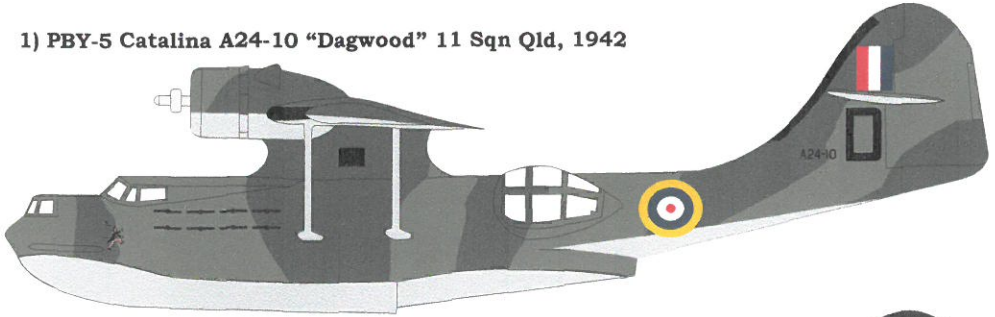


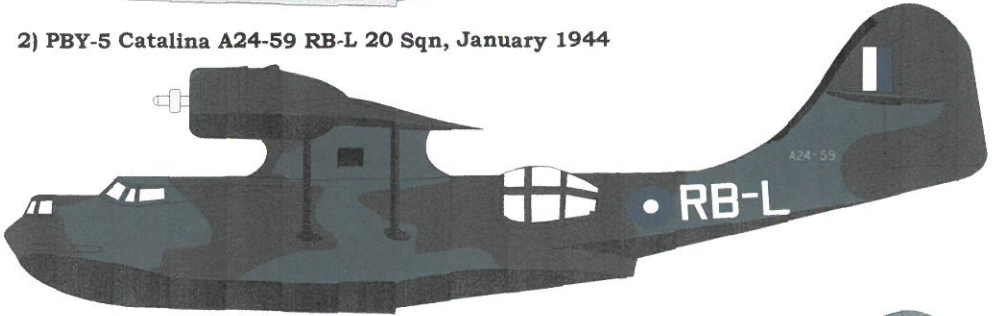

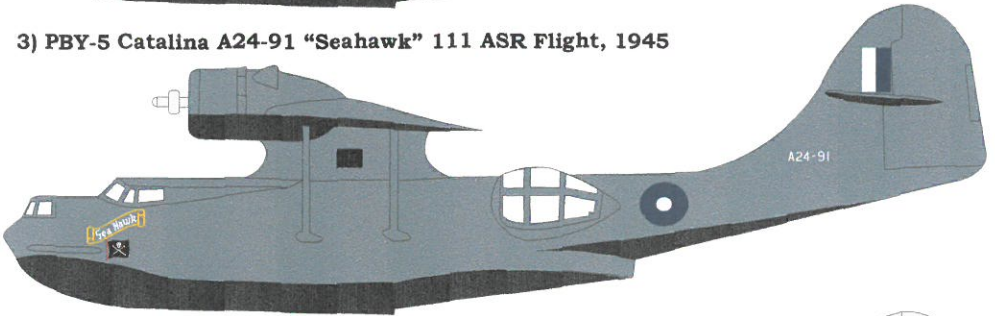
1) PBY-5 Catalina A24-10 "Dagwood" 11 Sqn Qld, 1942



2) PBY-5 Catalina A24-59 RB-L 20 Sqn, January 1944



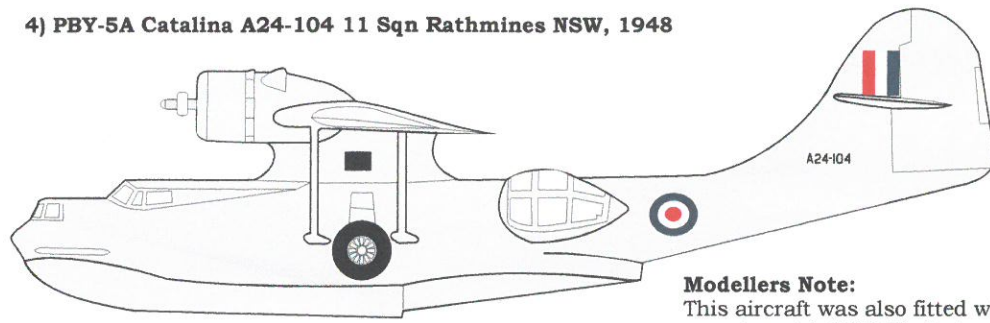
3) PBY-5 Catalina A24-91 "Seahawk" 111 ASR Flight, 1945



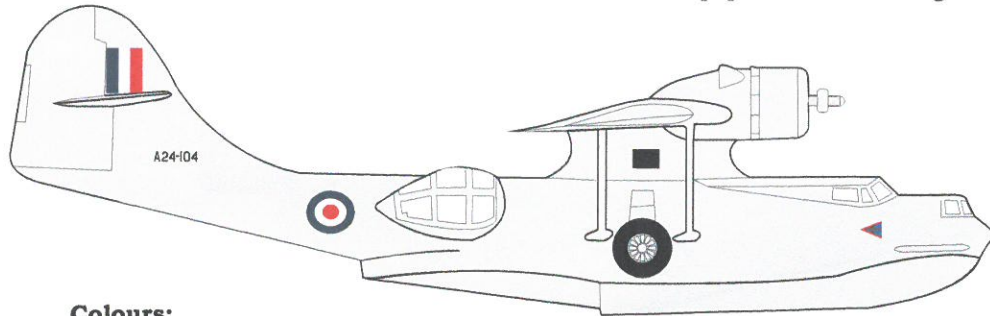

1) PBV-5 Catalina A24-10 "Dagwood" 11 Sqn Qld, 1942

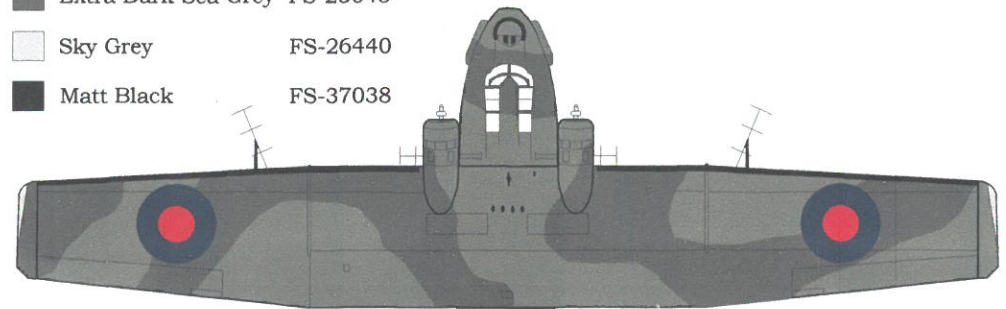


**Modellers Note:**  
There is conflicting opinions whether the D was worn on the Tail surface of this aircraft although this was standard practise for this squadron.



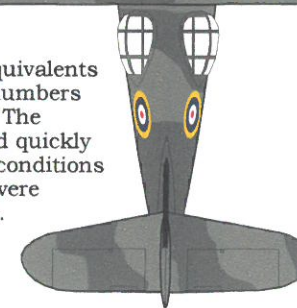

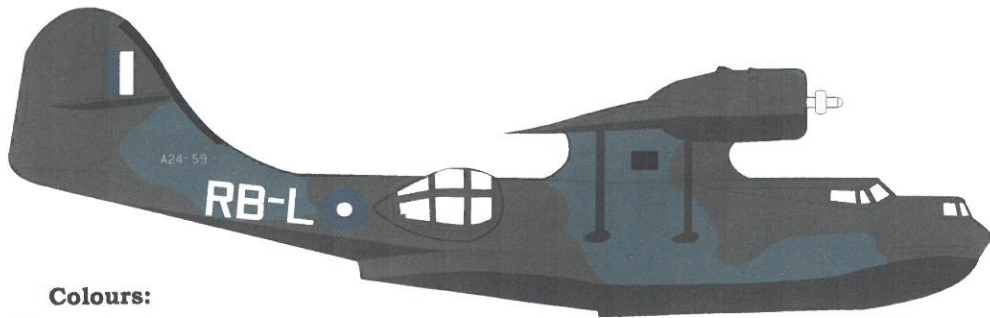
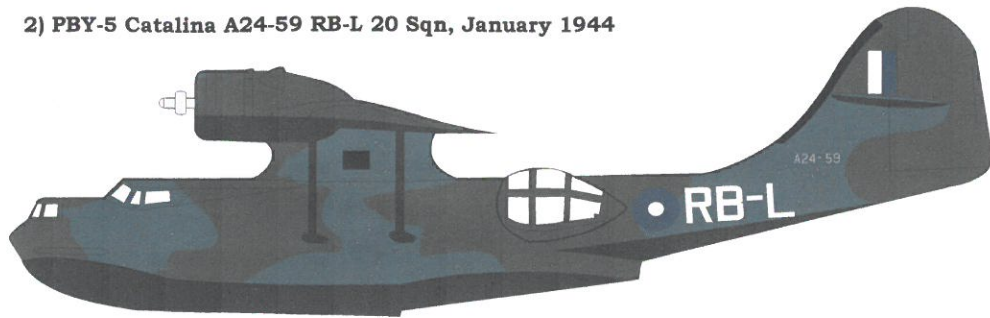
**Modellers Note:**

This aircraft did not carry Underwing Roundels.



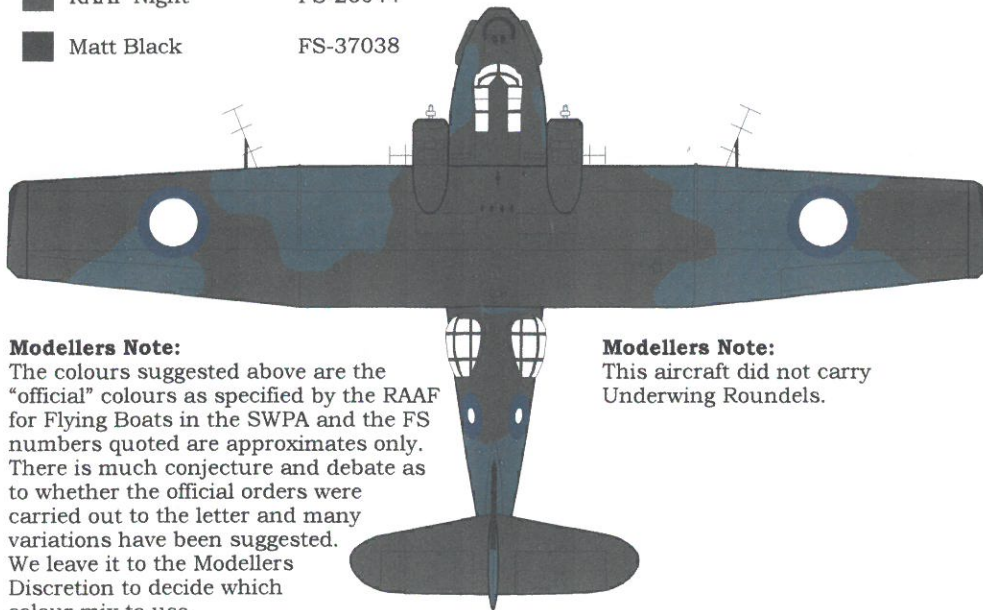


2) PBY-5 Catalina A24-59 RB-L 20 Sqn, January 1944

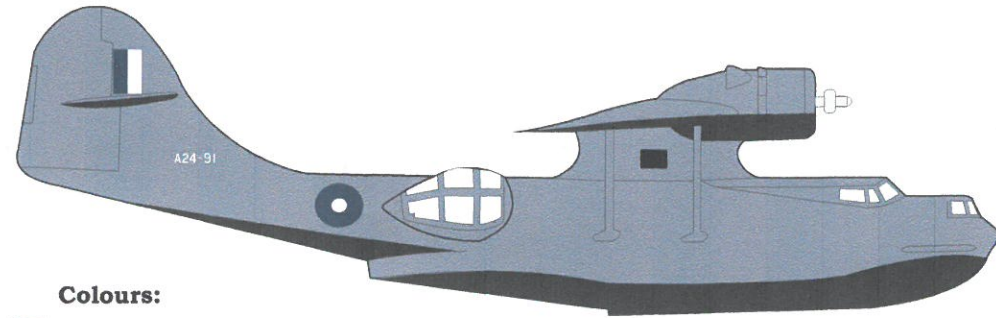
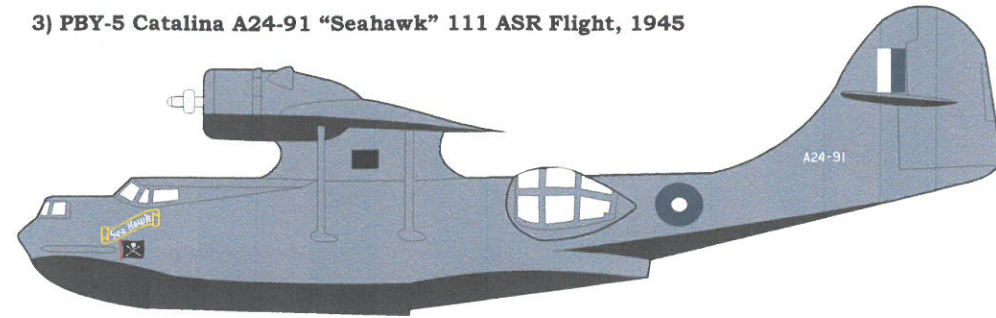
**Modellers Note:**
