DECALS FOR 1/48 SCALE DC-3



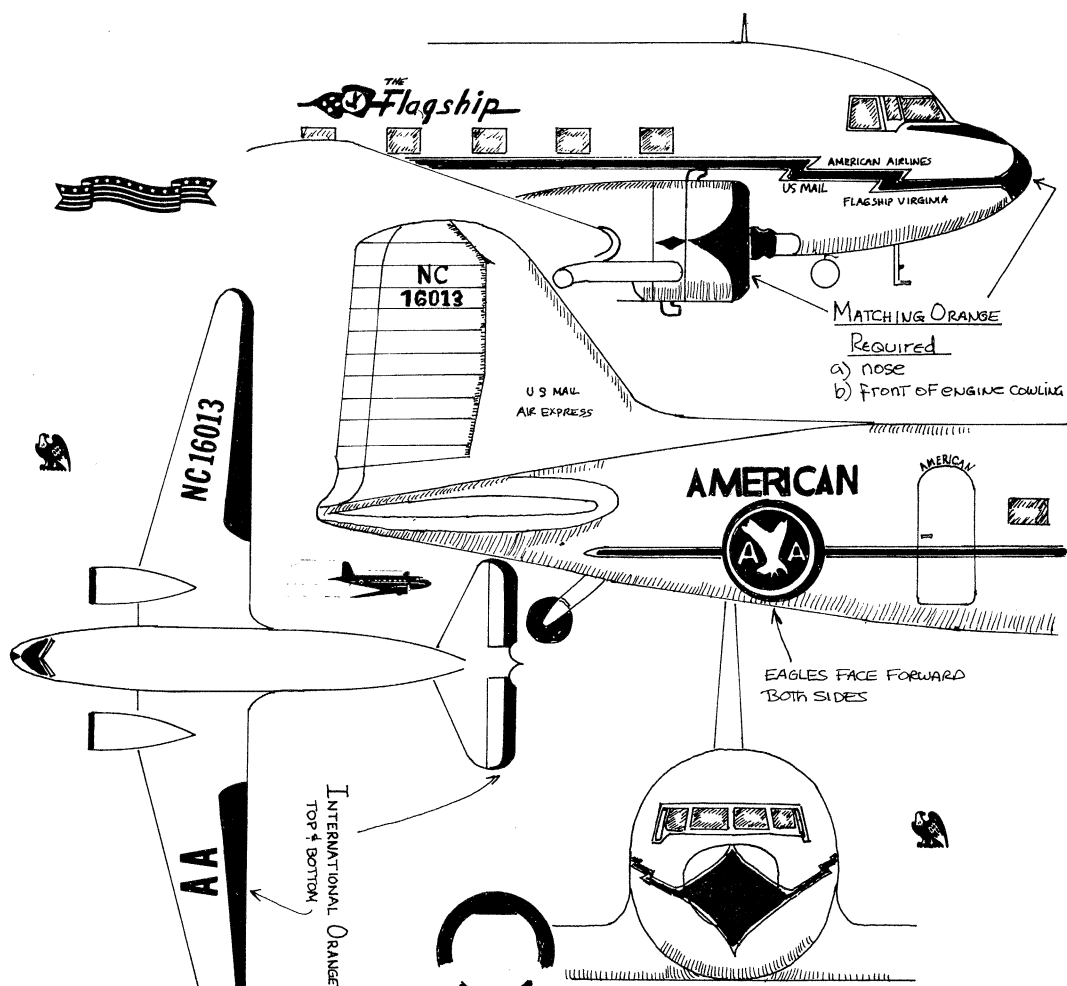
INSTRUCTIONS

Your Monogram C-47 will have to be converted to a DC-3 prior to using our American Airlines decals. We suggest that you consult the references listed on the other side of this sheet before beginning work on the conversion. Basically, you will need to attend to the following items:

1. CARGO DOOR. Break off hinges provided and cement in place. Fill gaps around outside edge and scribing of door outlines with putty. Scribe panel lines to match those on fuselage surrounding the door.
2. ADD 7th window on port side, just forward of cargo door.
3. Remove dome-base from top of fuselage just behind cockpit area. Plug hole with plastic disc, fill with putty, sand smooth.
4. Add door on starboard side (optional) or use decal provided on sheet.
5. Air intake (upper cowling) and oil cooler (lower cowling) must be modified. See references.
6. Color of aircraft is natural metal overall.
7. To apply decals, cut each image as close as possible to its edge, dip in warm water for a few seconds, and apply to model. Press firmly with light cloth to remove air bubbles, or use a decal softening agent.
8. To complete markings, use TESTOR'S INTERNATIONAL ORANGE to match orange on these decals. Surfaces to be painted include elevator, ailerons and nose of aircraft.
