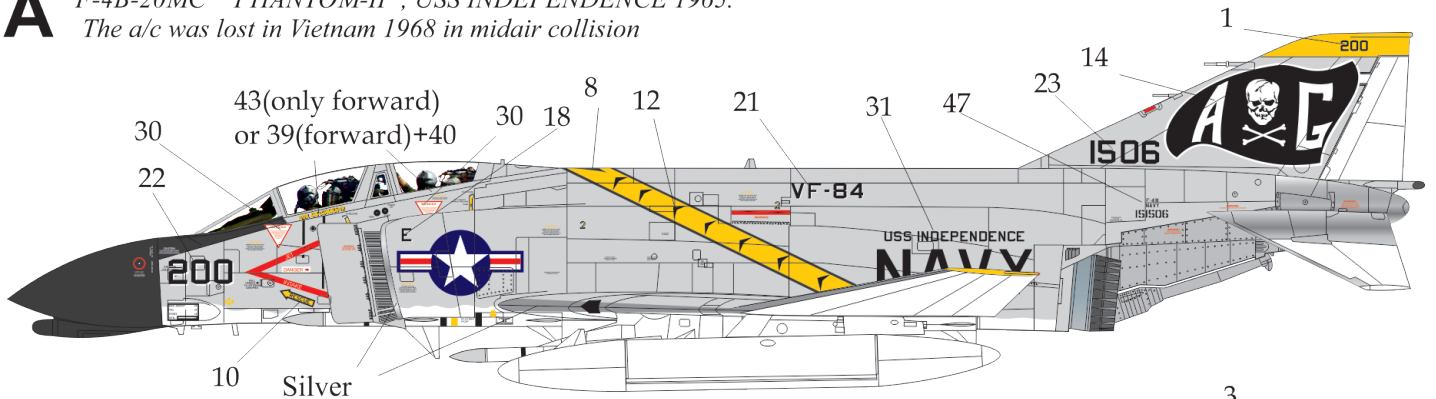


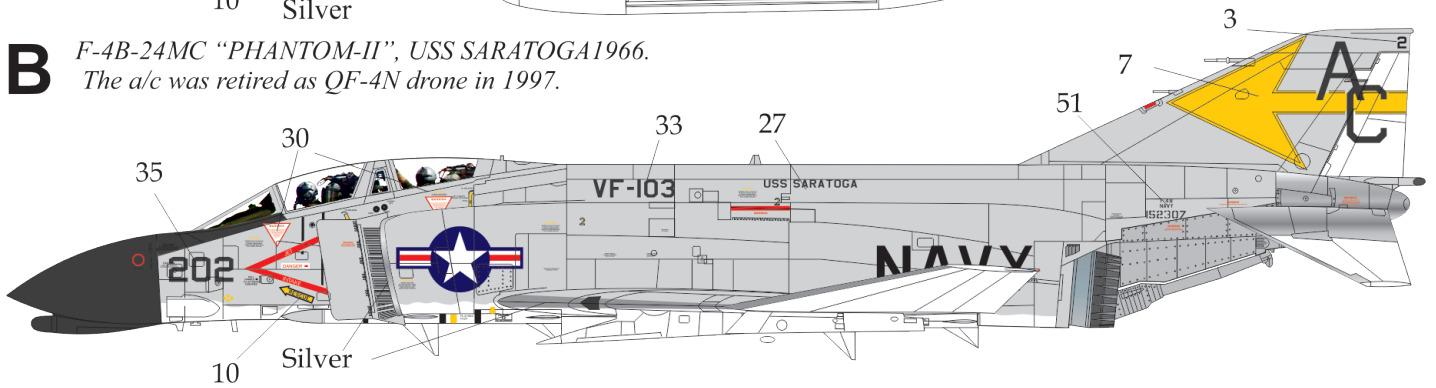


F-4B "Phantom-II" VF-21/84/103

The a/c was lost in Vietnam 1968 in midair collision



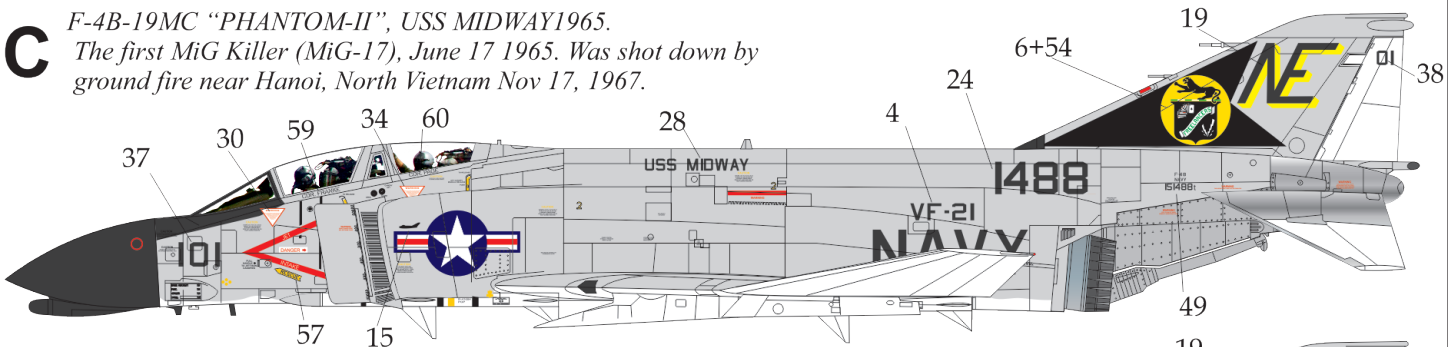
B F-4B-24MC "PHANTOM-II", USS SARATOGA 1966.
The a/c was retired as QF-4N drone in 1997.



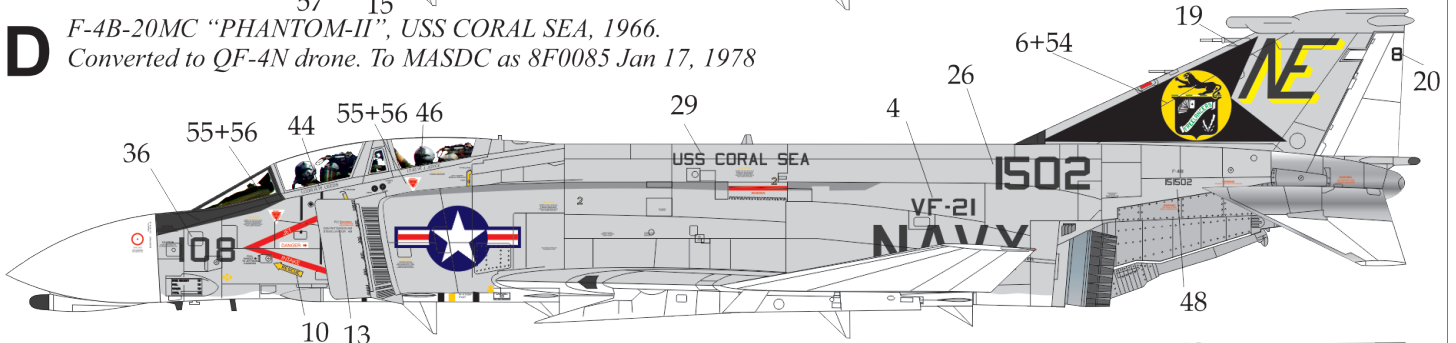

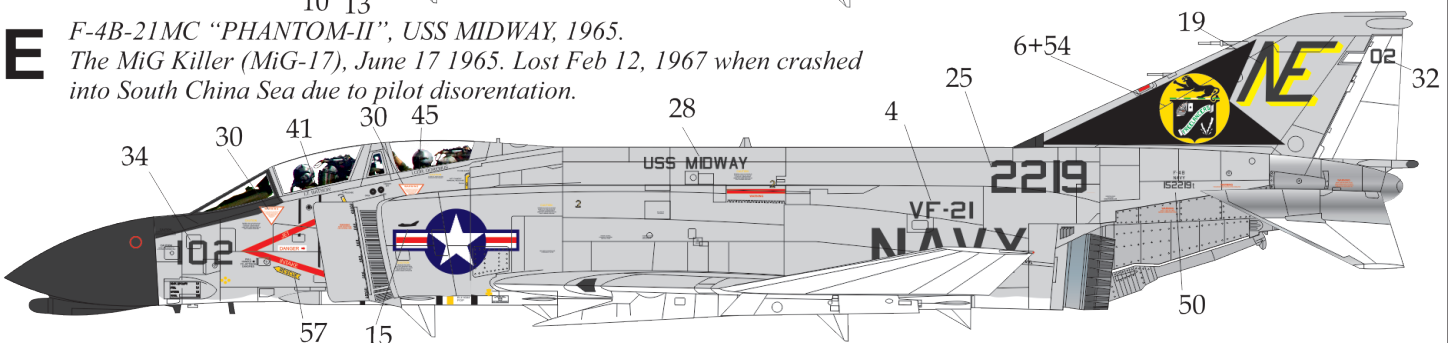
C F-4B-19MC "PHANTOM-II", USS MIDWAY 1965.
The first MiG Killer (MiG-17), June 17 1965. Was shot down by ground fire near Hanoi, North Vietnam Nov 17, 1967.

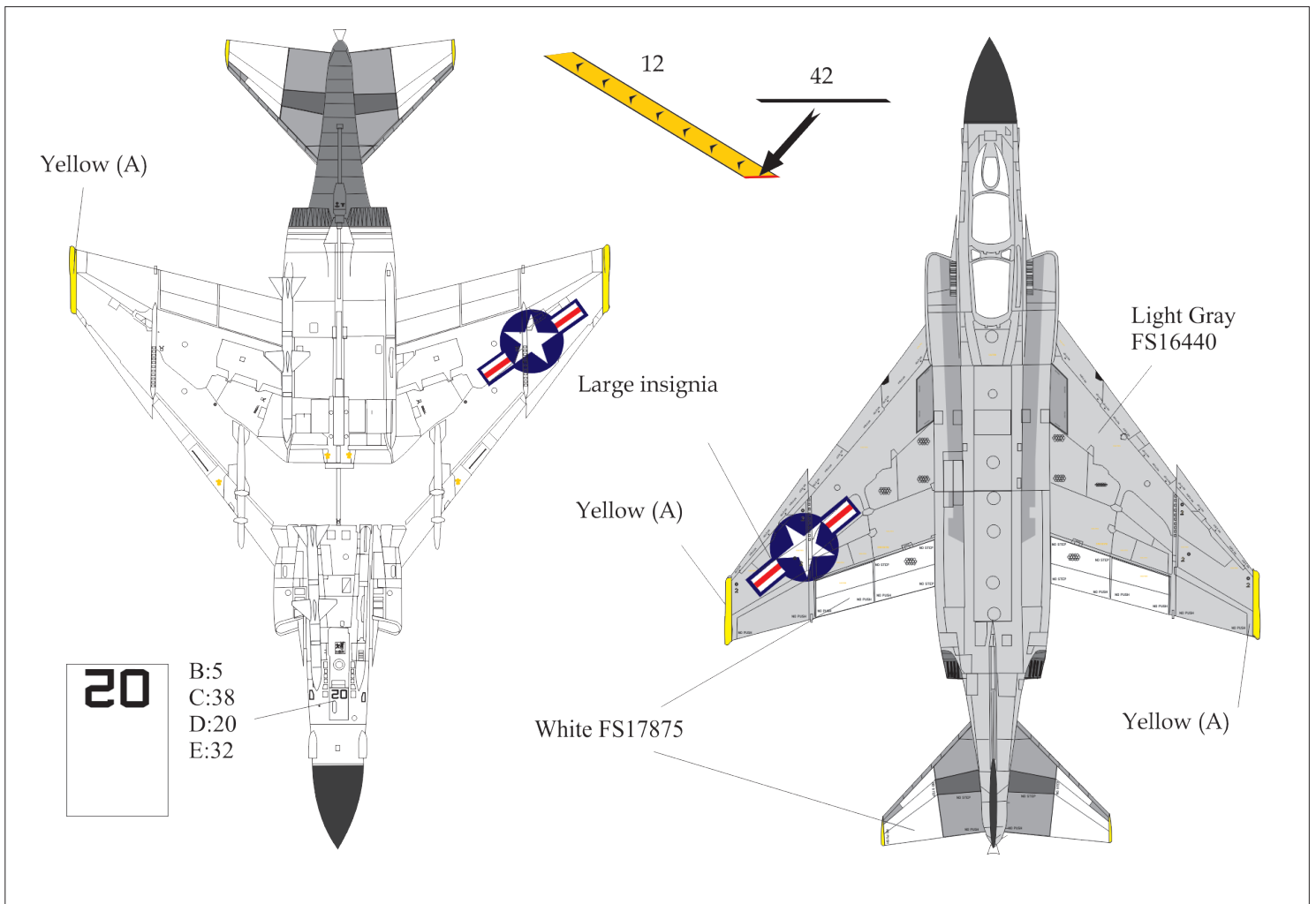


D F-4B-20MC "PHANTOM-II", USS CORAL SEA, 1966.
Converted to QF-4N drone. To MASDC as 8F0085 Jan 17, 1978



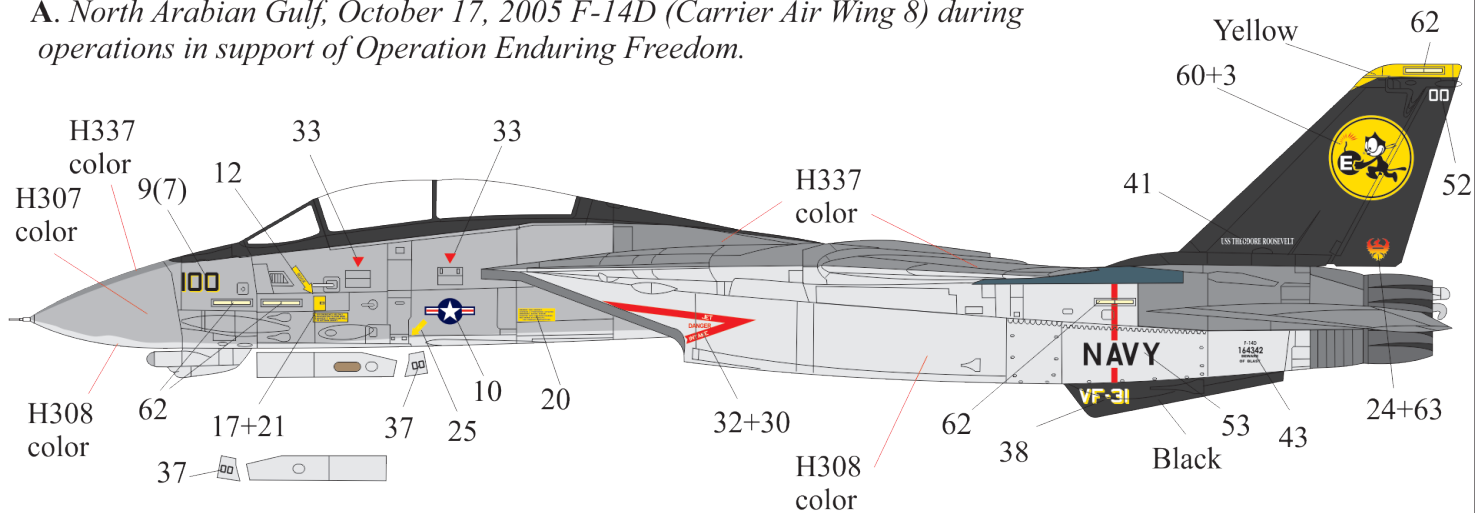
E F-4B-21MC "PHANTOM-II", USS MIDWAY, 1965.
