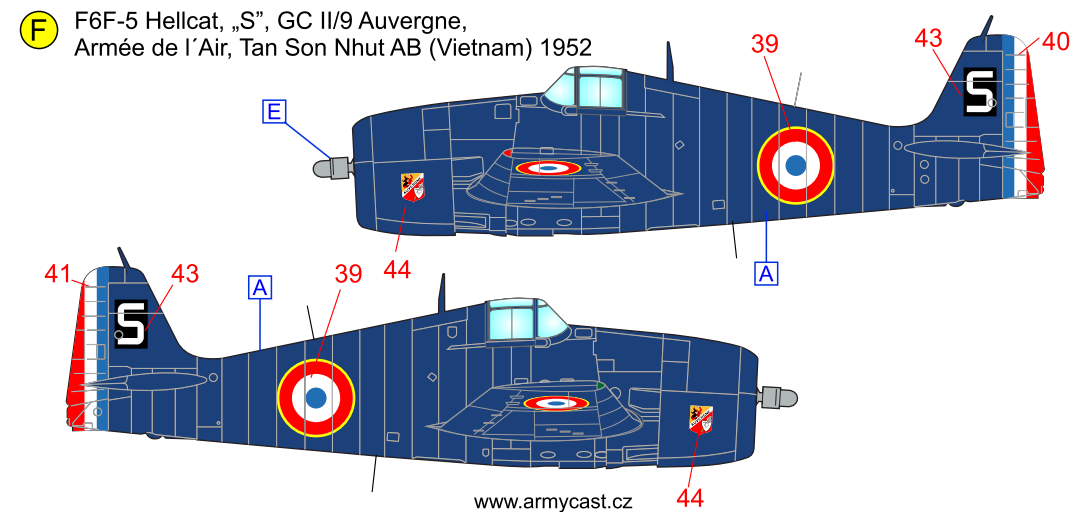
D F6F-5 Hellcat (early version), LTN Robert Benteley, VOF- 1, USS Tulagi, operation Dragoon - D Day, August 1944



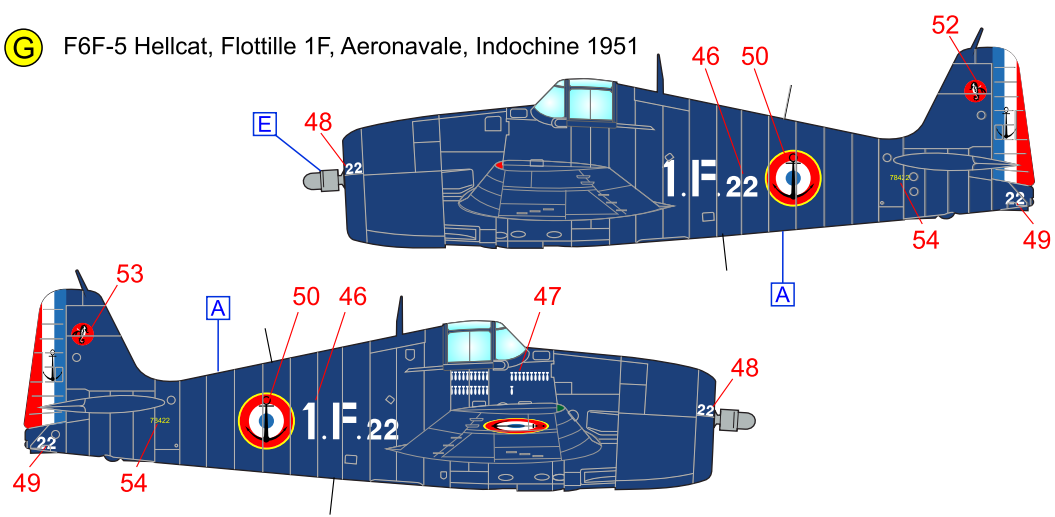
E F6F-5 Hellcat , „White 216”, CVL-26, USS Monterey, 1953



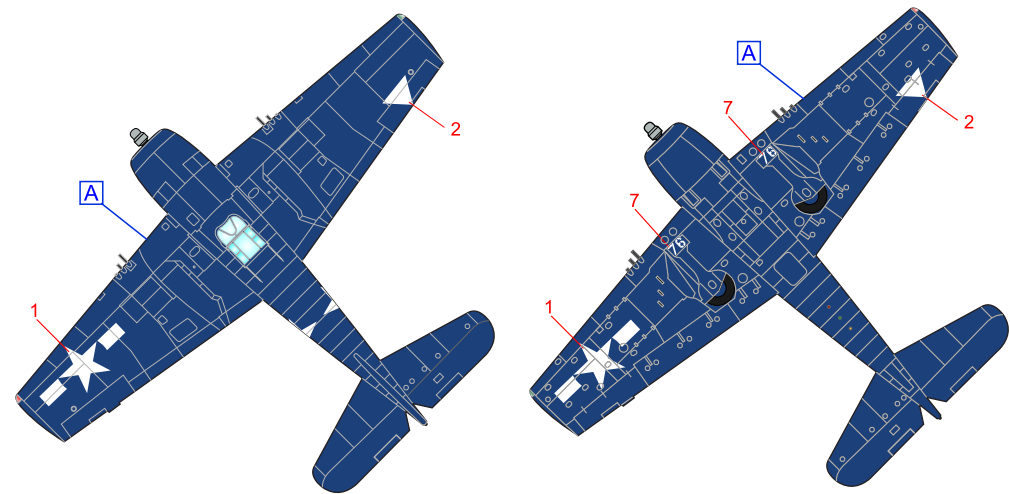
