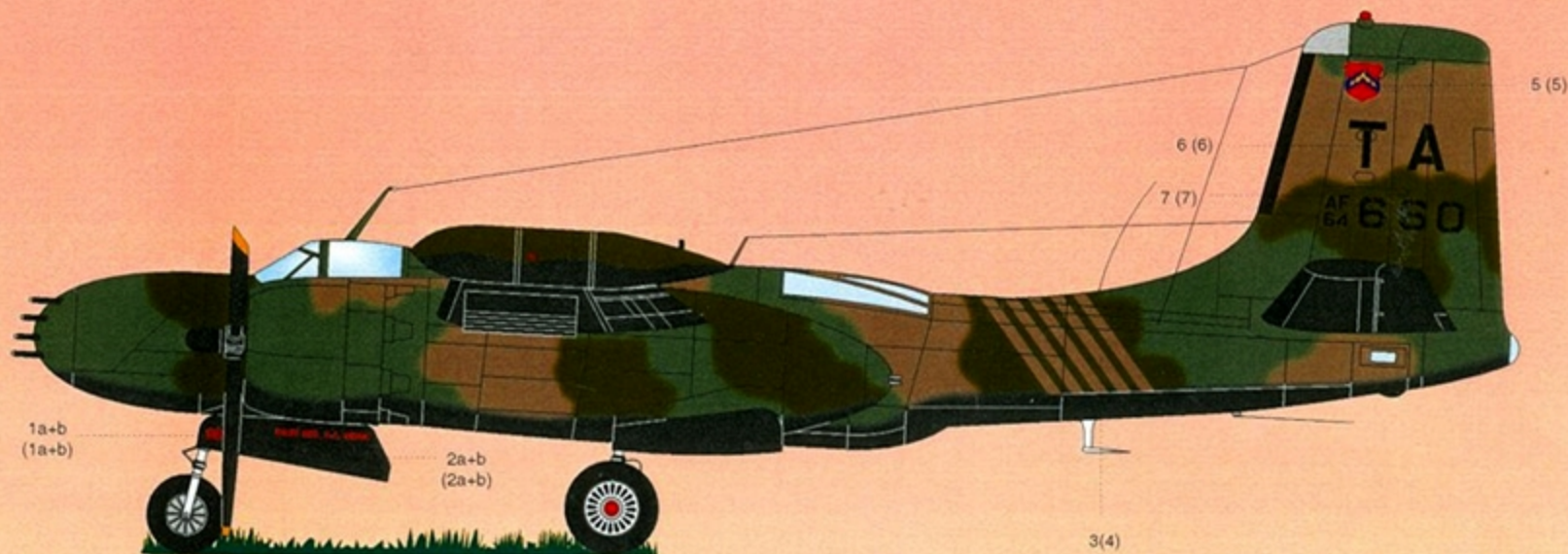

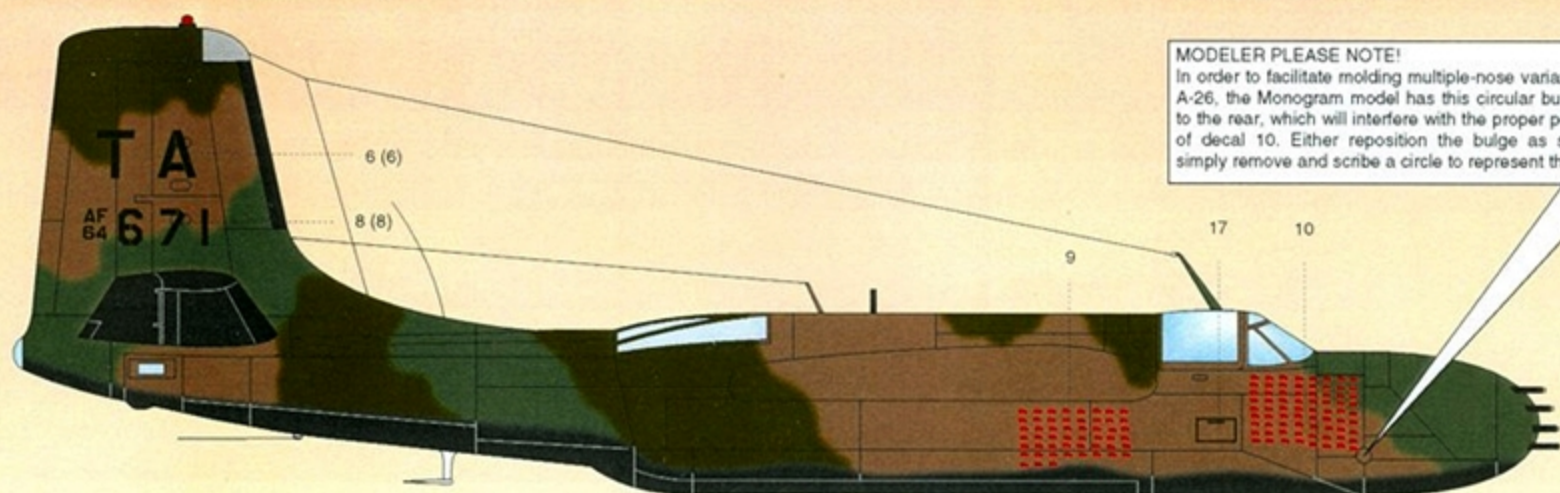

AIRCRAFT 1 • Douglas (On Mark) B-26K 64-17660, 609th Special Operations Squadron, Nakhon Phanom, 1969. Aircraft flown by Squadron Commander, Colonel E. J. White. Standard SEA Green 34102/Green 34097/Tan 30219 uppersurfaces with Black undersides. Note gray fin tip, black propeller spinners and red hubs on all wheels. No national insignias were carried on this aircraft.

AIRCRAFT 2 • Douglas (On Mark) B-26K 64-17671, 609th Special Operations Squadron, Nakhon Phanom, 1968. Standard SEA Green 34102/Green 34097/Tan 30219 uppersurfaces with Black undersides. Aircraft had gray fin tip, black propeller spinners and red hubs on all wheels. No national insignias were carried on this aircraft.

AIRCRAFT 3 • Douglas (On Mark) B-26K 64-17649, "Nother Trucker", 609th Special Operations Squadron, Nakhon Phanom, November 1967. Standard SEA Green 34102/Green 34097/Tan 30219 uppersurfaces with Black undersides. Note gray fin tip, black propeller spinners and red hubs on all wheels. No national insignias were carried on this aircraft.



MODELER PLEASE NOTE!

In order to facilitate molding multiple-nose variants of the A-26, the Monogram model has this circular bulge offset to the rear, which will interfere with the proper positioning of decal 10. Either reposition the bulge as shown or simply remove and scribe a circle to represent the bulge.
