

There is photographic evidence with the Rudder of the aircraft missing the Green Camouflage which indicates that the Rudder may have been replaced at some stage during it's service life. The original Trim Tab seems to have been replaced though. (See extra Tail Section Diagram above)

None of the featured aircraft carried Underwing Roundels which was the standard for RAAF Mosquitos serving in the SWPA.
