"No-Cut" P-51B/C replacement fuselage with field-applied fin fillet for the Tamiya P-51B/C

This one is 'bout as simple as it gets! This Loon Models "No-Cut" conversion is a straight replacement for the Tamiya P-51B/C fuselage to make a P-51B or P-51C with the retro-fitted fin fillet. With this conversion you'll be able to accurately and simply model famous aircraft such as Bonnie B flown by Donald M. Beerbower or 'Jackie' from the 353rd Fighter Group.

Before assembling your model, carefully wash the resin parts in soapy water, rinse and allow them to dry. Give the mating surfaces a VERY light sanding to remove flash and any molding pips that may remain. Inspect the rest of the edges of the resin parts for flash concentrating on the wingroot and radiator/oil cooler area. Lightly sand to remove any remaining flash.

As always, test fit! When you're satisfied that everything is in order, the Loon fuselage may be assembled just as the Tamiya original would be. Of course, the resin must be bonded with either cyanoacrylate glue or epoxy.

Finish as you would any other model!
