The carrier based A-6E intruder is a variant of the A-6 series which had been the mainstay of the U.S. Navy and U.S. Marine Corps from 1963 to 1997. As the last member in the series, the A-6E was introduced in 1970 and featured vast improvements on the radar system and onboard computer for missions including close air support, interdiction and deep-strike missions.

Despite the nickname "Double Ugly" inspired by its large blunt nose, the A-6E was obviously a top performer attack bomber. It had a total payload of 18,000 pounds and was capable of carrying ordnance including HARM, Harpoon missiles and a wide range of air-to-ground weapons. With the large variety of ordnance, the multiple-mode radar and Forward Looking Infra-Red (FLIR) system, the A-6E was able to detect, identify and attack targets precisely under zero-visibility conditions or in foul weather. In the early 1990s, wing fatigue problems were discovered in the A-6Es. As a primary solution, majority of the fleets were fitted with upgraded composite wings which significantly extended the aircrafts' operational life.

The A-6E saw service extensively in Operation El Dorado Canyon, Operation Desert Storm, Operation Restore and in Bosnia. As the aircraft retired in 1997, its precision strike role was filled by the F-14 Tomcat.
