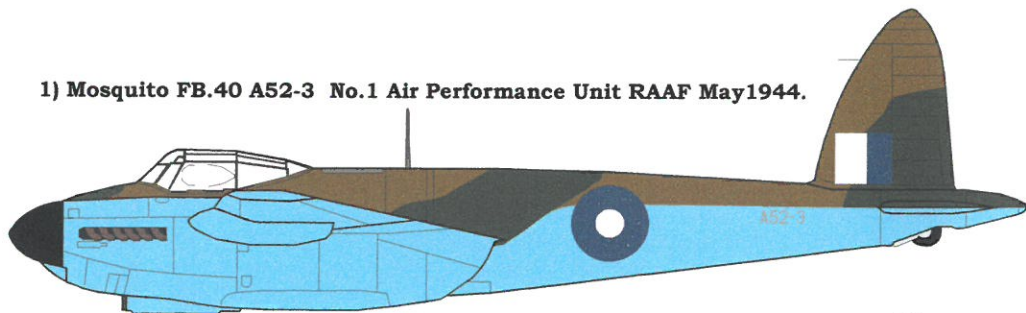


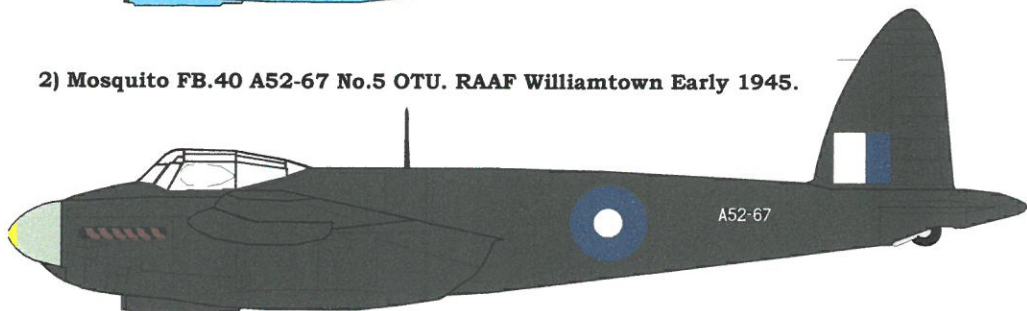

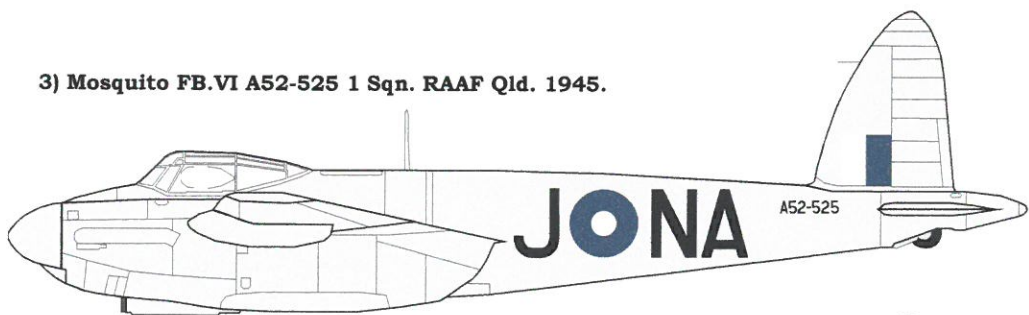
1) Mosquito FB.40 A52-3 No.1 Air Performance Unit RAAF May1944.



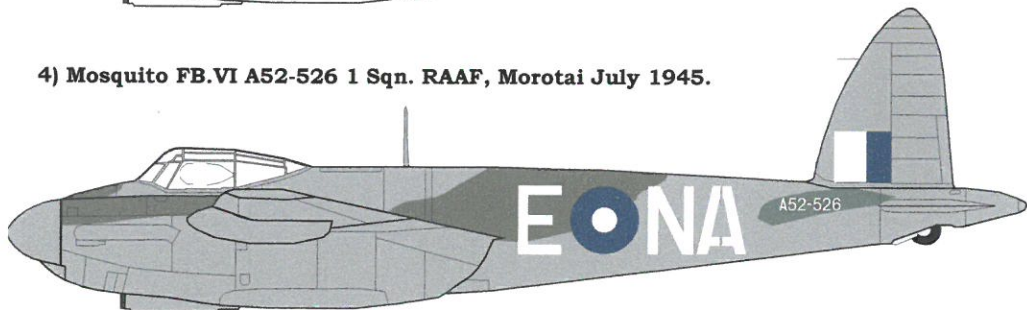
2) Mosquito FB.40 A52-67 No.5 OTU. RAAF Williamtown Early 1945.



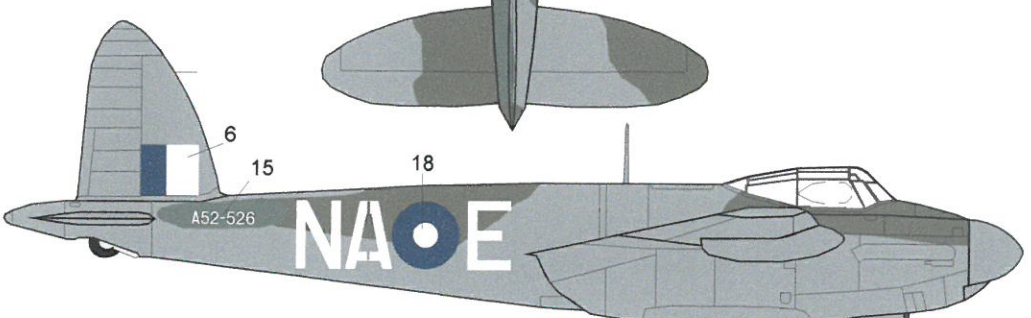
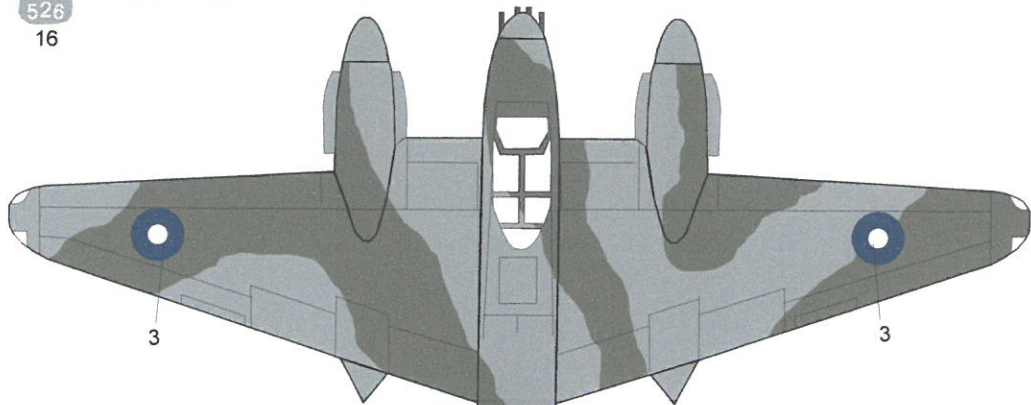
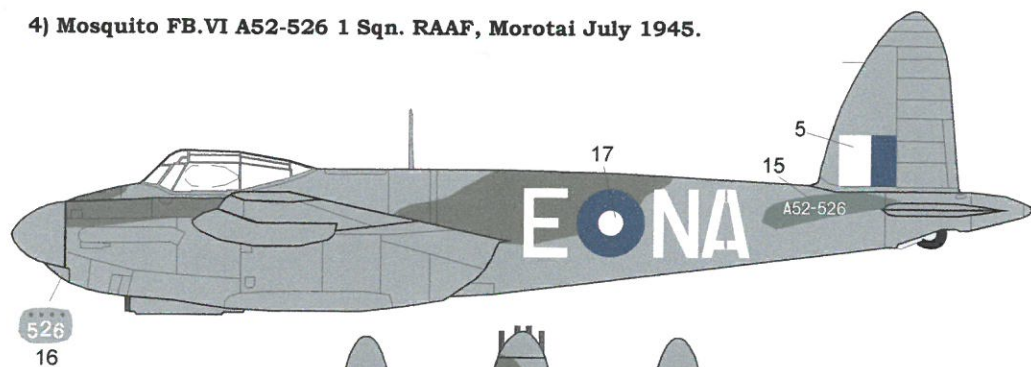

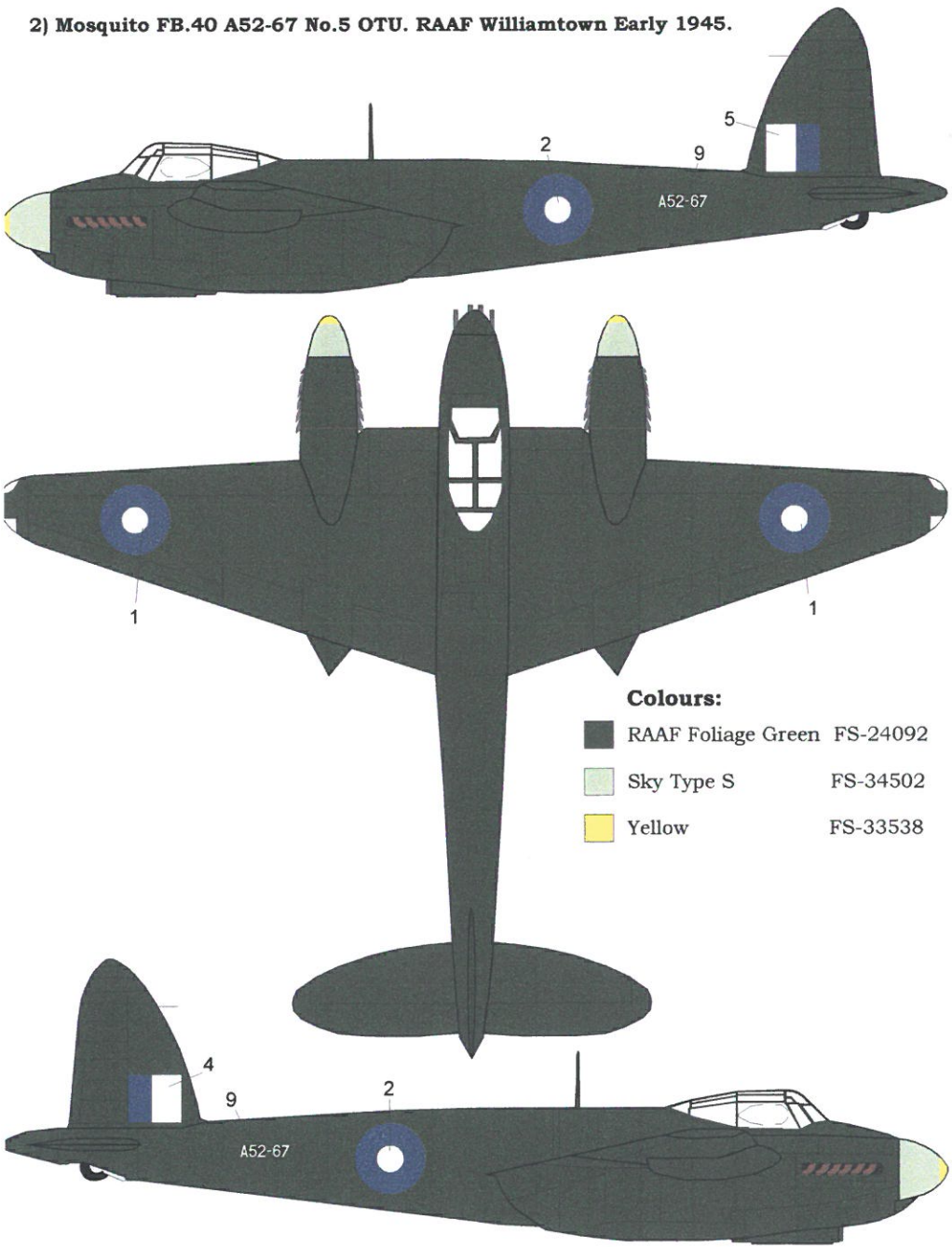

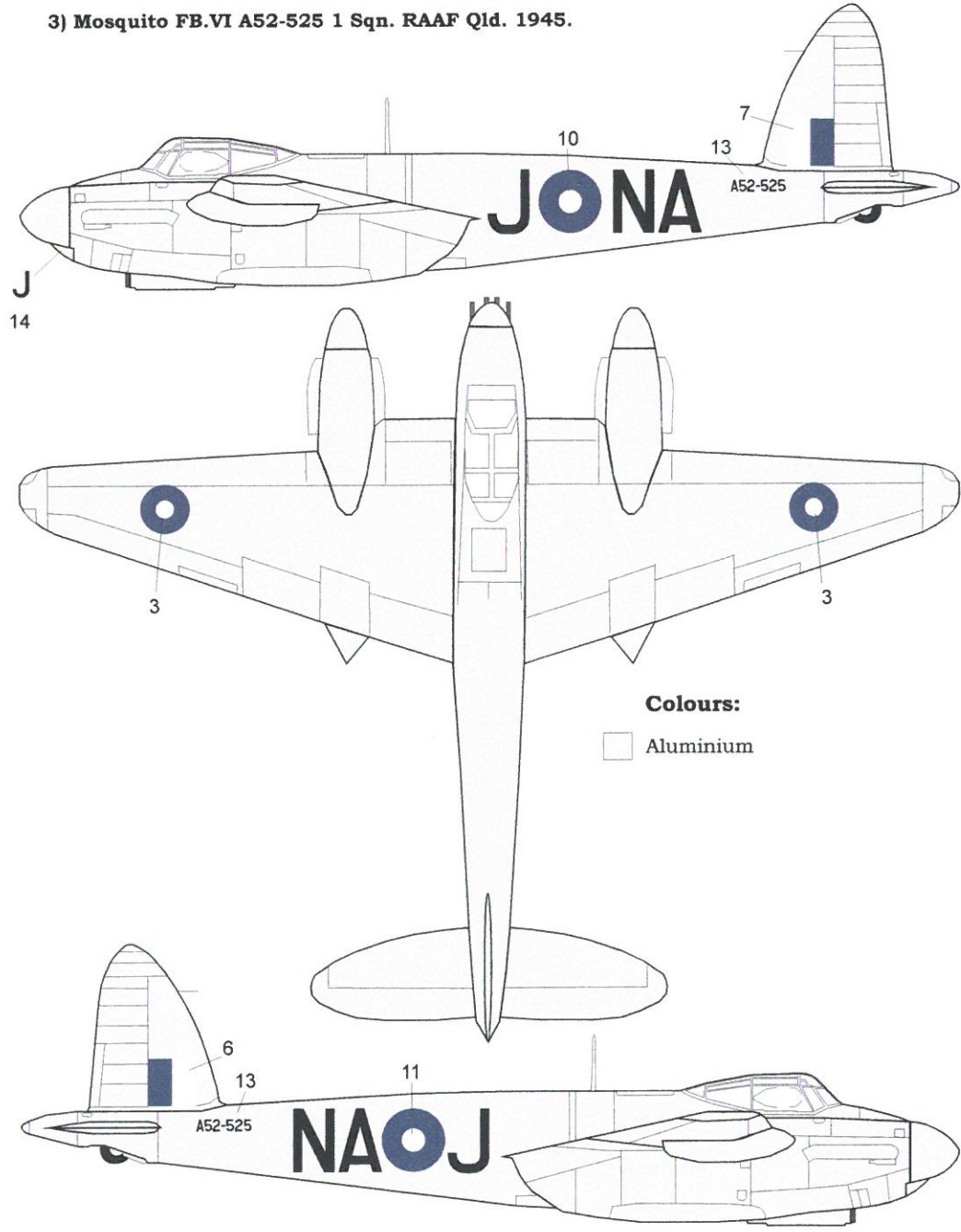
