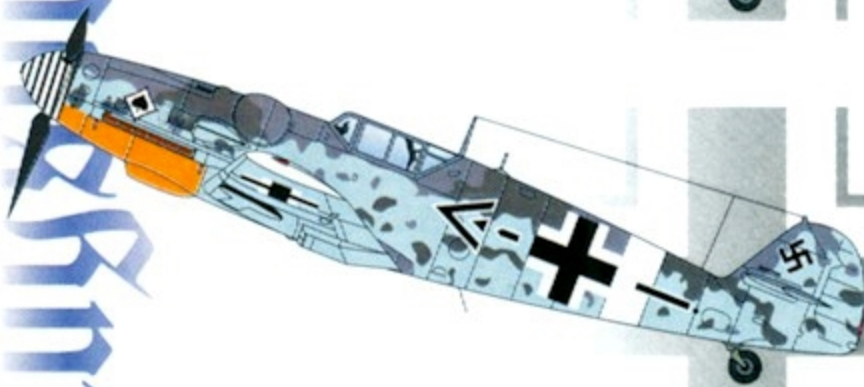

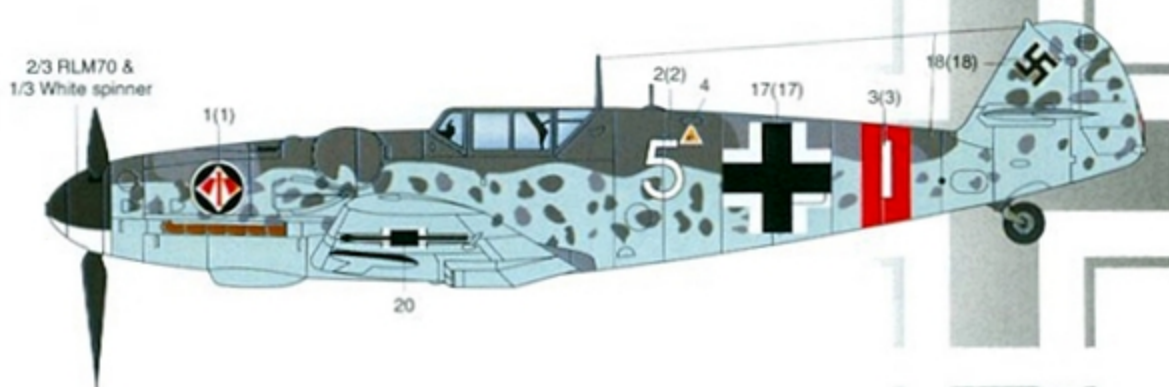

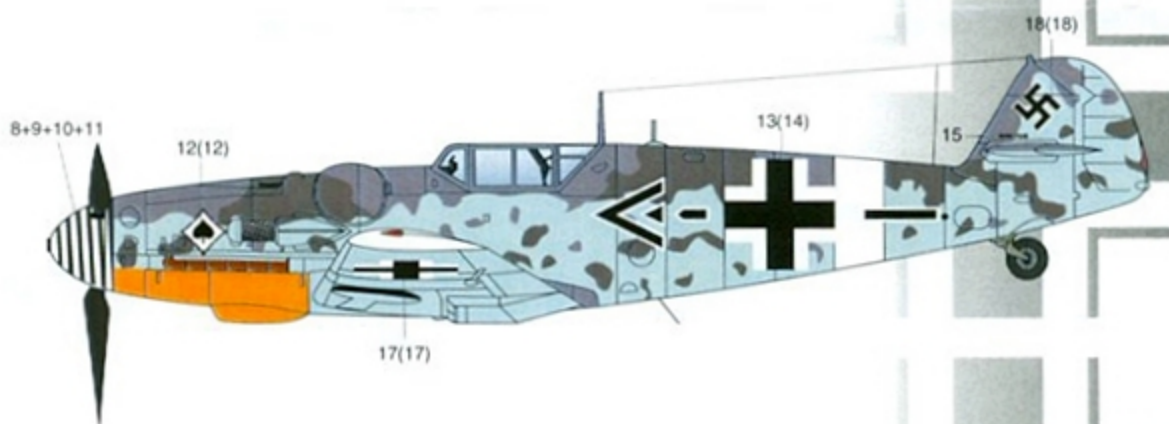

Bf109G-6, 7/JG1, Holland, early 1944.
Standard RLM 74/75/76 Gray camouflage. 2/3 RLM 70, 1/3 White spinner. Red fuselage band.

Bf109G-6, 2/JG302, October 1944.
Late-war RLM 81A (or 71)/82/84 camouflage with nose band, fuselage band RLM 04 Yellow and rudder RLM 27 pale Yellow.

Bf109 6-6/R-6 July 1943 Staff Squadron of JG53. Airfield Vibo Valentia. Bf109 G-6/R6 tropical in standard RLM 74/75/76 scheme. White fuselage band and lower wing tips. Yellow lower cowling. Spinner/prop in RLM 70. Notice tight White spinner spiral (provided in four pieces) and tropical air filter. No victory markings.
