This soviet truck was a simplified version of the AMO-3/ZiS-5 multipurpose vehicle, based on the components of the U.S.-made Autocar Dispatch SA truck. It had a load capacity of 3,000 kilograms. The Cyrillic letter "B" (pronounced as V) in the vehicle index stands for "voenny" ("military"). However, it refers to the war-time period of manufacture, when fewer and simpler parts were used for higher costeffectiveness, rather than a specific set of military equipment.

In October 1941, the ZiS-5 production line was moved to the Ural region. Initially, the trucks were manufactured in Ulyanovsk, and later in Miass, both subject to severe austerity measures. The truck's design was significantly modified, for instance the shape of the fenders was altered to rule out press forging. Front brakes, engine pan protection, and metal cabin step covers were discarded. A single headlight was often installed, and there was no horn. The original cabin was replaced with a structure made from wooden planks, and the cargo platform was simplified, with only swing tailgate left.

By the summer of 1942, when the capture of Moscow did not seem such a dire threat anymore, the assembly and repair of ZiS-5 trucks was partially resumed at the Moscow plant. ZiS-5B trucks made by different factories during various production phases would often have major distinctions. The wheels of ZiS-5 were the same as those of American trucks, which is why the military variants were equipped with lend-lease Firestone tires with a "chevron" tread pattern.

The ZiS-5B was produced at the ZiS factory from 1942 to 1946 (126,215 units, of which 66,900 during the war years), at the Ulyanovsk ZiS factory from 1942 to 1944 (10,400 units), and at the Ural ZiS factory from 1944 to 1947 (8,500 during the war years). A total of 84,100 units were produced during the war.
