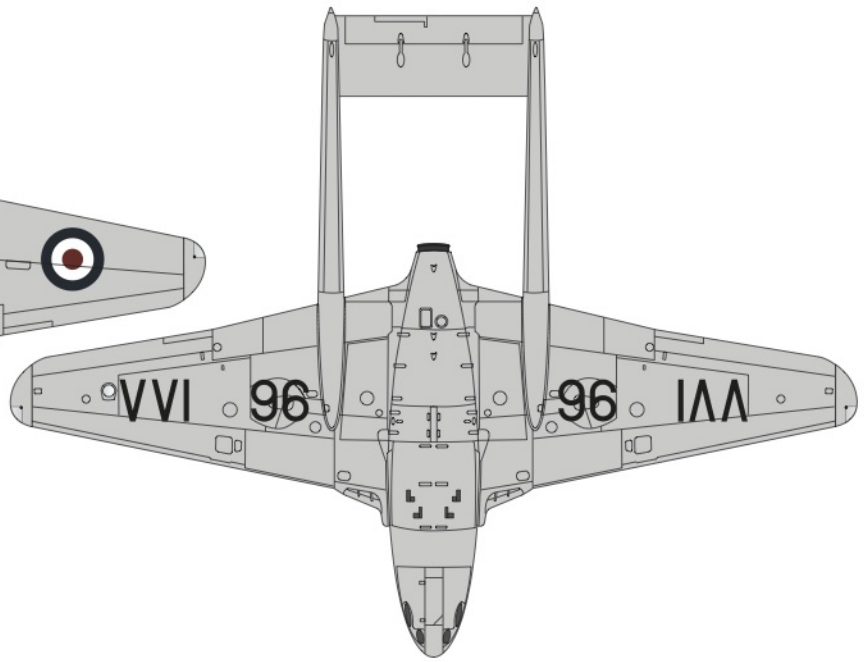
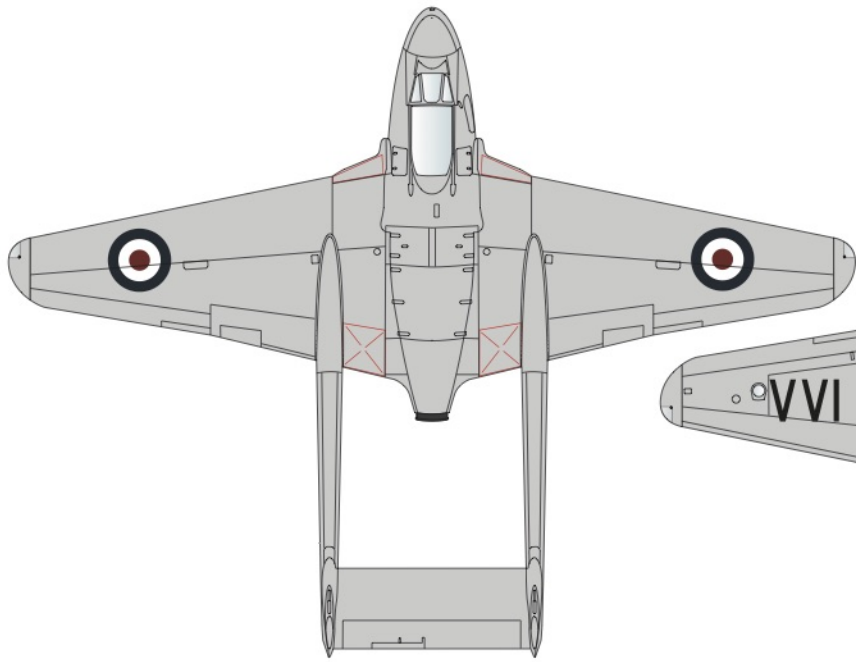


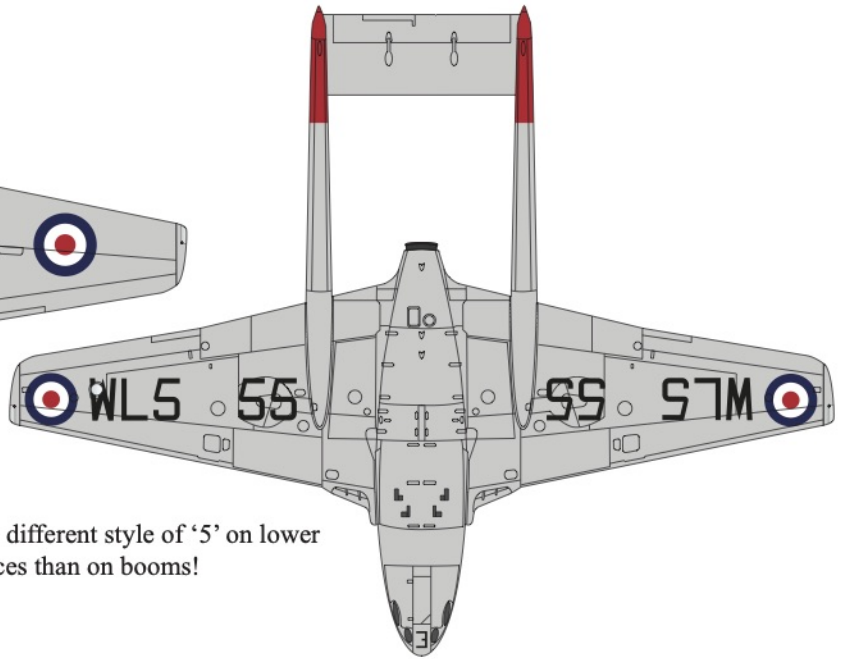
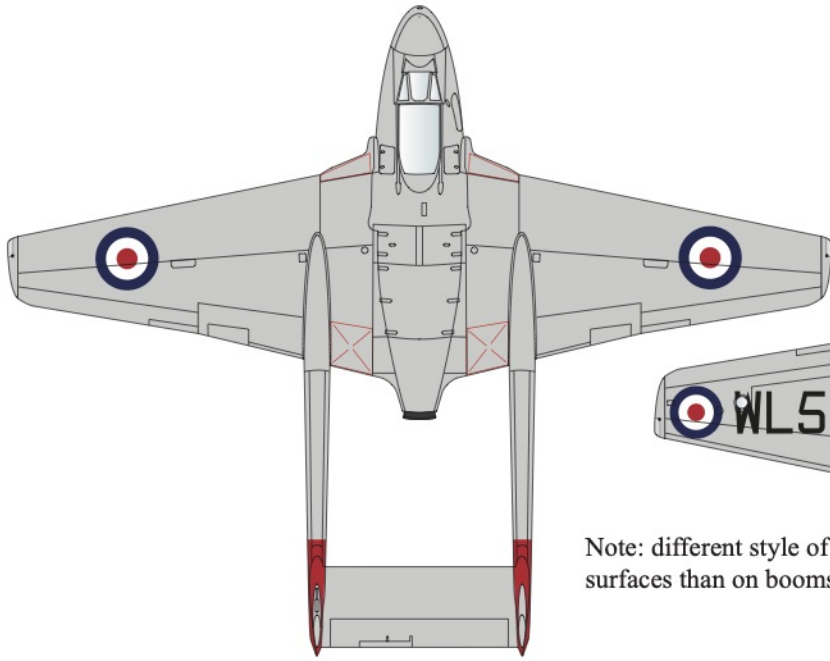

1/48 Template for dissecting decals





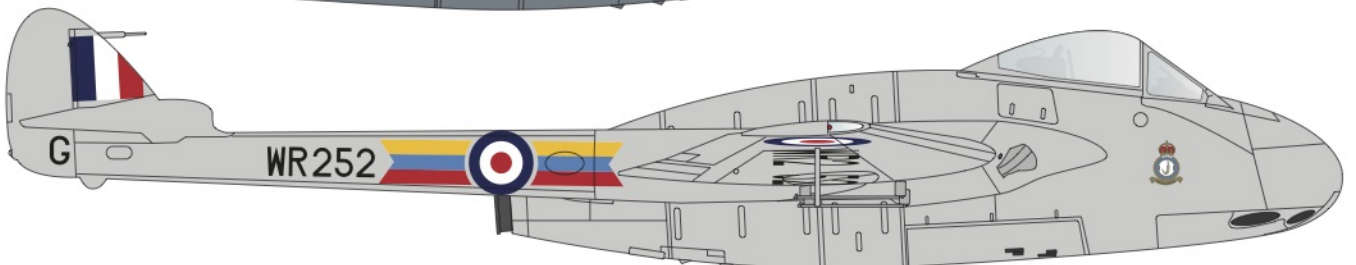
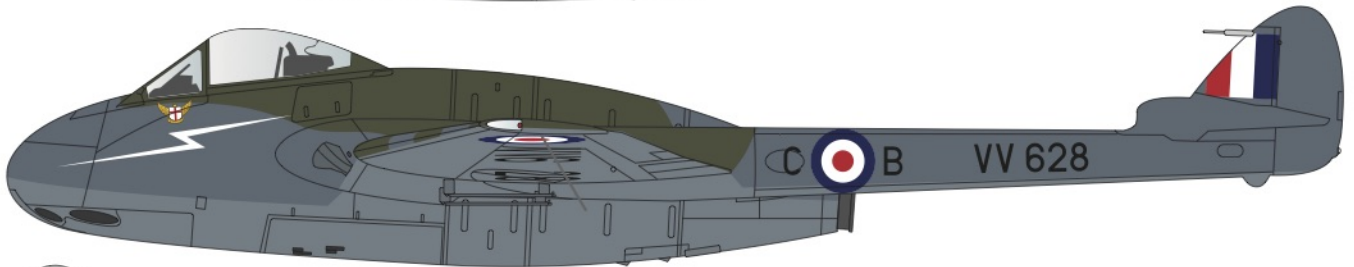
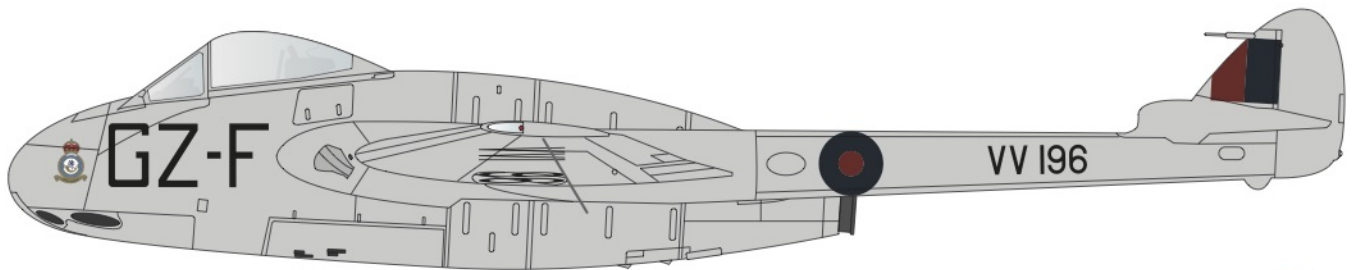


Note: different style of '5' on lower surfaces than on booms!
