

F-3A (A-20J) 155th night photo sqn. 10th Photo Recon Group. Pilot Lt. Clifford Mackie. A/C named for Mackie's girlfriend and later wife. A/C lost in September 5, 1944 with Lt. William Fleur at the controls. Olive Drab over Neutral Gray with Green 42 over leading and trailing edges of fliyng surfaces. D-Day bands only on undersurfaces. Note Flat Black propeller blades, hubs and Natural Metal prop. bosses.

Boston III of 22nd Sqdn, RAAF. Vivigani Strip, Goodenough Island, February 1943. Dark Green and Dark Earth upper surfaces with Med. Sea Gray lower surfaces.

Note: prop hub removed to show decal placement. Flat Black propeller blades, hubs and Natural Metal propeller
