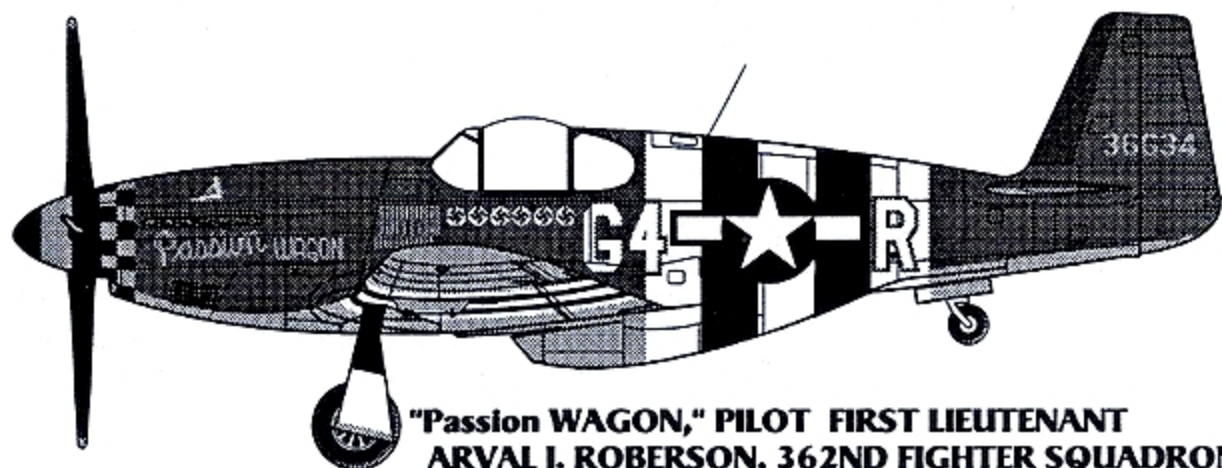

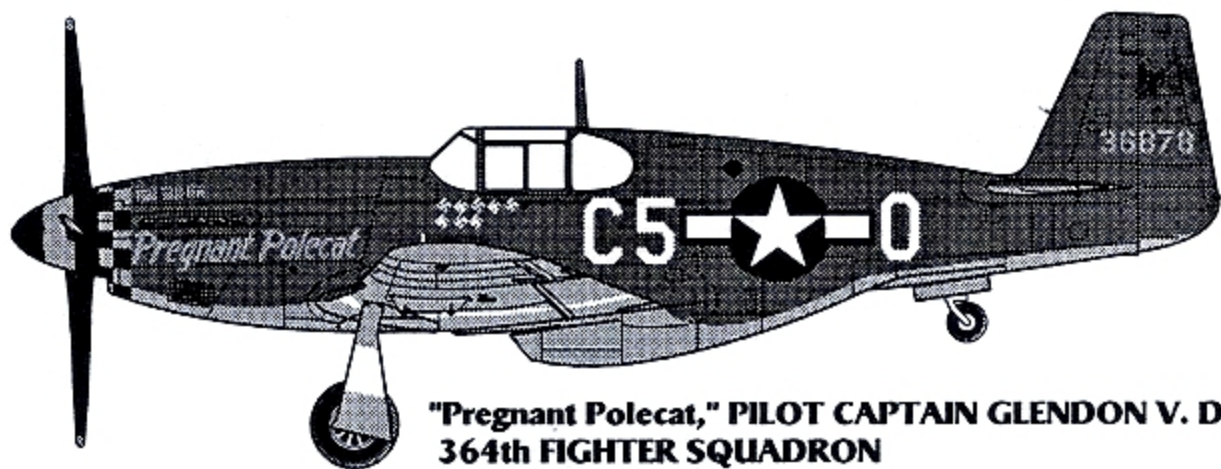

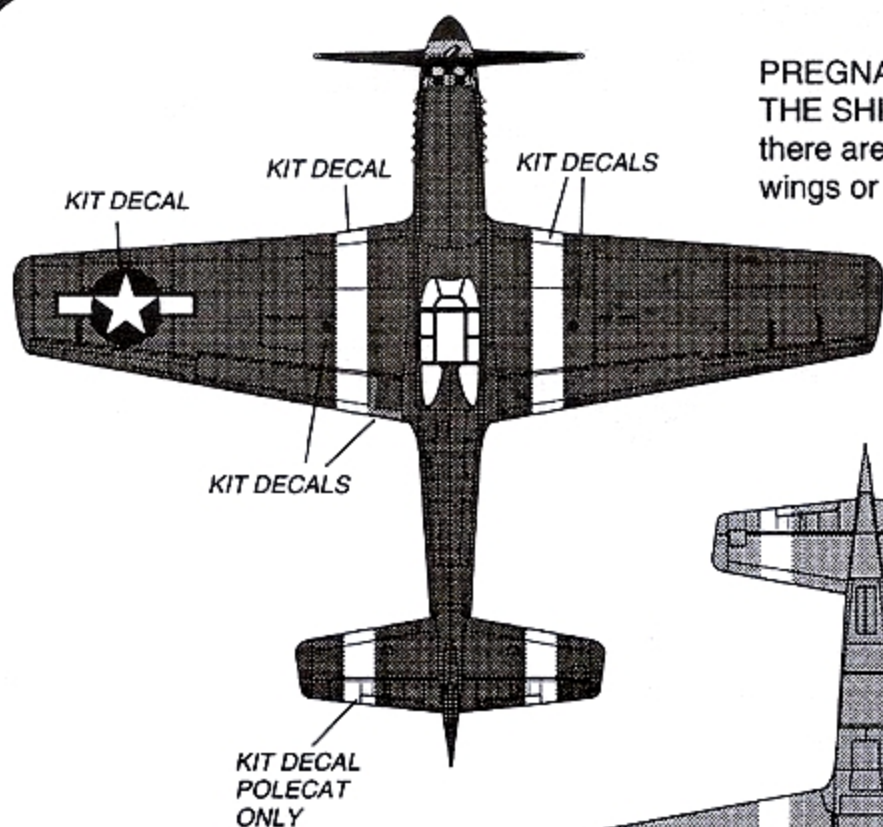

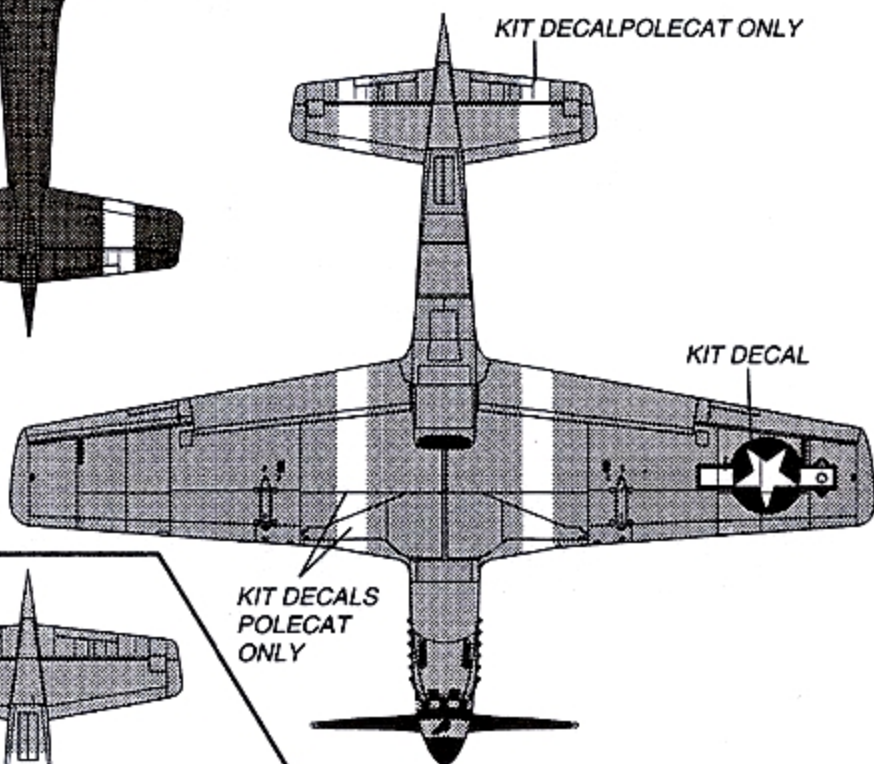

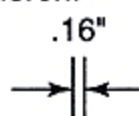




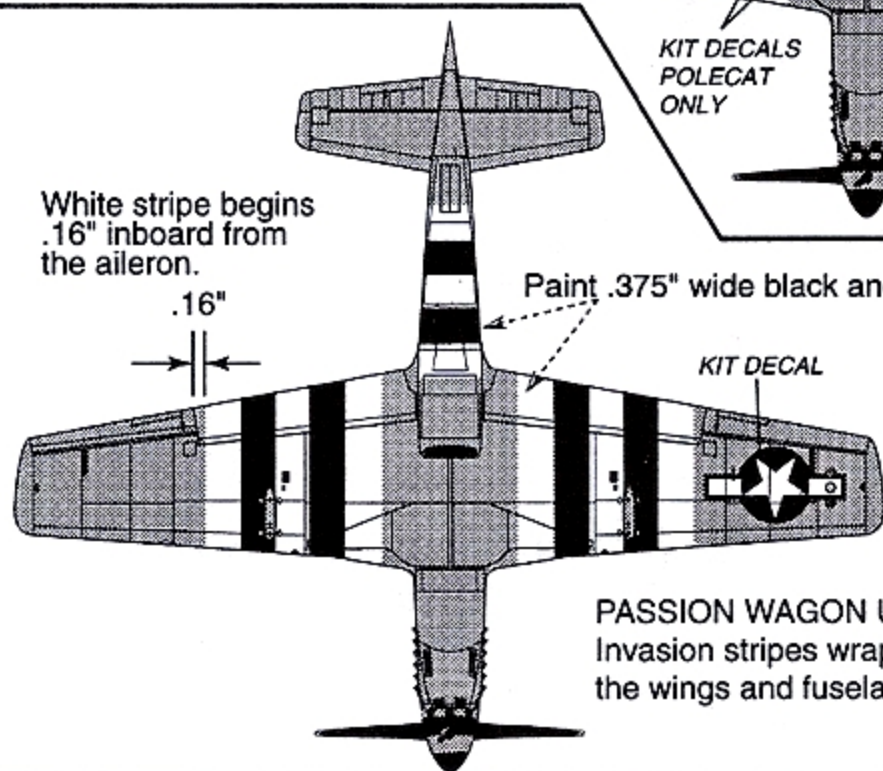
PREGNANT POLECAT PLAN VIEWS

 wings or stabilizers.

Paint .375" wide black and white stripes.

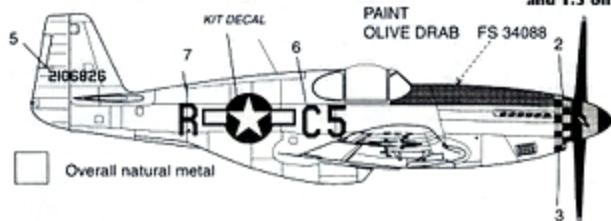


PASSION WAGON UNDERSIDE VIEW.  
 Invasion stripes wrap completely around  
 the wings and fuselage.

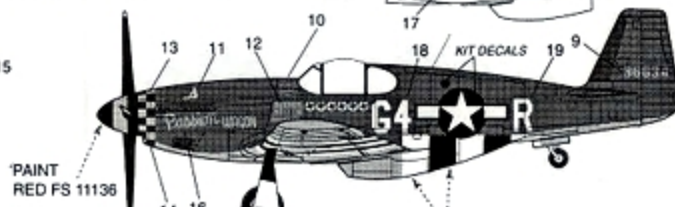
NOTE: The checkers on the noses of the 357th fighters were not identical. Each one was painted individually, and this characteristic is depicted on these decals

**P-51B-15-NA, 42-106826, "THE SHILLELAGH," PILOT CAPTAIN JOHN A. STORCH, 364TH FIGHTER SQUADRON, 357TH FIGHTER GROUP.** Storch was promoted to the rank of Major in May of 1944, and as a Lieutenant Colonel became Commander of the 364th FS in early 1945. He is credited with 10.5 aerial kills and 1.5 on the ground.



Note darker paint on the leading edge of the fin.

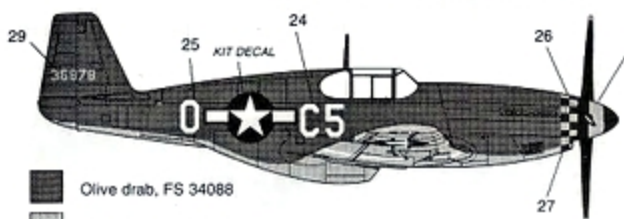
**P-51B-5-NA, 43-6634, "Passion WAGON," PILOT FIRST LIEUTENANT ORVAL J. ROBERSON, 362ND FIGHTER SQUADRON, 357 FIGHTER GROUP.** Roberson achieved six aerial victories.



Paint five .375" wide black and white stripes.

**P-51B-5-NA, 43-6878, "Pregnant Polcat," PILOT GLENDON V. DAVIS, 364th FIGHTER SQUADRON, 357TH FIGHTER GROUP.** Davis destroyed 7.5 enemy planes, although 8 kills are displayed on his plane. Brooms indicated fighter sweeps, while angled bombs were for dive bombing raids.
