A. F-117A (82-0799). The Midnight Racer first flew on September 22, 1983. Initially delivered to the 4450th TG. 21 sorties performed during Desert Storm assigned to the 416th TFS. King Khalid Air Base, Saudi Arabia, 1991.

B. F-117A (82-0803). "Unexpected Guest" first took to the air on May 8, 1984. This aircraft participated in Panama as part of the operation "Just Cause" (December 1989). As part of the 416th TFS, 33 sorties were completed during Desert Storm. 803 has the most the number of combat missions among all F-117s. C. F-117A (85-0814). The first flight took place on July 26, 1985. During "Desert Storm" he made 34 sorties assigned to 416th TFS. Pictured as of 1991, King Khalid Air Base.






