





The C15TA Armoured Truck was developed by GM Canada along a concept lines of the American M3 Scout Car. The vehicle used the chassis of the Chevrolet C15A Canadian Military Pattern truck design. Between 1943 and 1945 a total of 3,961 units were built in Oshawa, Ontario. Armoured hulls were supplied by the Hamilton Bridge Company


The C15TA was used by the British and Canadian units in the Northwest Europe campaign as armoured personnel carrier and ambulance. After the end of the hostilities, many vehicles were left in Europe and were subsequently employed by armies of the liberated European countries, including Belgium, Denmark, the Netherlands, Norway. In addition about 150 were sold by Canada to Spain. Trucks left by the British forces in Vietnam were taken over by the French, which used them in Indochina and later transferred to South Vietnam. Many C15TAs were employed by the police forces of the Federation of Malaya. In 1955 Portugal received a number of vehicles, which were later used in the African wars. Some vehicles remained in service until the 1960s.
















Extended Assembly guide and part list to download at www.Mirror-models.com Assembly guide based on test sprue samples, which dont have quality of final product, features like molded canvas rope and some hinges and details are not present in pictures, but will be found on the final kit Heat up PE parts with lighter before use, brass will soften and become easy to bend and work with **B8 B7 Tamiya Super Thin Glue recommended** for plastic parts В4 b10 x4 back pins on crossbeams into holes in frame sides **B8** B6 **B9x 4 front** C15 frame assembly PE1x8 PE5x4 0.5mm dia wire PE₂ **B12** rear ends of springs with half C6 round top C10 only angle C8 C9 C3+C4 Set angle between front springs **C5** according to angle between front holders B9 before you glue springs on C1+C2, check before glue dries... Make ties with 0,5mm wire and then glue both differentials on their holders. Add C3-C5 and C7












Shock absorbers in the kit are meant rather optional for additional details, PE parts are tiny a require some patience (PE9-11 can be also replaced by simple piece of 0,3mm dia wire for easier handling)







Body Assembly If you want to go for full interior, do not assemble part A3 until you have done all inside windows subassemblies like described on following pages



The kit offers option of closed or open front windows, but because of difference between wall thickness in real and scale, it is only possible with a little surgery. If you want to build closed vehicle without interior details, you can leave these steps












small windows assembly - for closed option use PE24, for open option use PE23 mind position of PE21, different for opened (down) and closed (up) window









Assemble dog house and steering wheel







Bonnet can be assembled in any position wanted, open or closed




PE18 0,5mm wire


put wire through hole in PE25, leaving short end at the back, that can be glued into a hole drilled in place where mirrors are to be assembled later - your mirrors will never fall off



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
