Samolot myśliwski, będący eksportową odmianą wersji P.11a, opracowany pod kierownictwem inż. Wsiewołoda Jakimiuka jako rozwinięcie samolotu P.6 konstrukcji inż. Zygmunta Puławskiego.

Już w połowie 1932 r. francuska wytwórnia silników Gnome-Rhône wyraziła zainteresowanie wyposażeniem obiecującej konstrukcji P.11 w swój silnik, licząc na zamówienia eksportowe. Jeszcze w tym samym roku prototyp P.11/IV z silnikiem Gnome-Rhône 9Kcr Mistral o mocy 550 KM został zaprezentowany w barwach polskiego lotnictwa wojskowego na Międzynarodowym Salonie Lotniczym w Paryżu. Wzbudził zainteresowanie sił powietrznych Turcji, Rumunii, Portugalii, Grecji, Szwecji, Czechosłowacji, Japonii i Jugosławii.

Kilka z tych krajów zdecydowało się na zakup późniejszej wersji samolotu P.24, natomiast Rumunia zamówiła wersję samolotu P.11 wyposażoną w silnik GR 9Krsd produkowany w Rumunii na licencji. Tak napędzany samolot otrzymał oznaczenie P.11b. Ponieważ strona rumuńska wymagała bardzo szybkiego terminu dostawy gotowych maszyn, zakłady PZL rozpoczęły ich produkcję przed wariantem P.11a dla lotnictwa polskiego. Aby przyspieszyć prace, wykorzystano część rozwiązań konstrukcyjnych (skrzydło) z poprzedniego typu myśliwca, PZL P.7a. Zamówienie, opiewające na 50 sztuk płatowców, zrealizowano na przełomie lat 1933-34.

Do dziś nie zachował się żaden egzemplarz myśliwca P.11b.

Fighter plane, an export version of P.11a, designed under inż. Wsiewołod Jakimiuks supervision as a development of inż. Zygmunt Puławski's P.6 construction.

Already in mid 1932 French engine manufacturer Gnome-Rhône expressed interest in equipping P.11 construction with their engine, counting on export orders. In the same year the prototype – P.11/IV with Gnome-Rhône 9Kcr Mistral 550 hp engine was presented in Polish Airforce colors on the International Air Exhibition. It aroused interest of Turkish, Romanian, Portugese, Greek, Swedish, Czechoslovak, Japanese and Yugoslavian airforces.

Several of these countries decided to purchase the subsequent P.24 version of the plane, only Romania ordered the P.11 version equipped with GR 9Krsd produced in Romania under licence. Plane with such propulsion was named P.11b. Because of the Romanian side demand to deliver the planes on short notice PZL factory started their production even before the P.11a for Polish Airforce. To speed up the works some of the structural solutions (the wing) from previous project – PZL P.7a were used. The order for 50 planes was delivered at the turn of 1933 and 34.

No P.11b plane survived until this day.

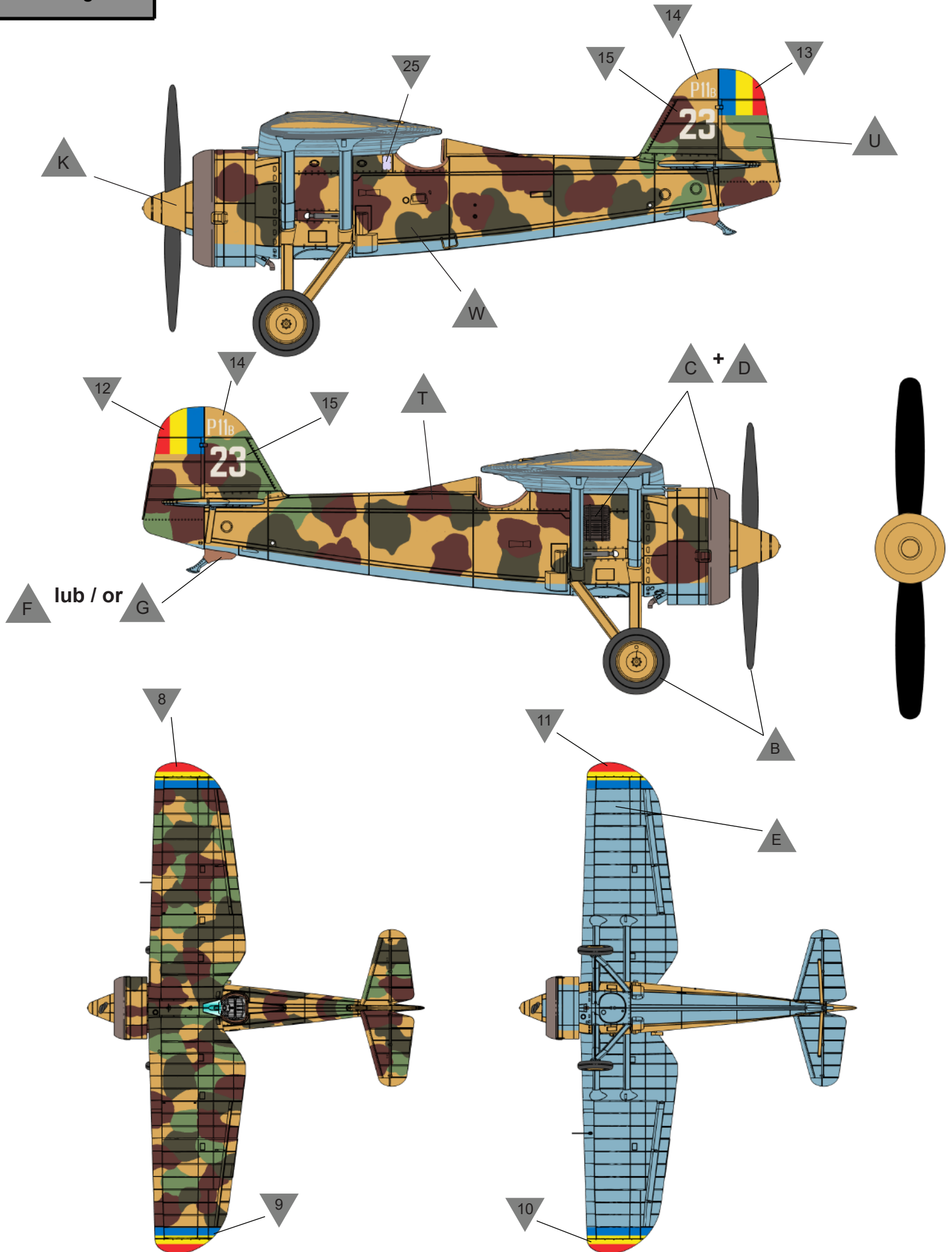
