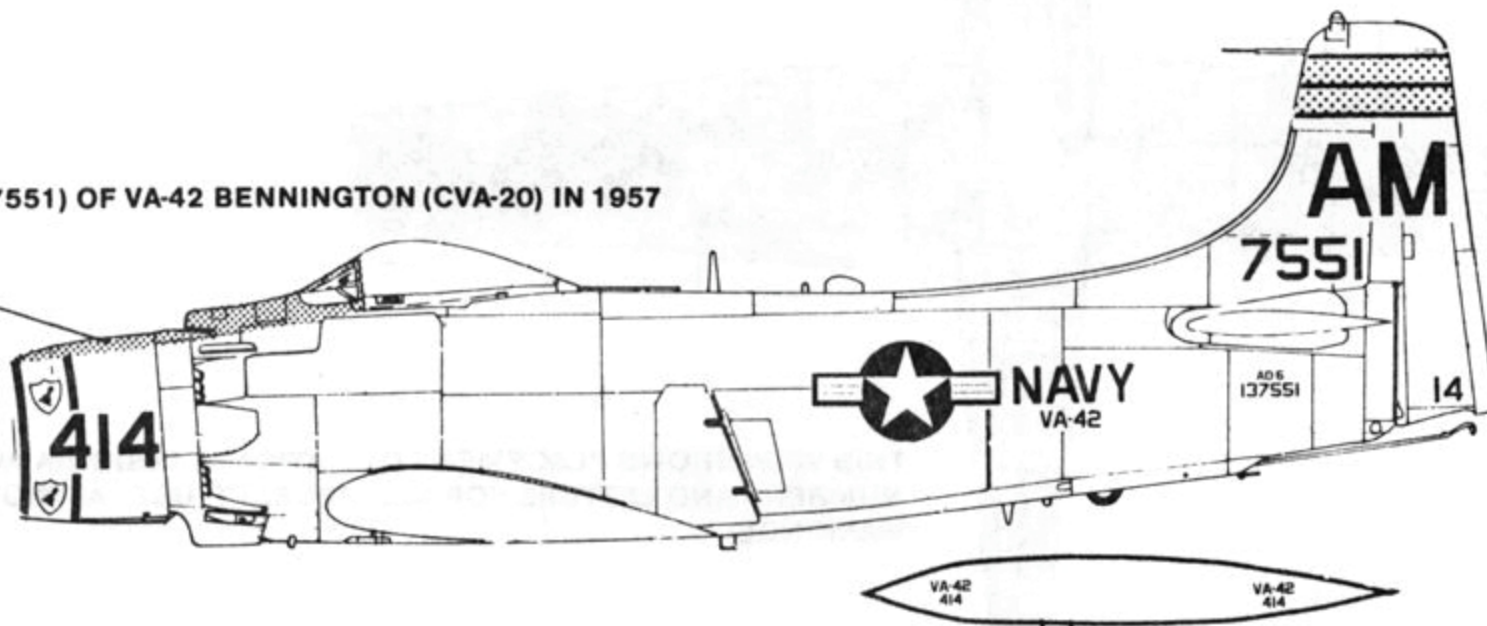

AD-6 (137551) OF VA-42 BENNINGTON (CVA-20) IN 1957

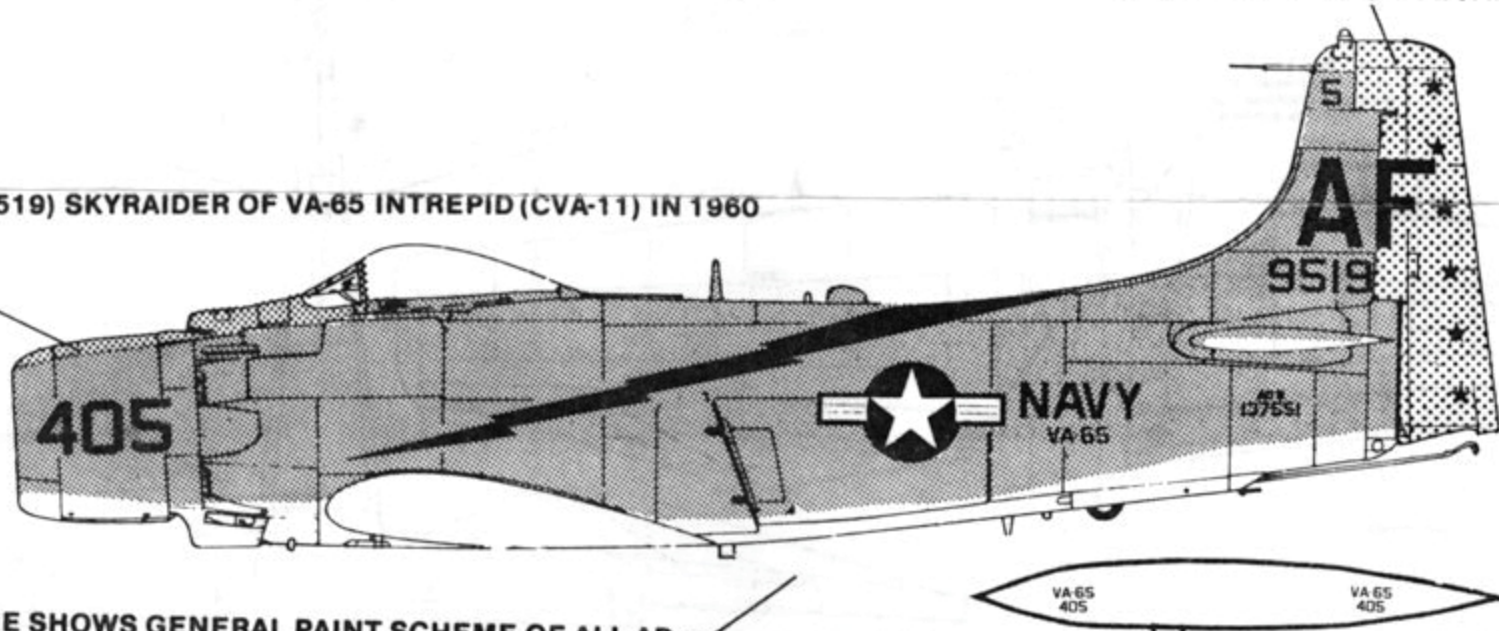

THIS PLANE SHOWS GENERAL PAINT SCHEME OF ALL AD-6

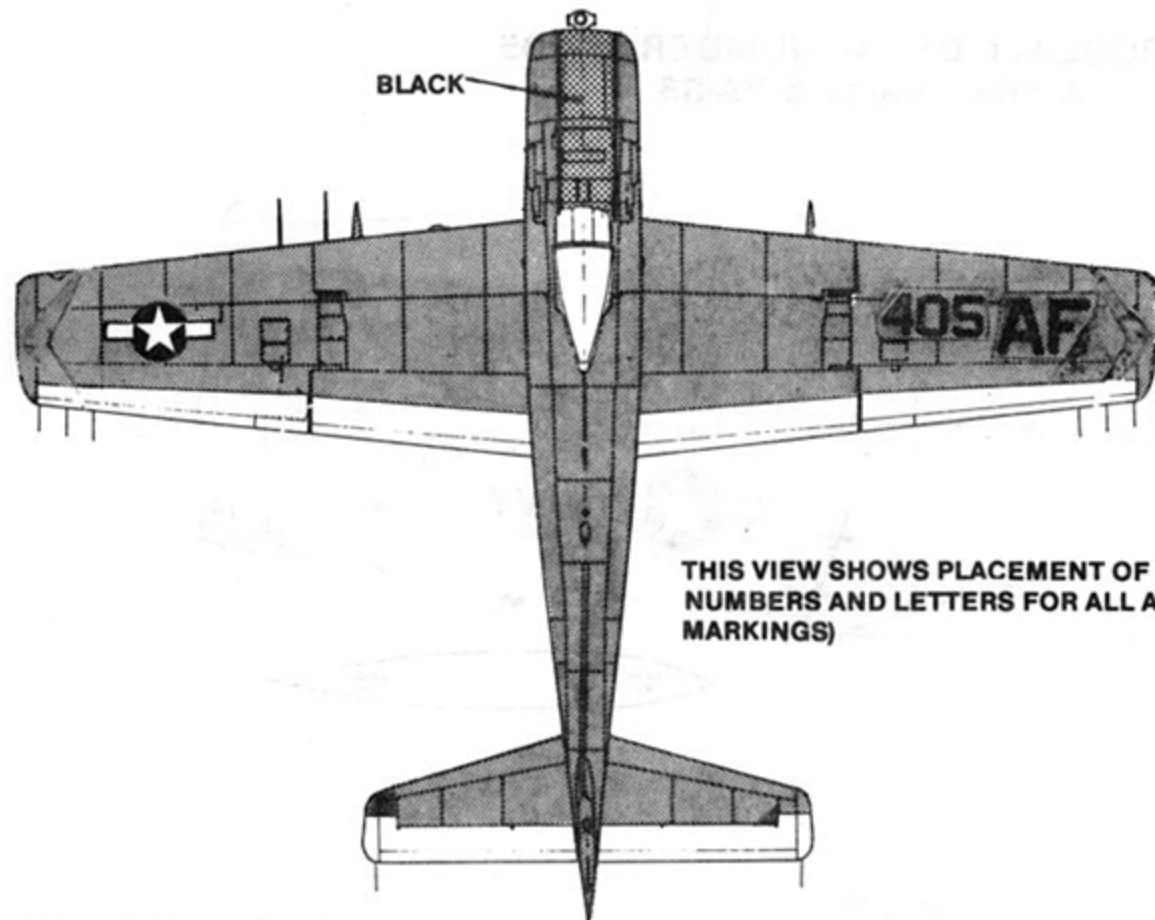
NATIONAL INSIGNIA IS ON UPPER PORT AND LOWER STARBOARD WINGS

**GENERAL PAINT SCHEME**

OVERALL UPPER AIRCRAFT IS LT. GULL GRAY EXCEPT AILERONS, FLAPS, AND ELEVATORS, WHICH ARE WHITE, THE OVERALL LOWER AIRCRAFT AND PODS ARE ALSO WHITE

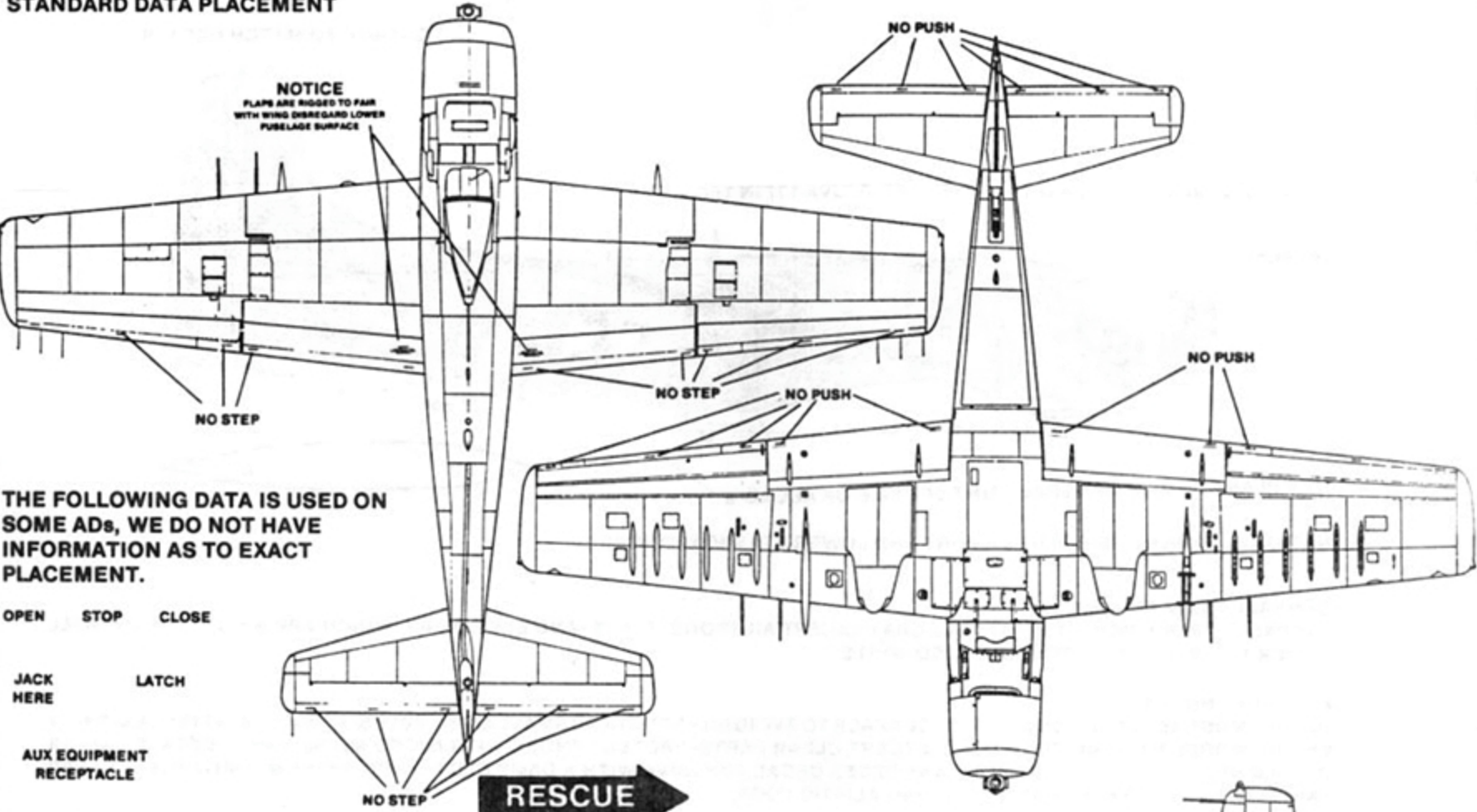
**FINISHING NOTES:**

DECALS MUST BE PLACED ON A GLOSSY SURFACE TO AVOID SILVERING AND SMALL AIR BUBBLES. IF MATT PAINT IS USED, PAINT ENTIRE MODEL WITH MICRO GLOSS. (EXCEPT CLEAR PARTS--PROTECT THOSE WITH MICRO MASK) APPLY DECALS. AFTER DECALS DRY COMPLETELY, REMOVE ANY EXCES DECAL ADHESIVE WITH A DAMP CLOTH, AND SPRAY MODEL (EXCEPT CLEAR PARTS) WITH MICRO FLAT FOR A TRUELY REALISTIC LOOK.
