BAC Canberra B.2

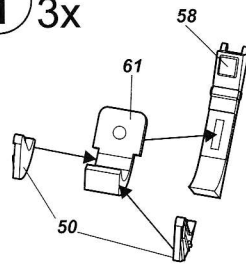
