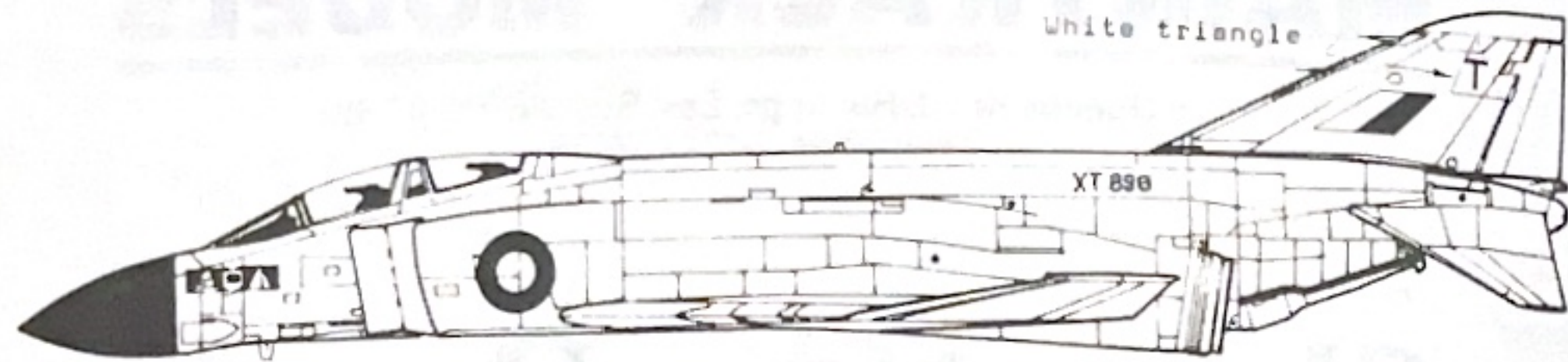
Instructions for use:

Using sharp pointed blade, cut out decal to be affixed, and position tacky-side down against surface of model. When you are certain the decal is correctly positioned, release backing sheet by placing a drop of water on the backing paper. After a few seconds, the backing paper may be wiped away.

**IMPORTANT:** Once the decal is wetted, it is fixed on the surface of the model and cannot be moved. Ensure position is correct before releasing the backing paper. Protect the tacky surface of the sheet when not in use, to prevent accumulation of dirt.

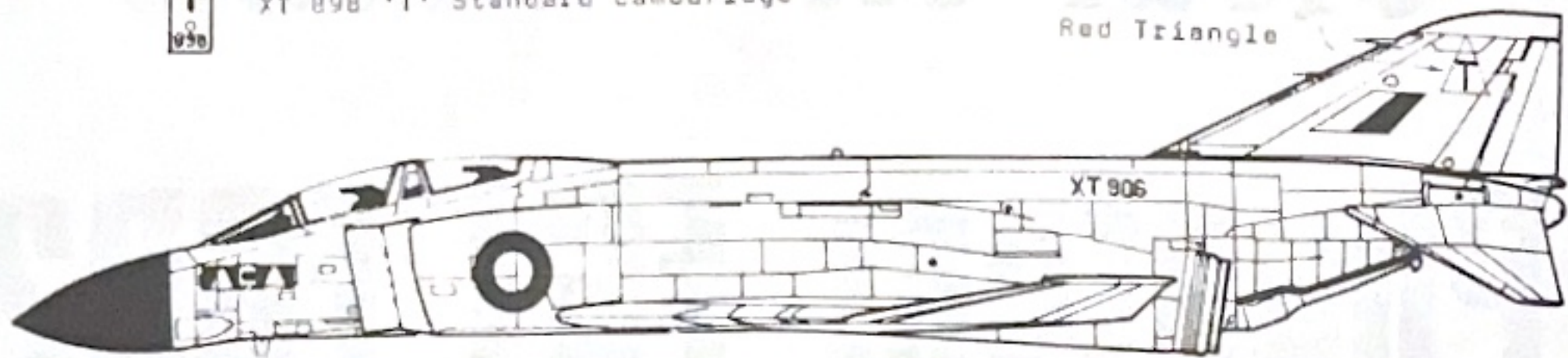

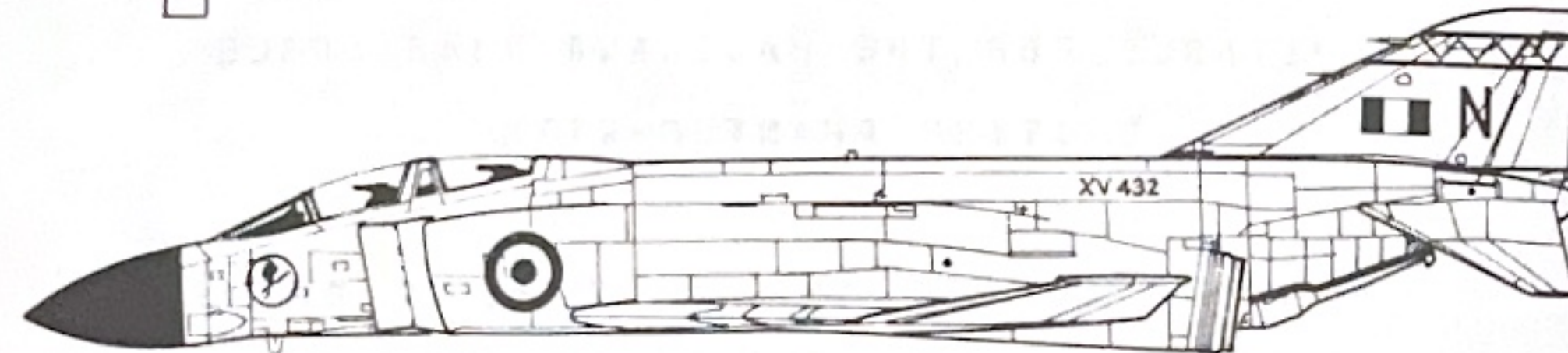

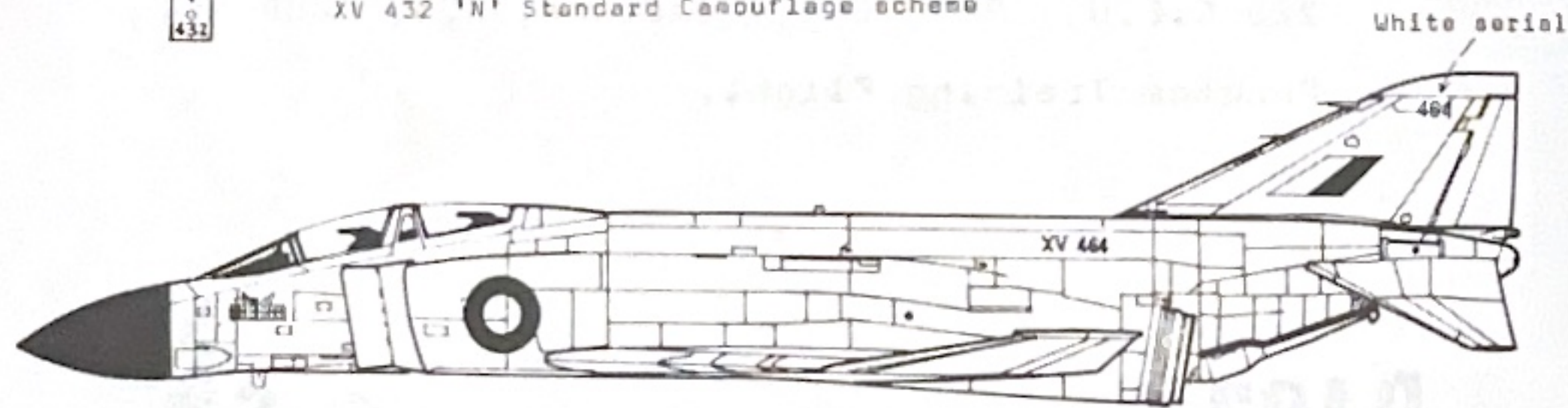
Red Triangle

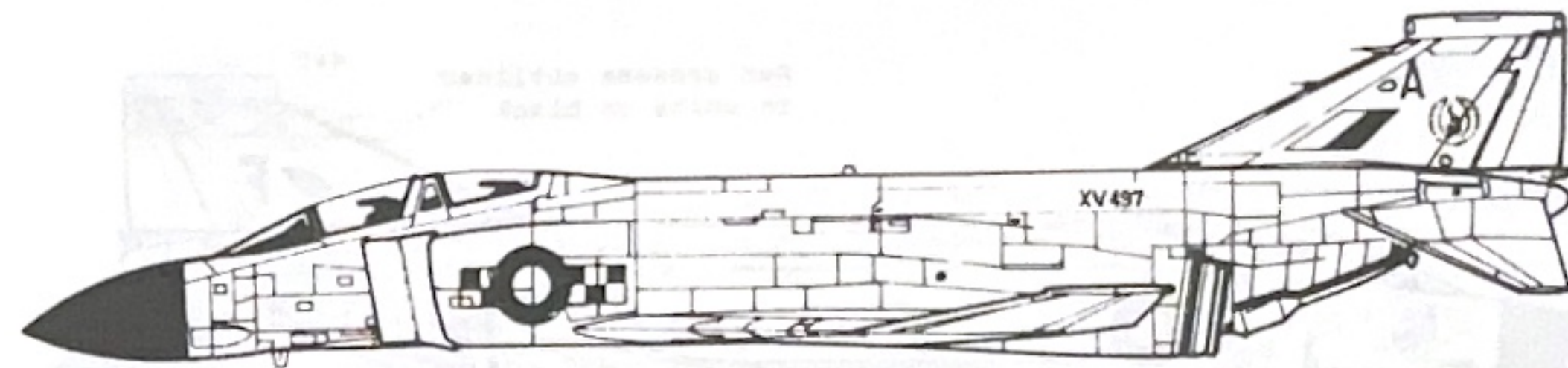

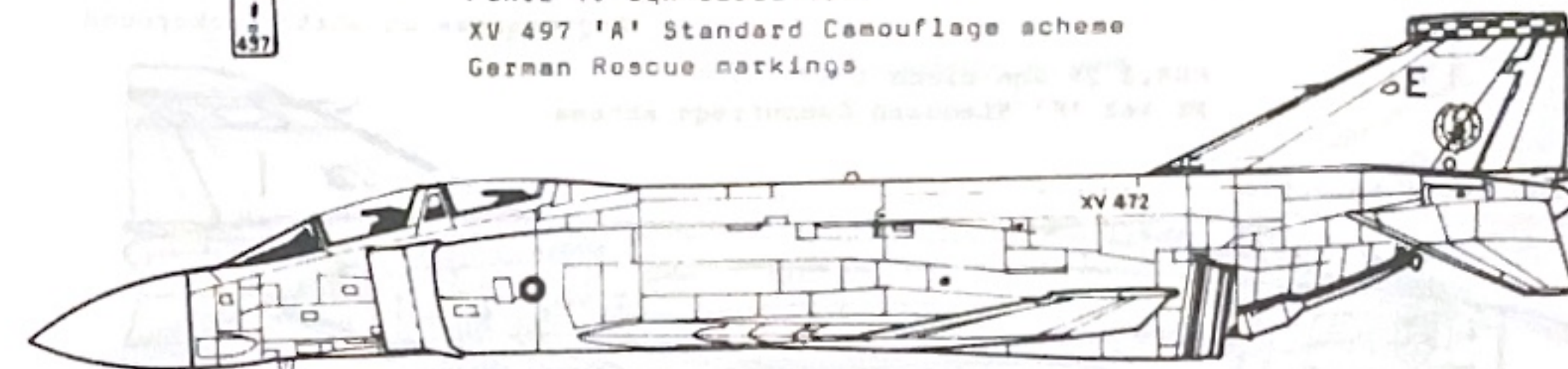

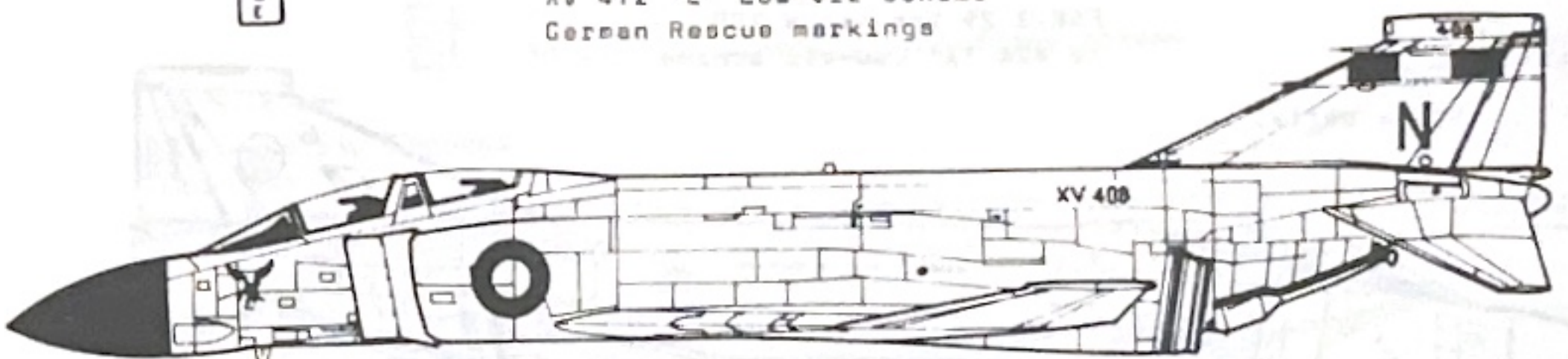

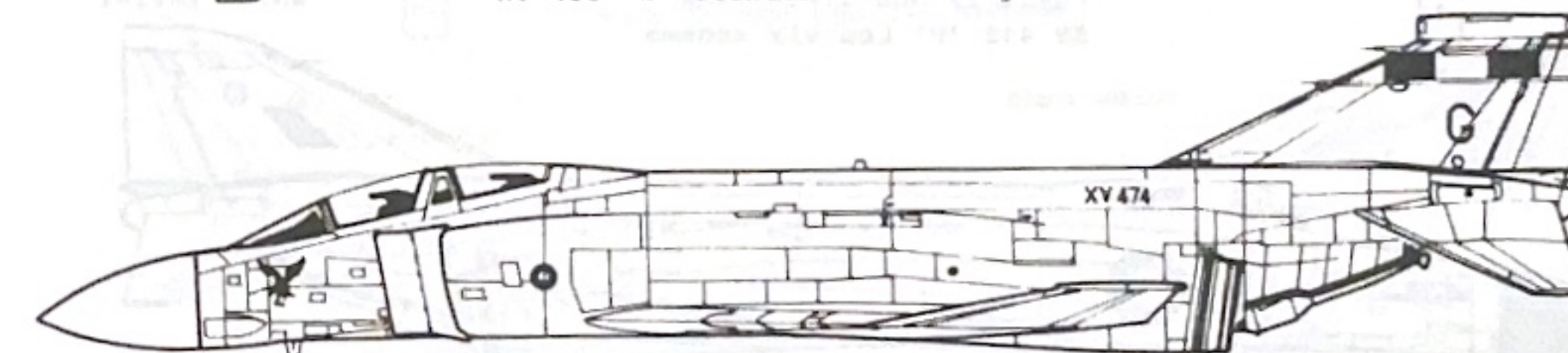

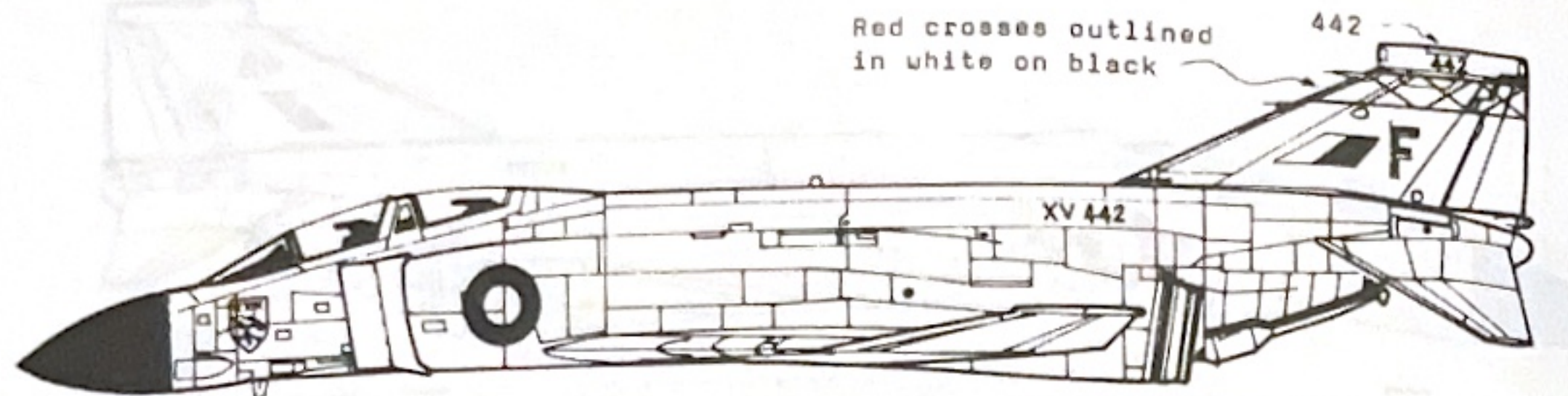

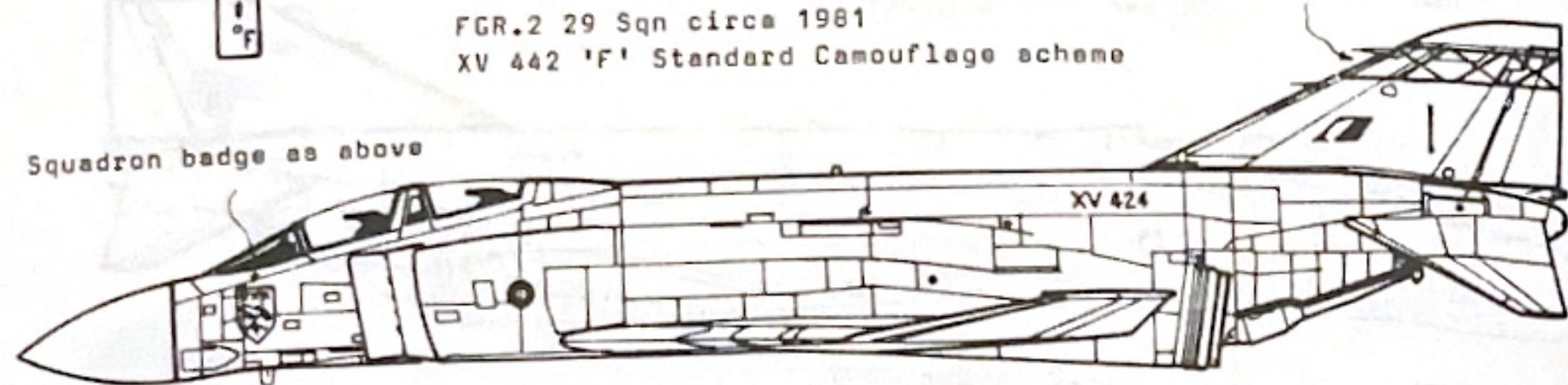

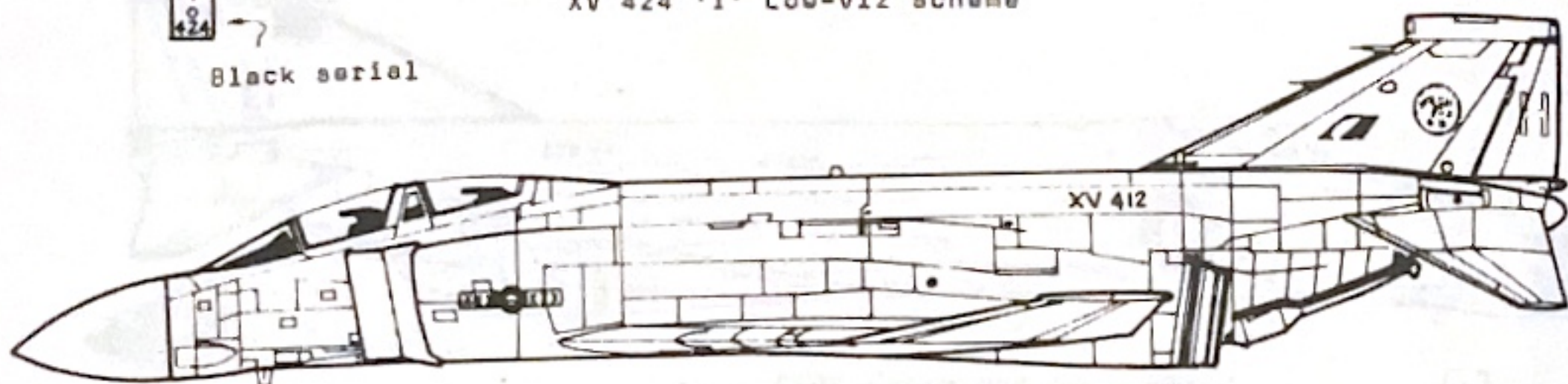

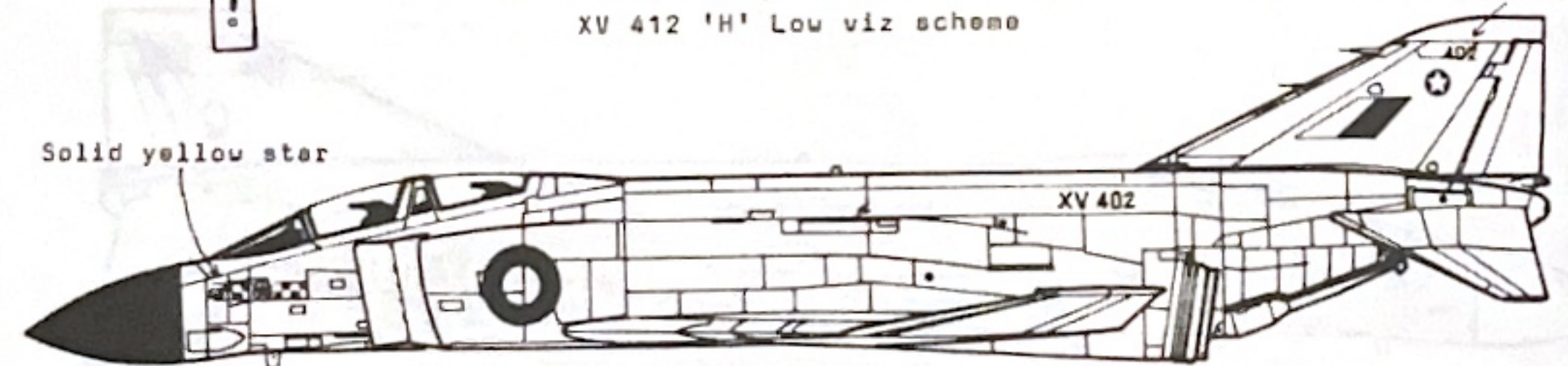

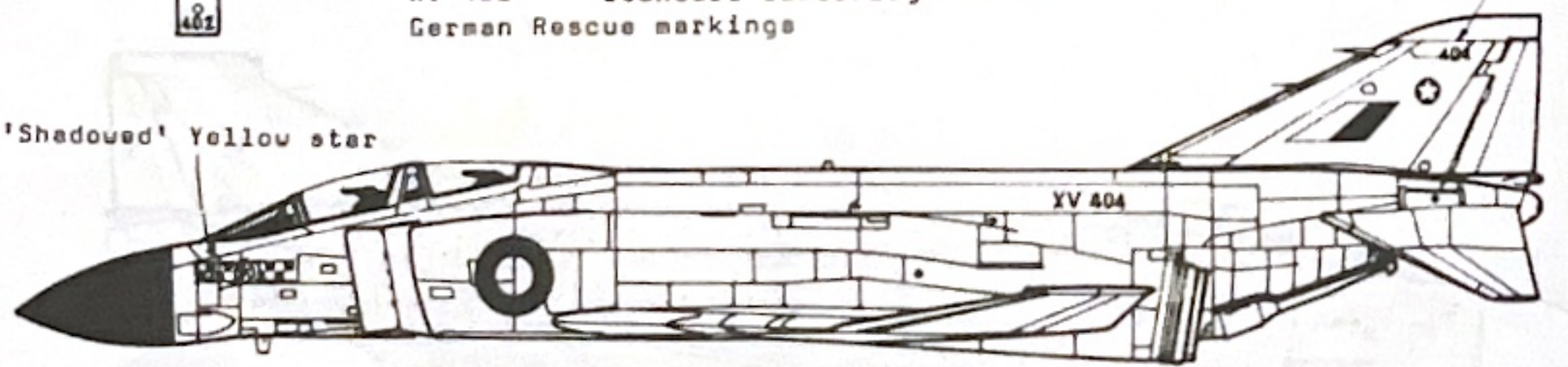

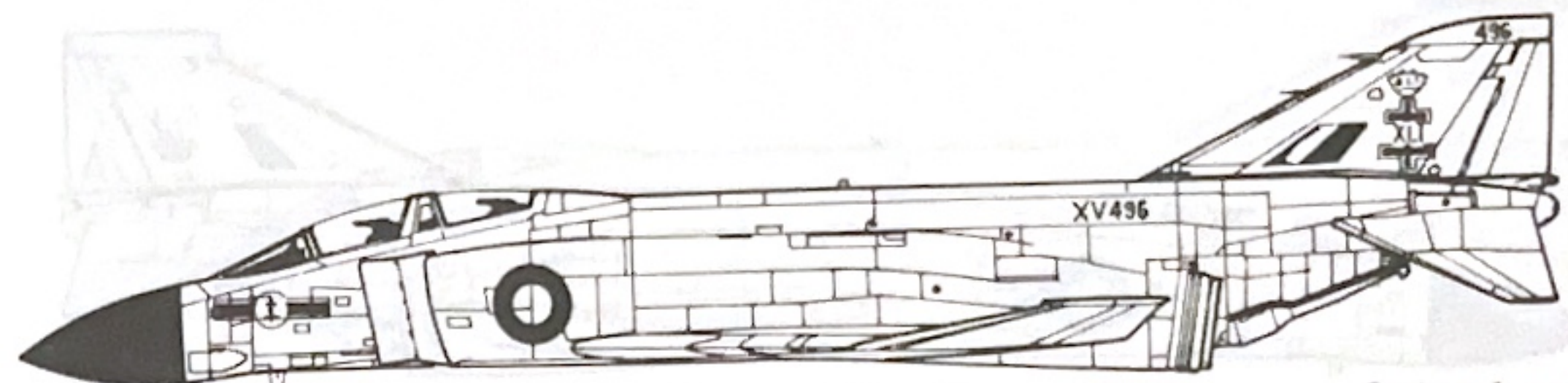


FGR.2 31 Sqn

'Shadowed' Yellow star

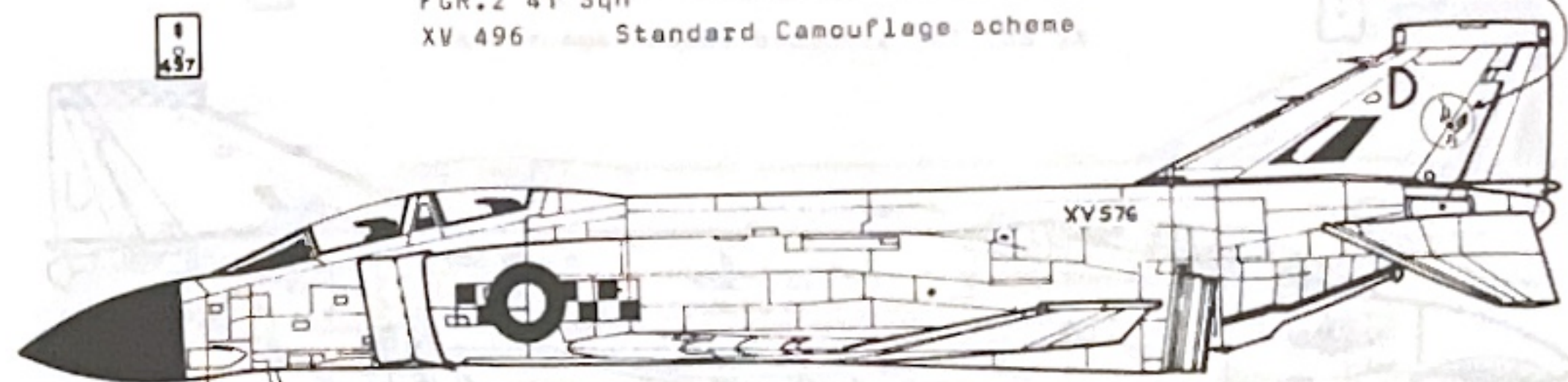

German Rescue markings



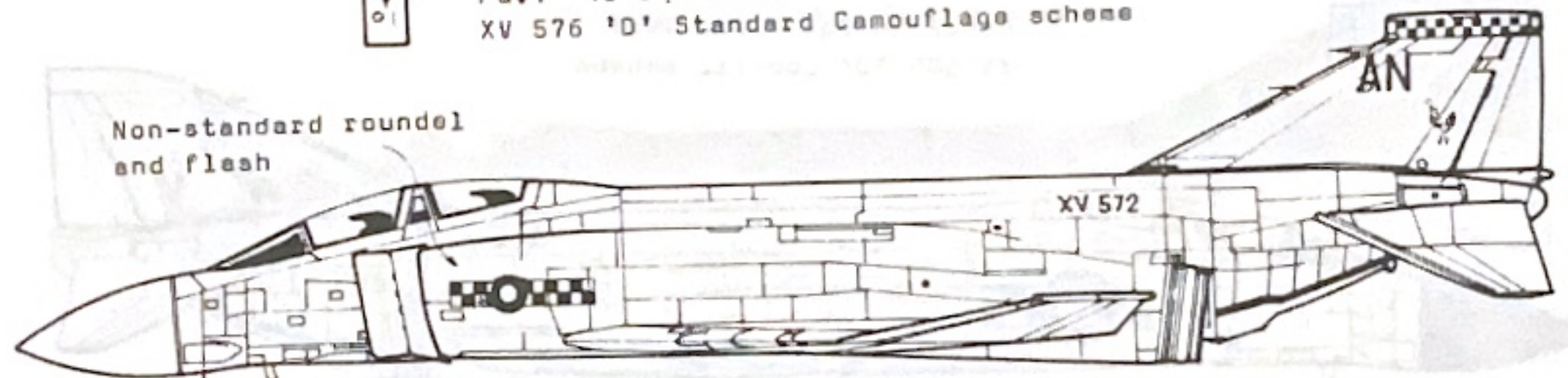

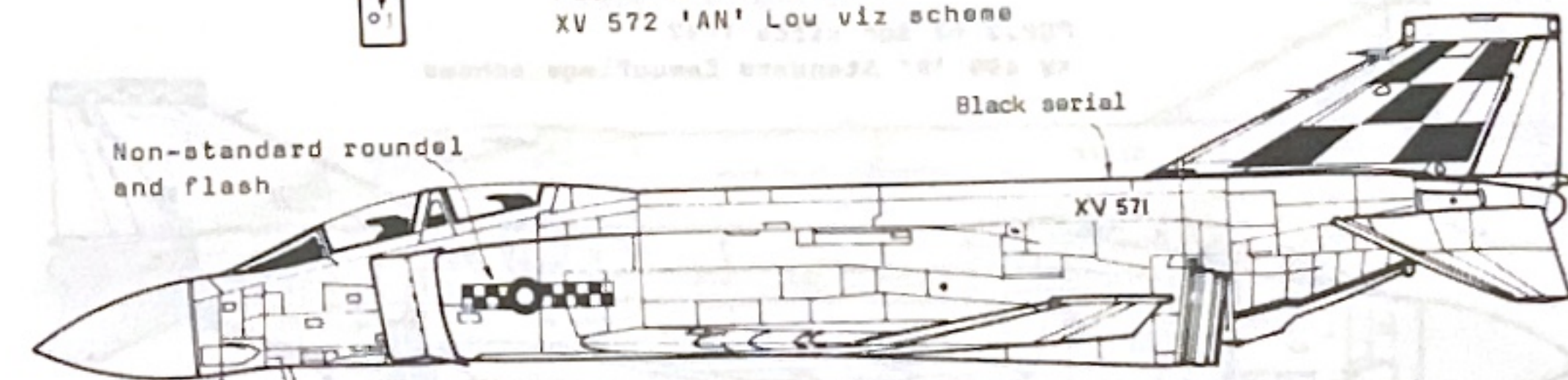
FG.1 43 Sqn 1978

and flesh

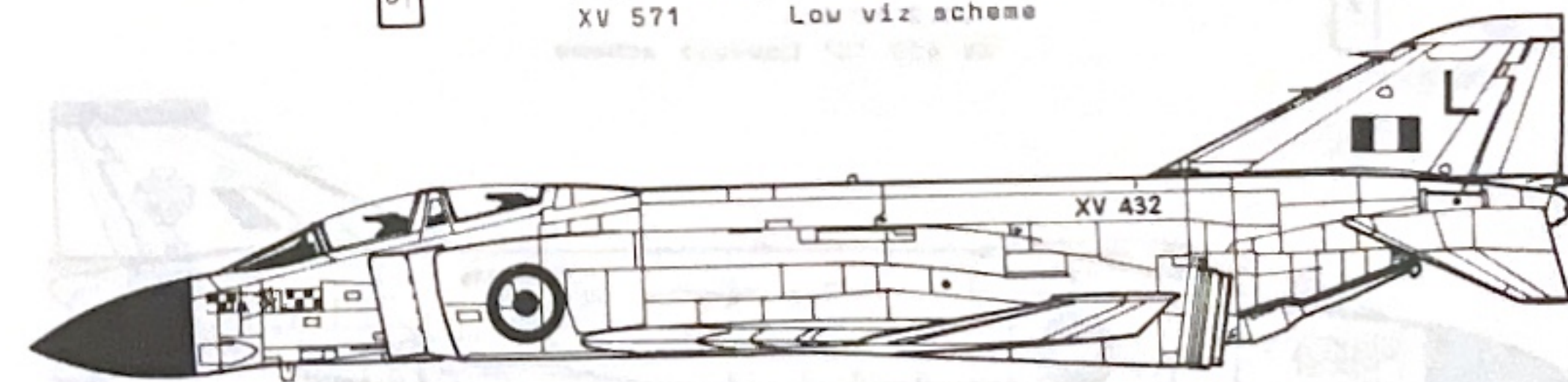


FG.1 43 Sqn 1987

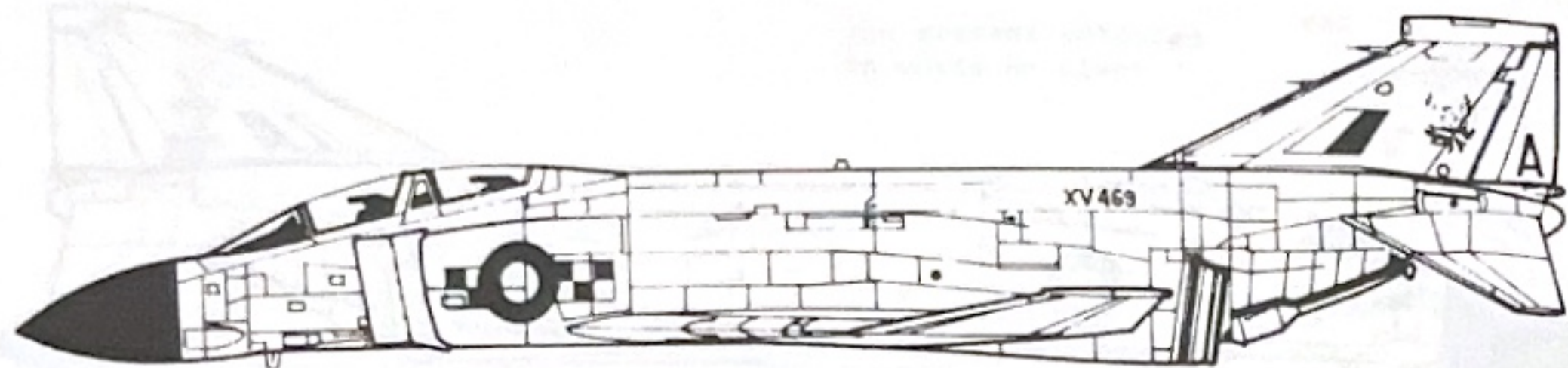


FG.1 43 Sqn C.O.'s special  
XV 571 Low viz scheme

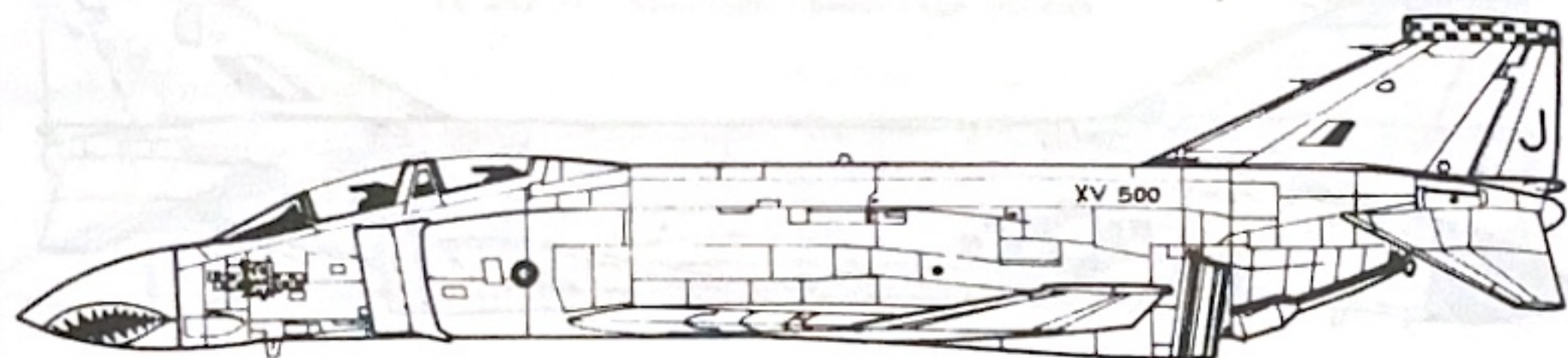

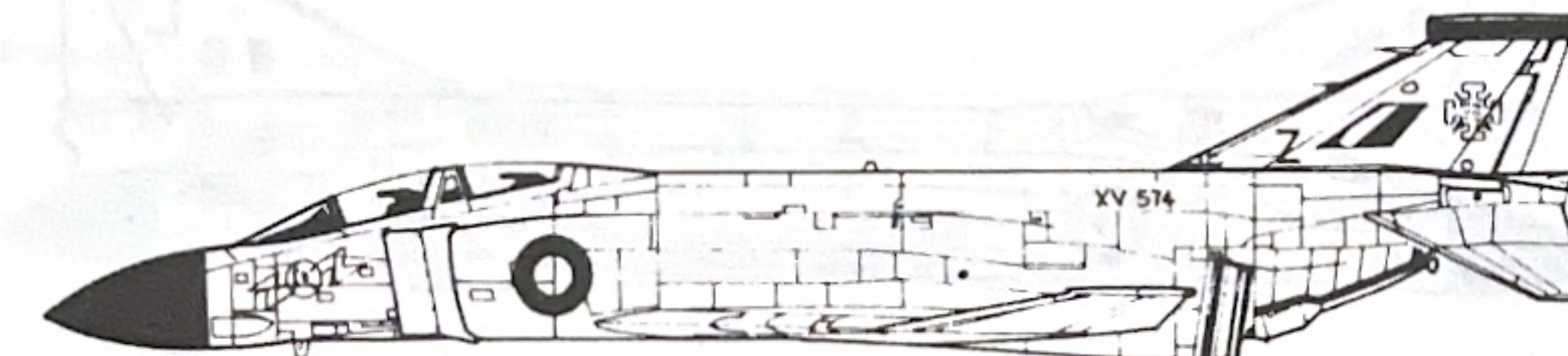

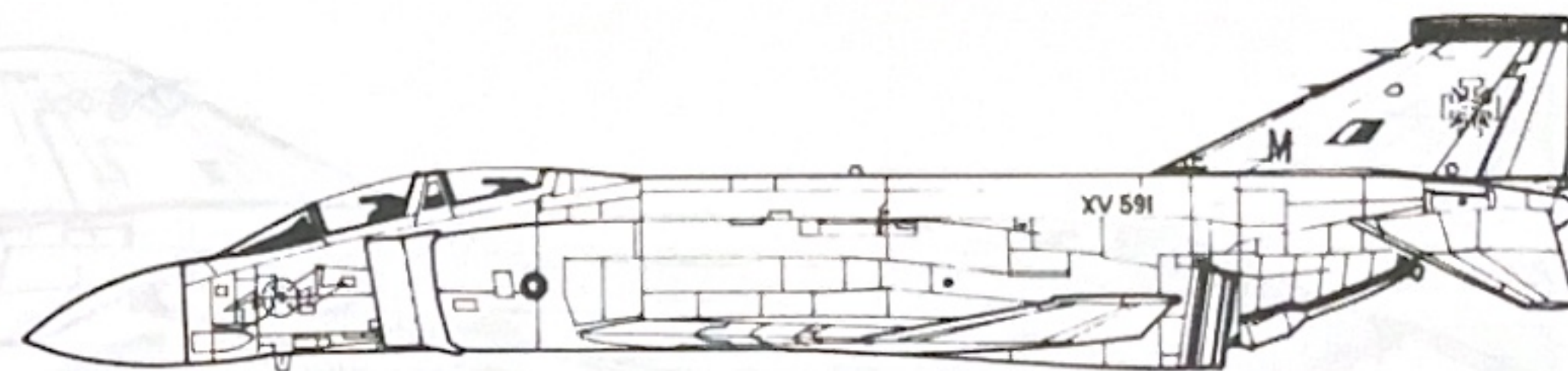

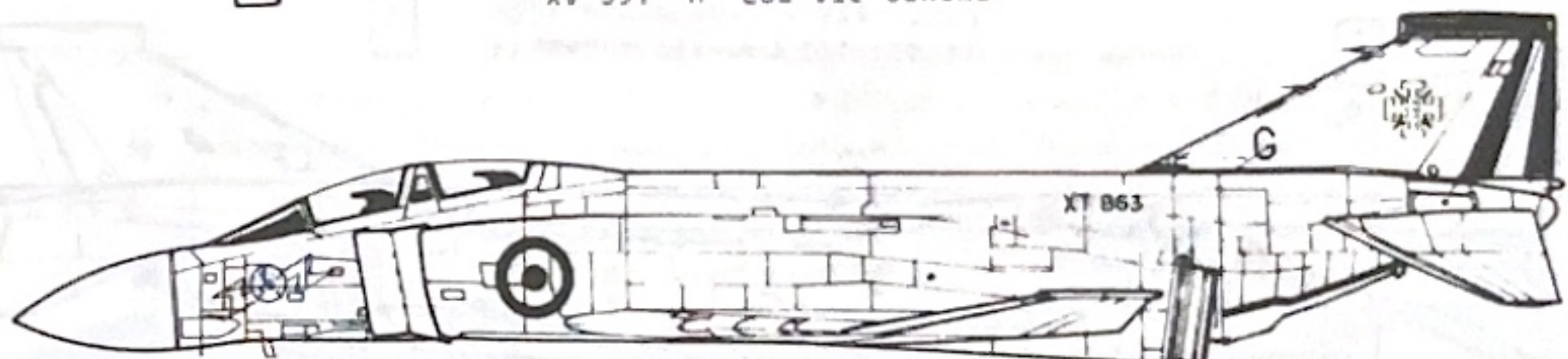

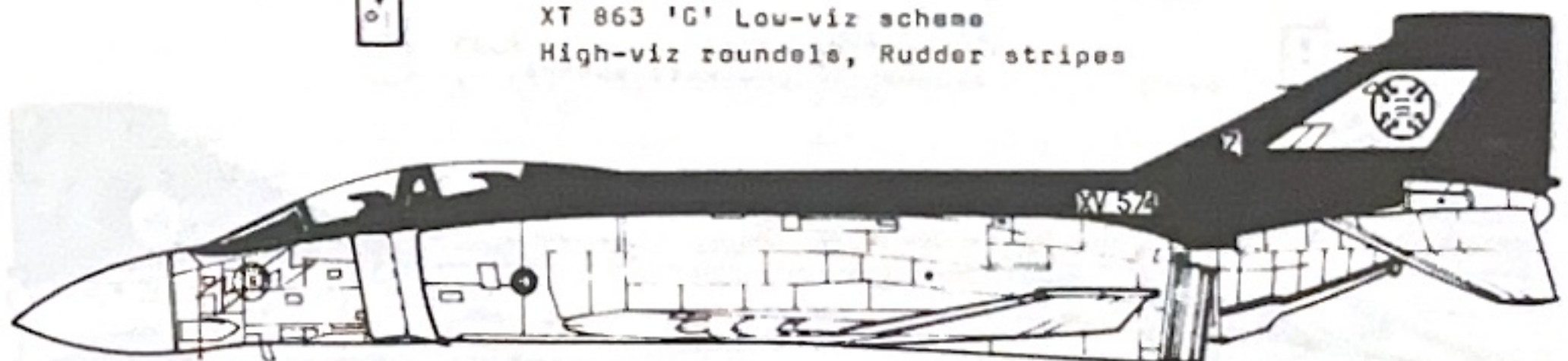

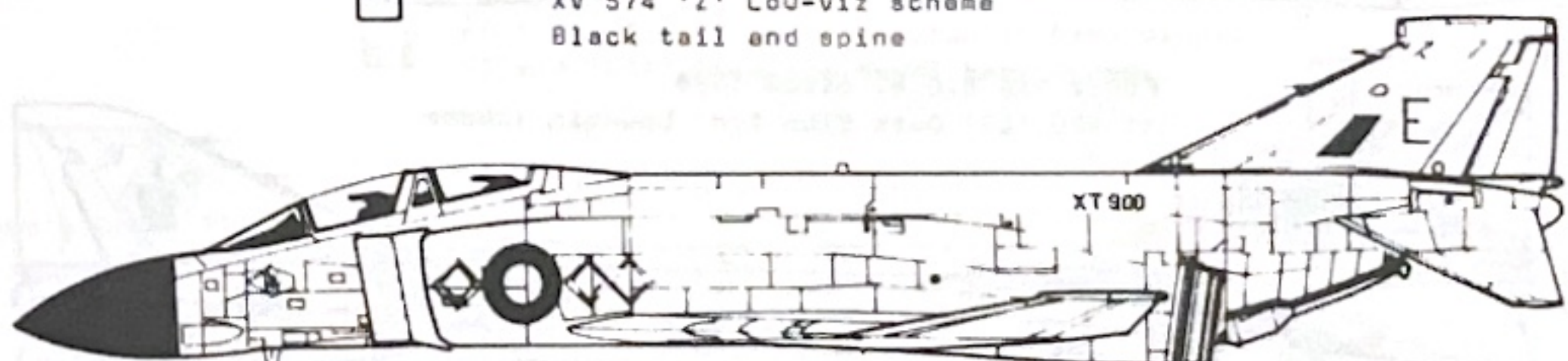

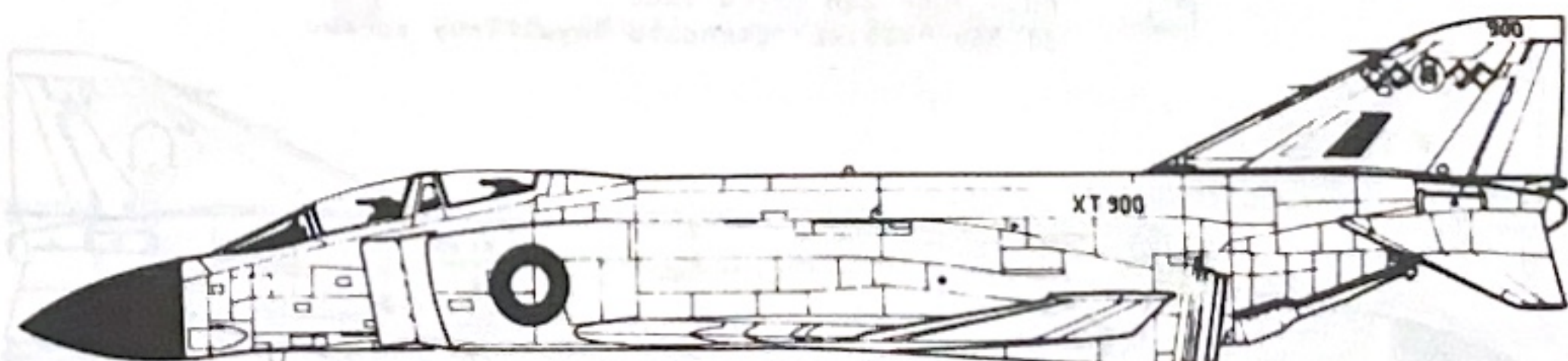

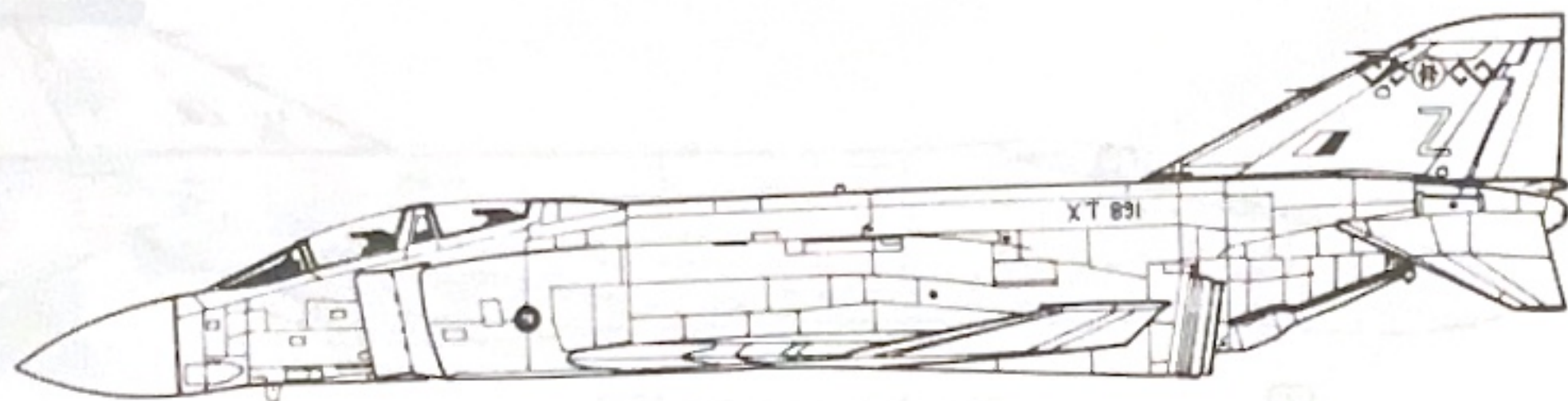

XT 900 'C' Standard Camouflage scheme

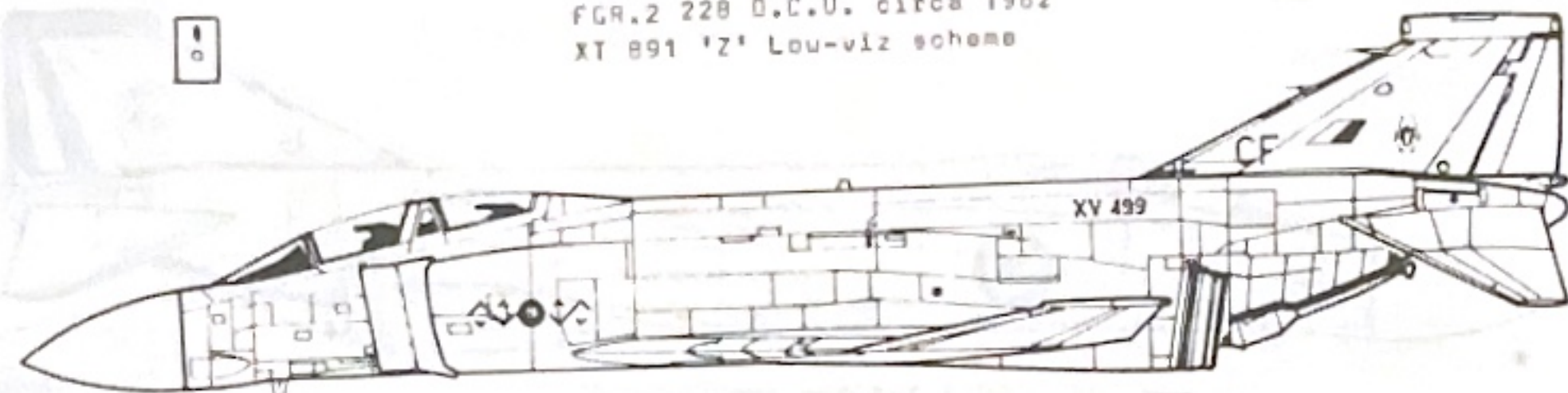

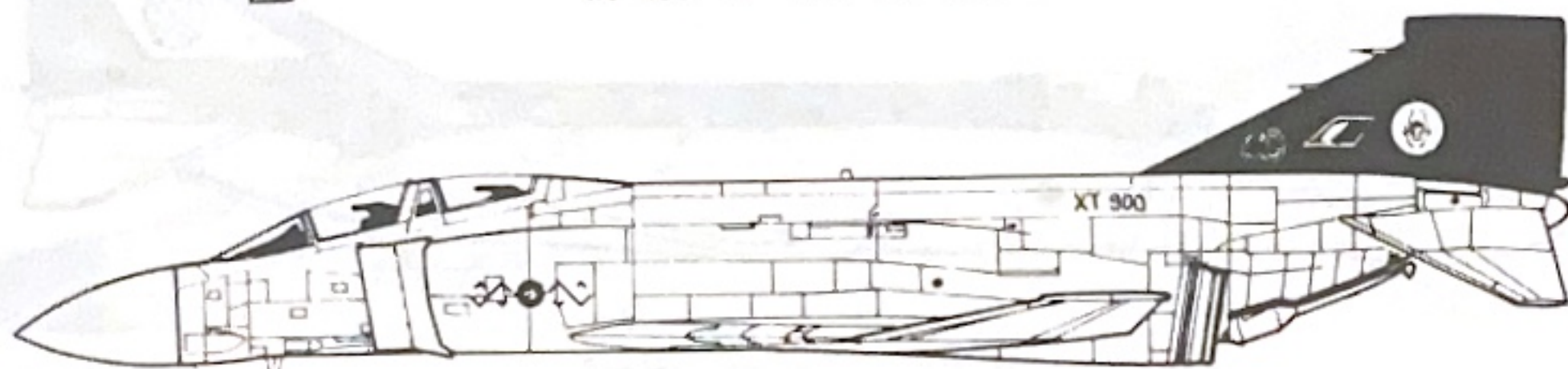




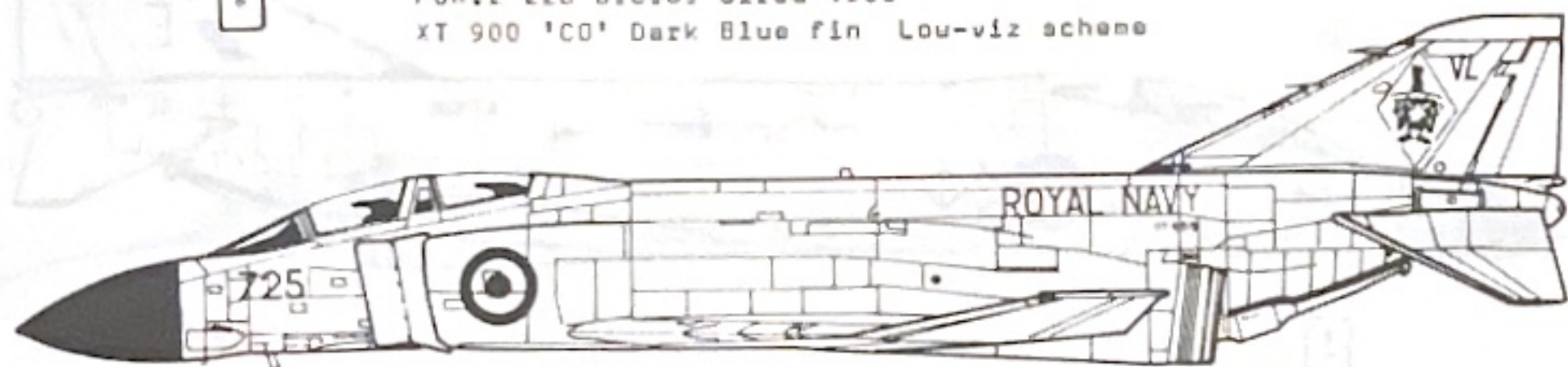

XT 891 'Z' Low-viz scheme



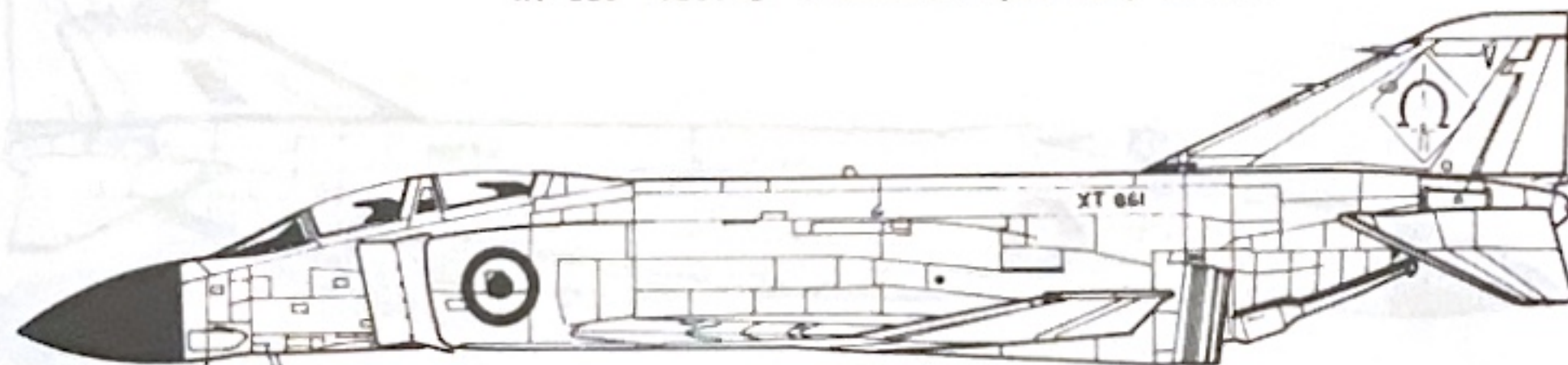

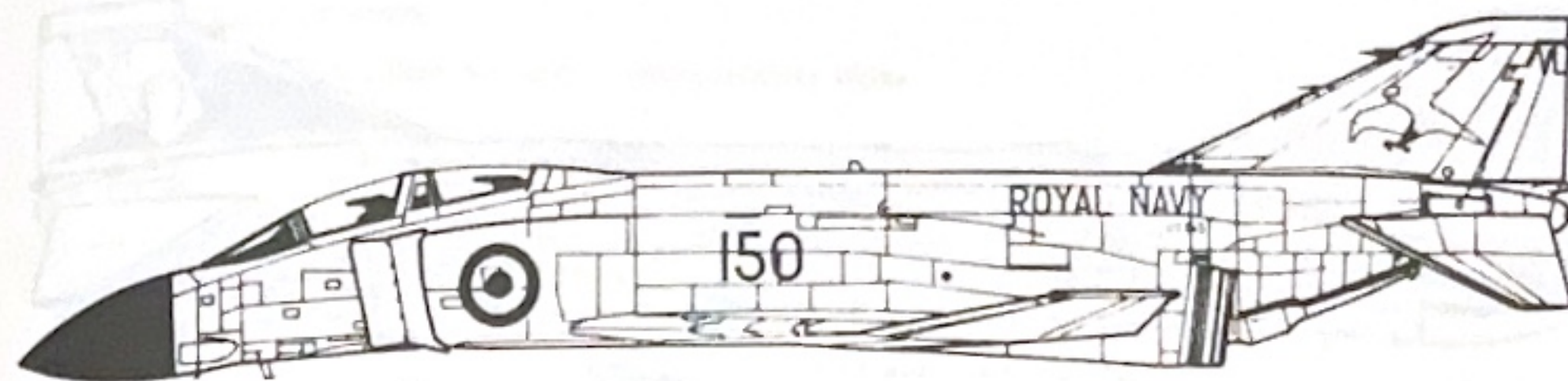

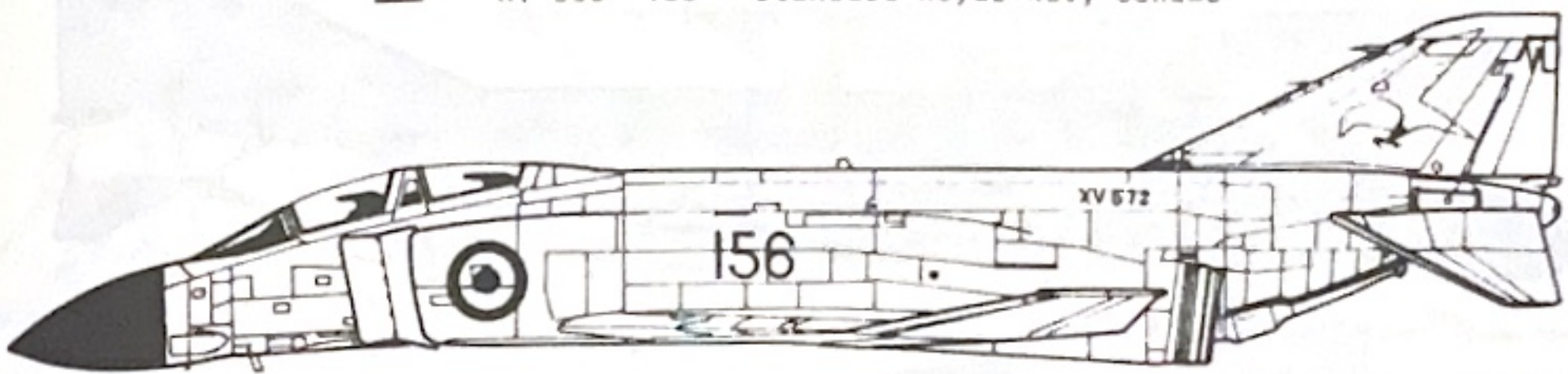

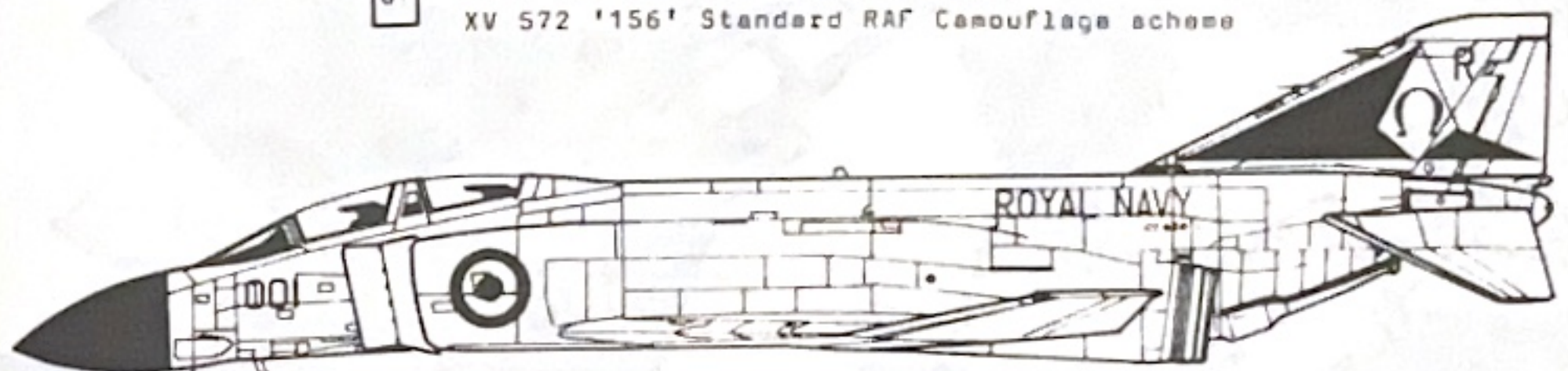

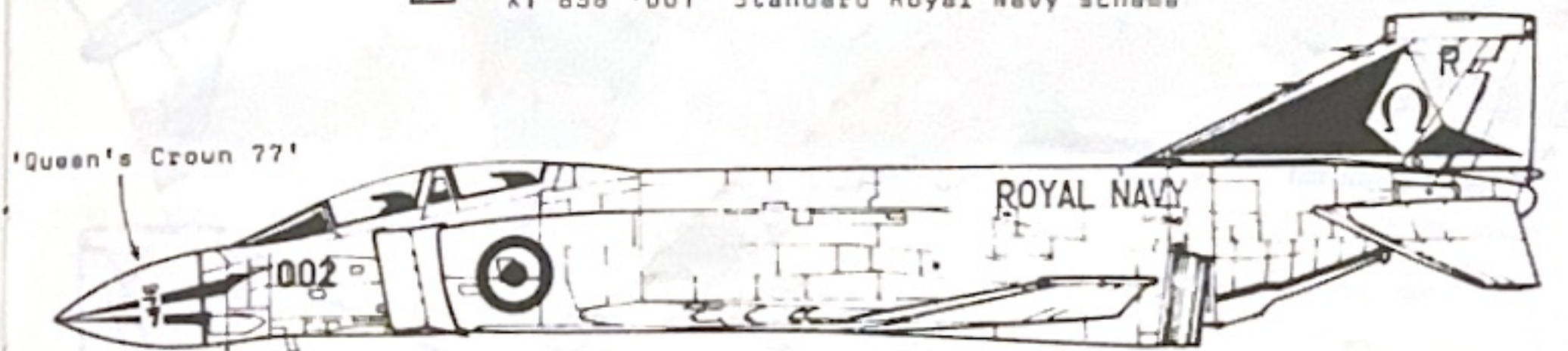

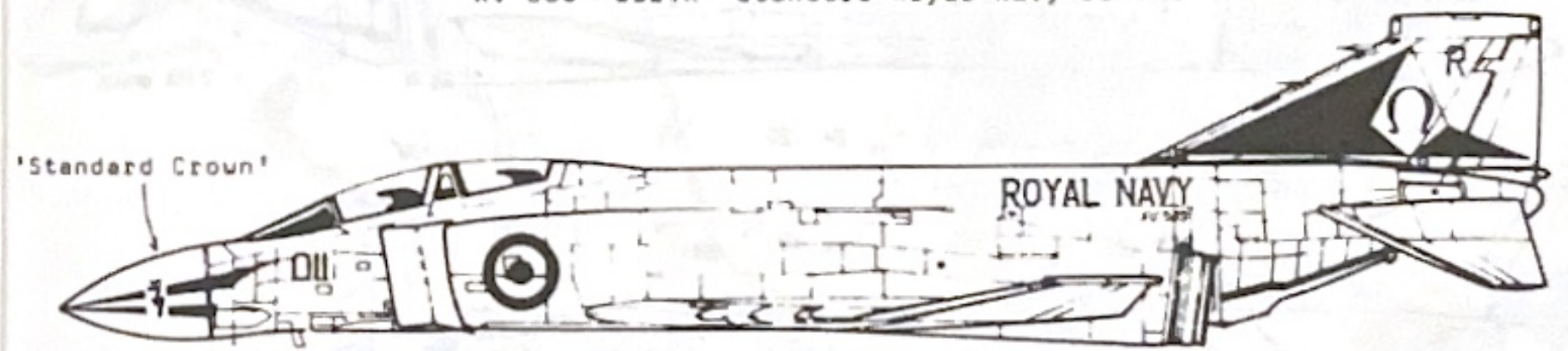

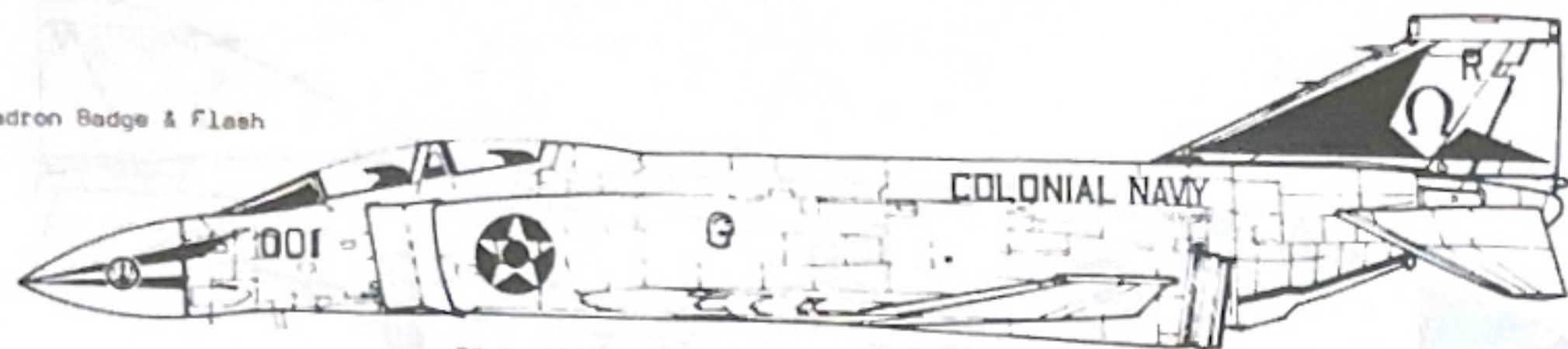

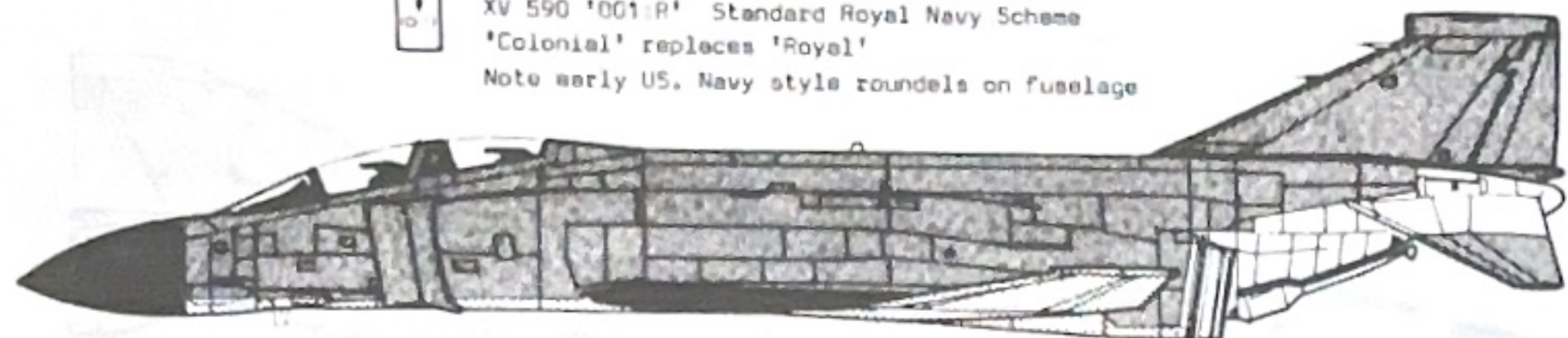

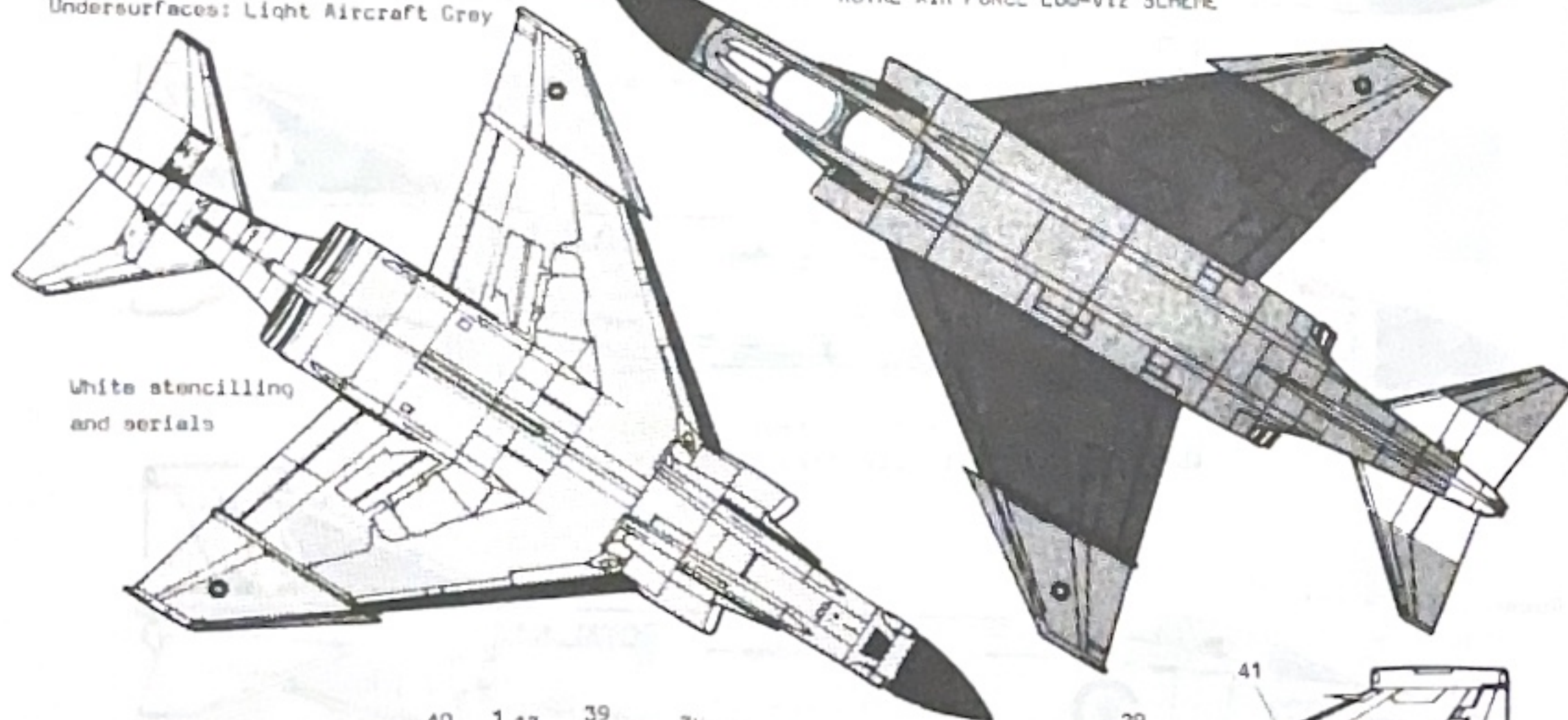

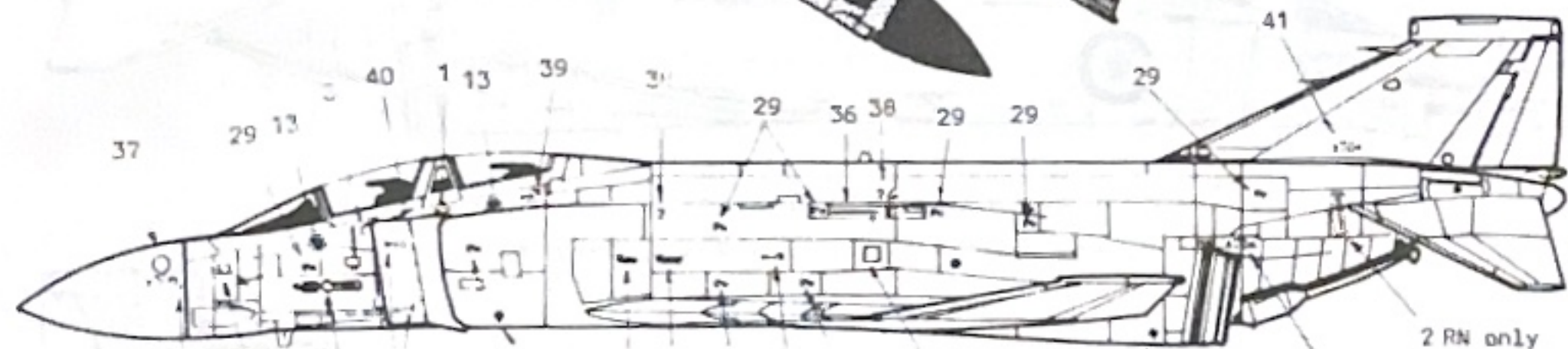

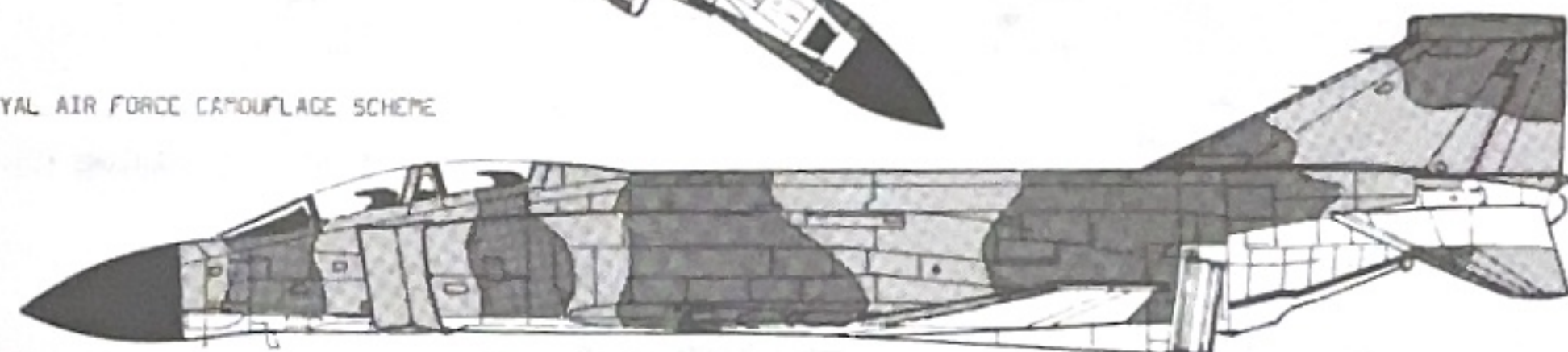

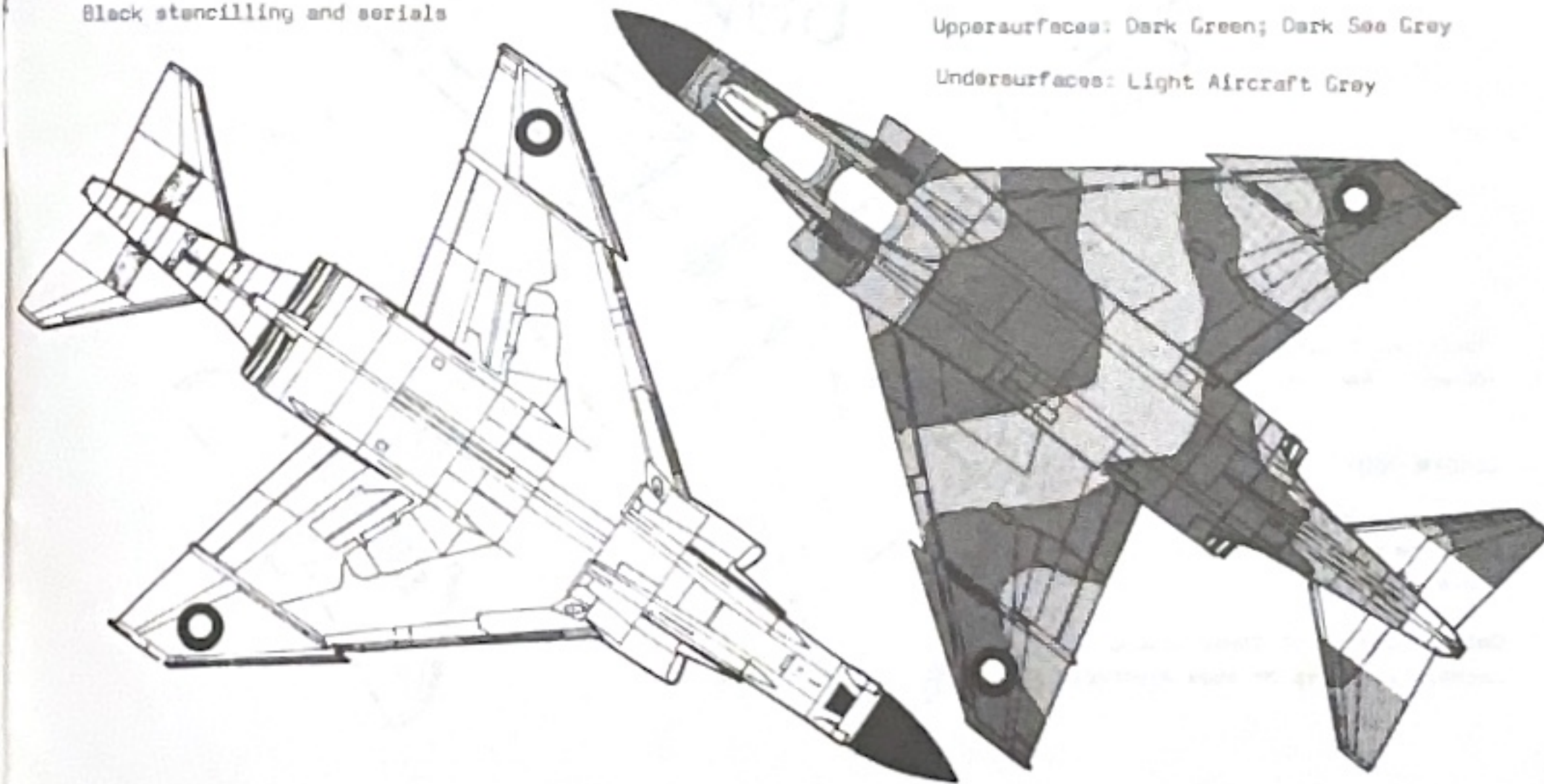
ROYAL AIR FORCE CAMOUFLAGE SCHEME



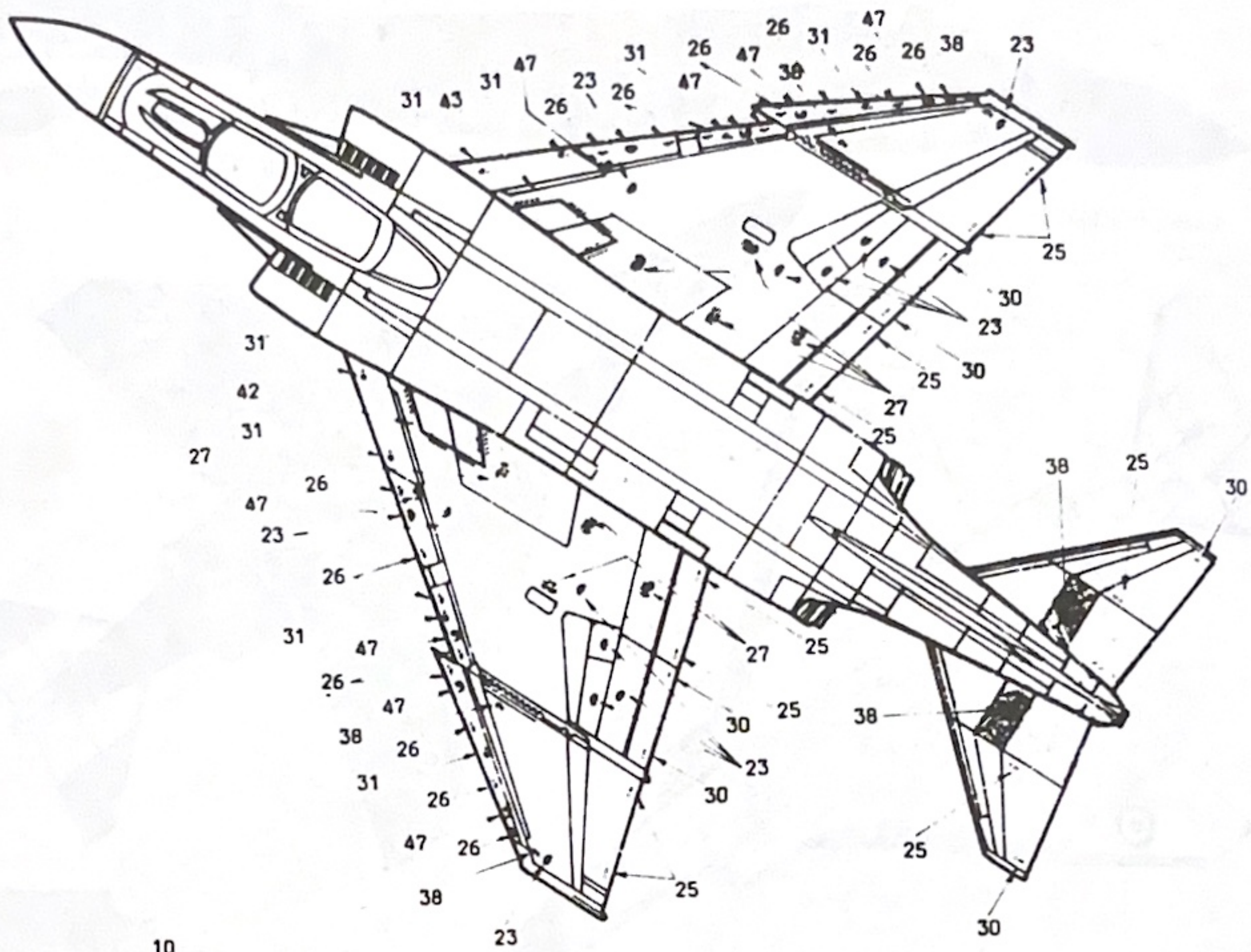

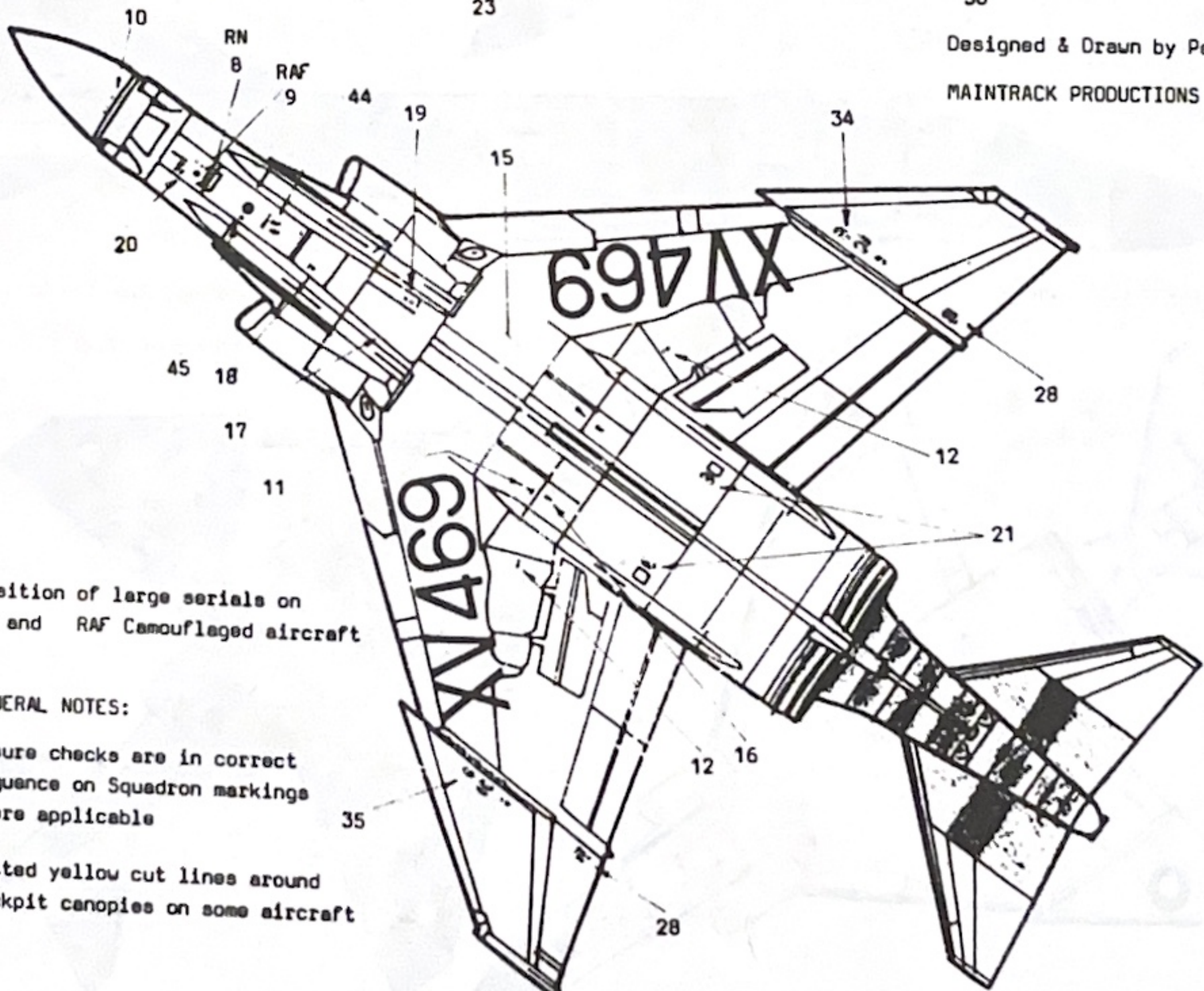
