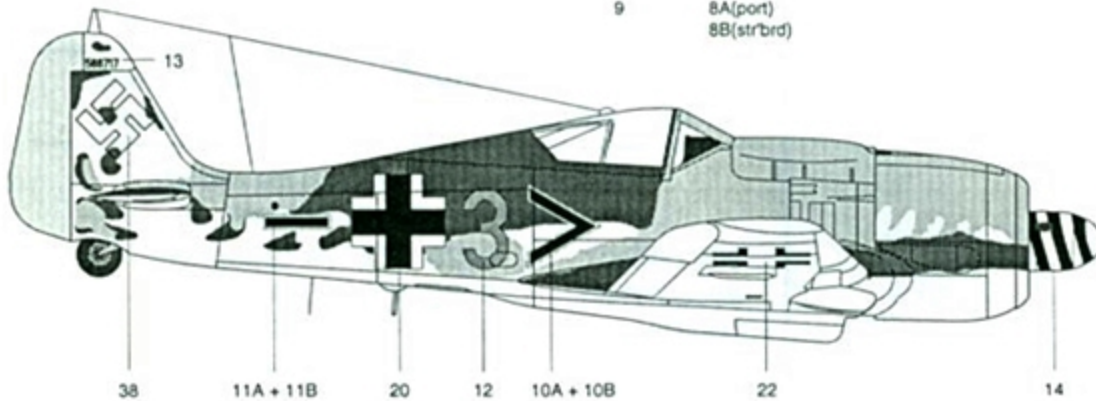
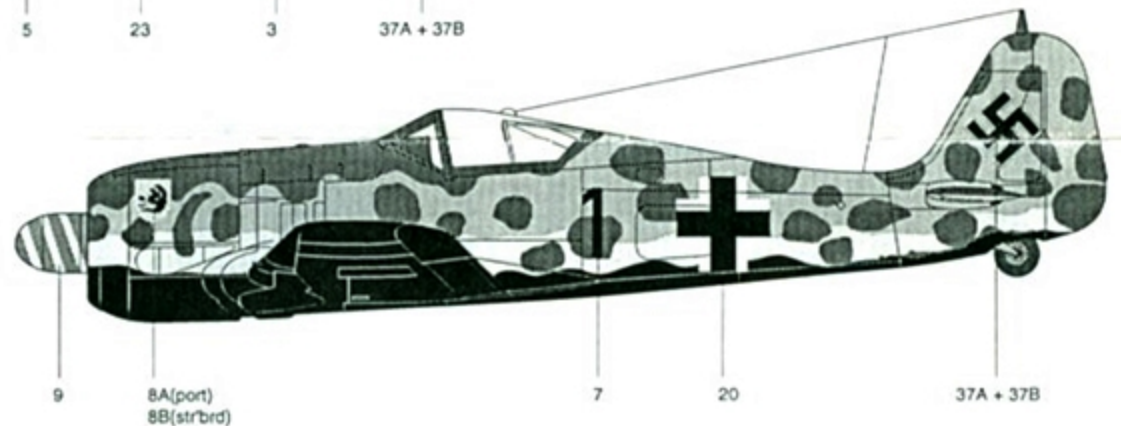
Note: 1. Decal spirals may need to be trimmed slightly to improve fit.

Fw190A-8, KG51, Bad Abling, Germany, 1945. RLM 81/82/76 camouflage with Green 25 spinner.



Fw190A-8, II/JG11, Kastrup, Denmark, 1945. RLM 81/82/76 camouflage. Propeller spinner black with white spiral. Tail assembly camouflage (probably a replacement unit) is RLM 74/75/76.

Fw190A-6, JG300 "Wilde Sau", Geschwader Kommodore, Maj. Hajo Herrmann, Summer, Germany, 1945. RLM 74/75/76 camouflage. Red propeller spinner with yellow spiral. Undersurface was painted black.



Fw190A-8, W. Nr. 588717, Stab II Gruppe, 1945. RLM 81/82/76 camouflage. Yellow rudder and black propeller spinner with white spiral. Lower wheel cover parts of main gear covers are missing.

Fw190A-8, W. Nr. and unit unknown, 1945. RLM 81/82/76 camouflage. Yellow stripe around middle section of cowling and yellow rudder. Black propeller spinner with white spiral.
