





Boston III A28-16 R 'Indoor Sport' No.22 Sqd. Port Moresby 1942.


Boston III A28-8 J for 'Jessica' 22 Sqd. 1942. Also DU.J Goodenough Island 1943. 'Jessica' can be made in the above scheme or with DU.J in the 'Indoor Sport scheme. The early coding of Boston III aircraft can be made by deleting the DU code and placing the last letter the same as 'Jessica'. This can be done with all Boston III aircraft. 'Jessica' is currently being restored at RAAF Amberley.



Placement of the 'SHES APPLES' decal.

The top corner of the D covers the bottom half of the ES in APPLES.

The FIRE EXTINGUISHER decal is positioned under the elliptical window.

Recommended kit

1/72 Scale Matchbox Revell Conversion by Plane Bits

1/48 Scale AMT

Decal Application

Cut around the required design.

2. Soak in luke warm water for 3-4 seconds.

3. Stand the decal on facial tissue.

4. Moisten the application with plenty of water.
5. Apply decal by carefully sliding off the backing paper.
6. Use decal setting agent to nestle decal around body detail.
7. Paint model with clear laquer to hide decal film.

NB: Decals adhere best to gloss surfaces. This decal film is very thin and will need extra care in application. We suggest using a small paint brush and tweezers when doing Step No.5.
