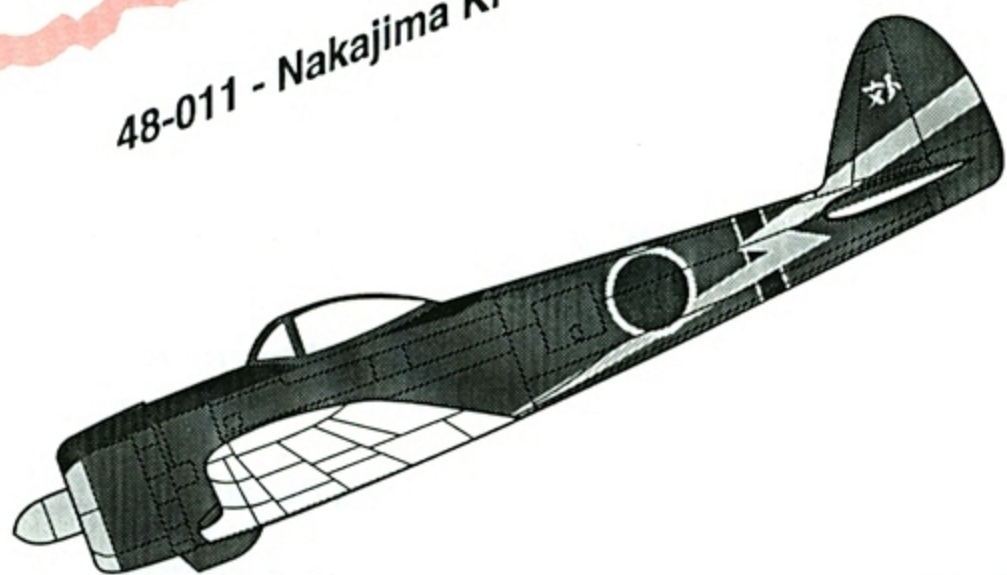

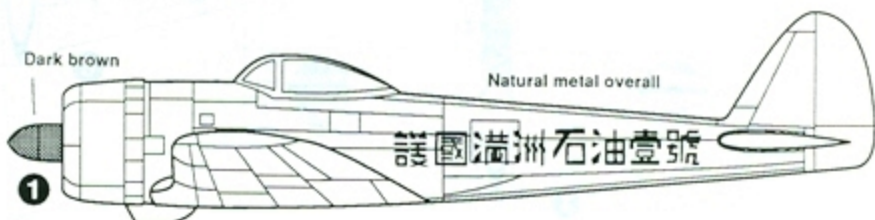

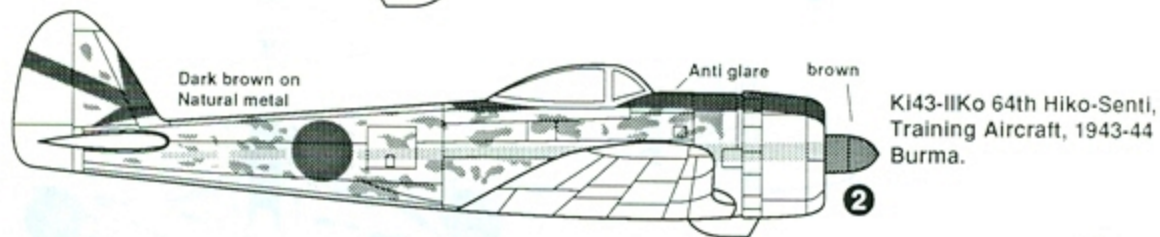

NOTE: Hinomarus have not been included on this sheet so we could give you decals to build six different versions. Hinomarus can be used from the kit or purchased separately.

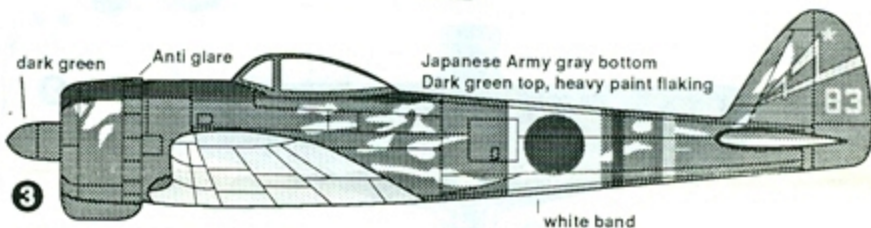
Ki43-IIK6 Manchoukuo

AB/Manchuria



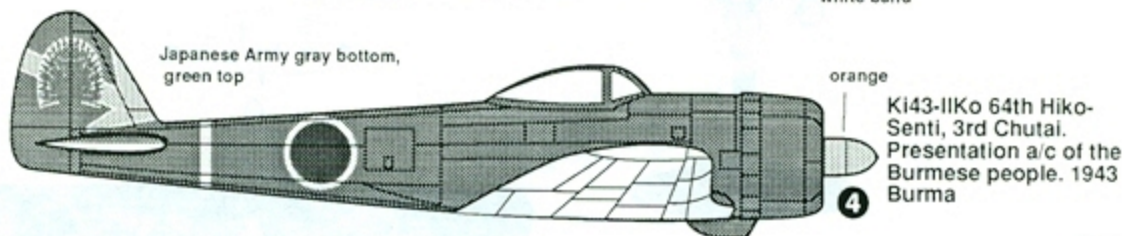
Ki43-IIKo 64th Hiko-Sentai,

Burma.



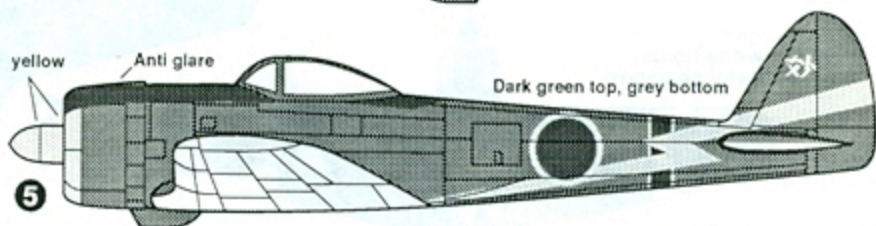
Ki43-I 47th Independent

Chofu AB/Tokyo.



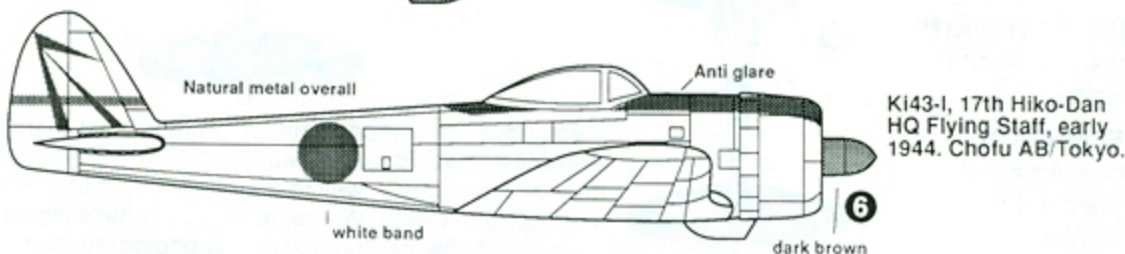
Ki43-IIKo 64th Hiko-Sentai,

August 1943, Malaya



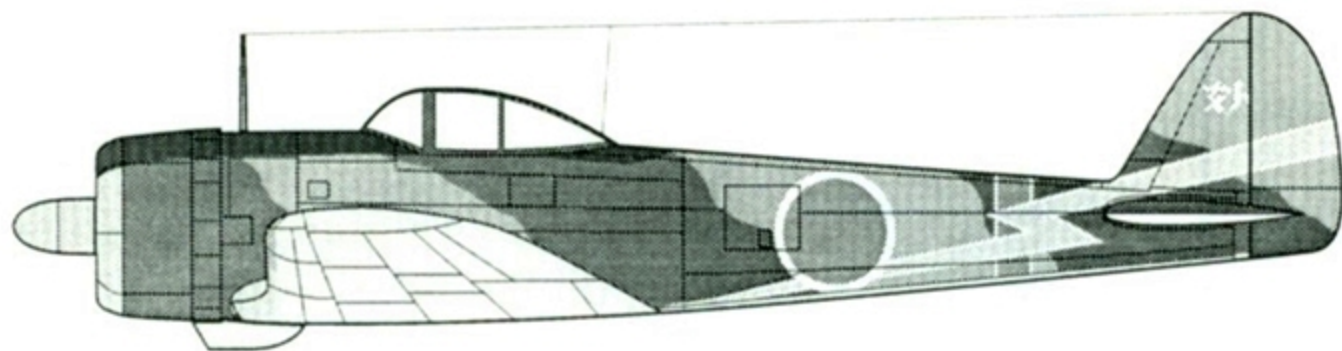
Ki43-I, 17th Hiko-Dan

1944. Chofu AB/Tokyo.



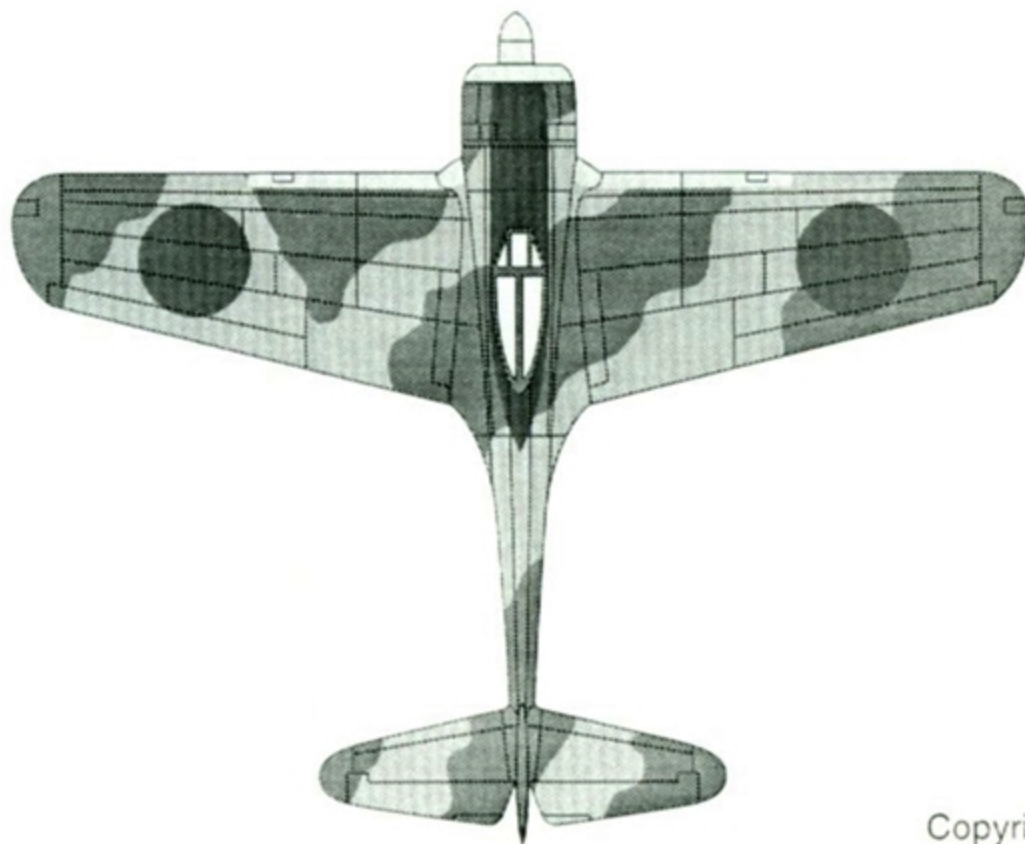
