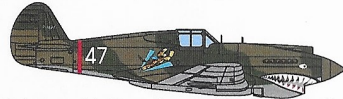
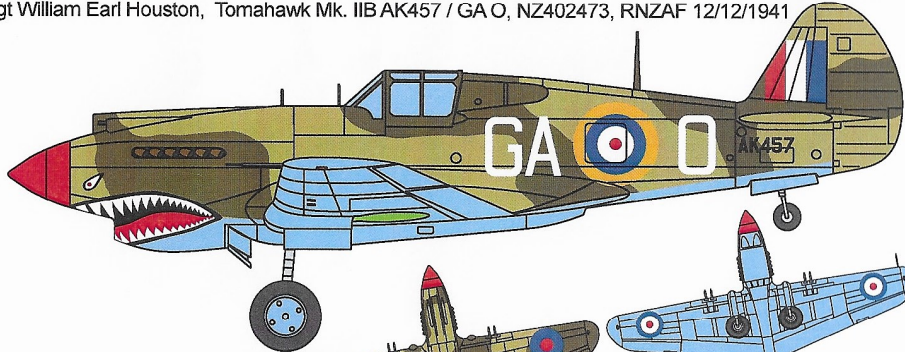

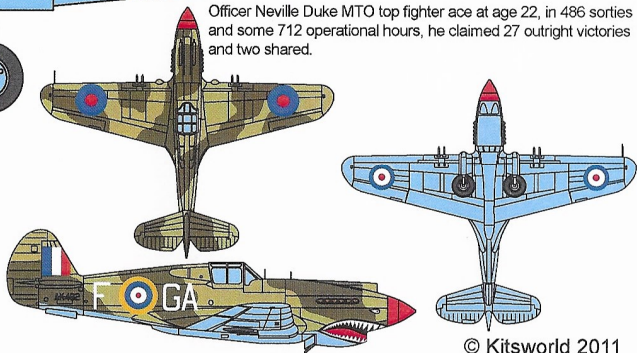
While the RAF used a greenish-blue color called Sky Type S for their fighters, there wasn't any DuPont color that closely matched it. A mid cool gray color was used instead, and this was likely F.S. 16473 Aircraft Gray, which has a very slight blue-green hue to it.

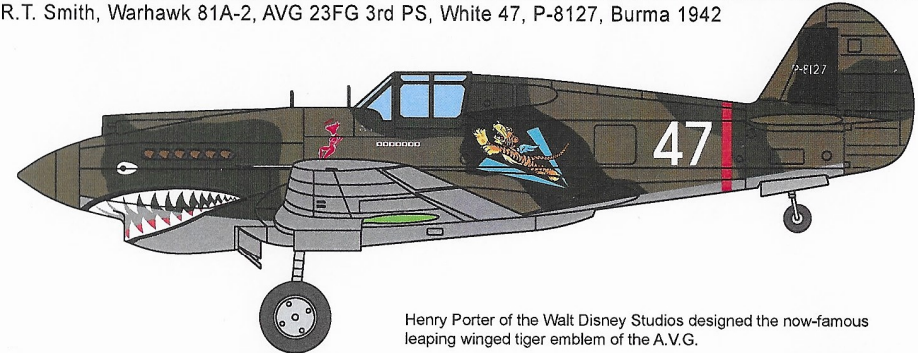

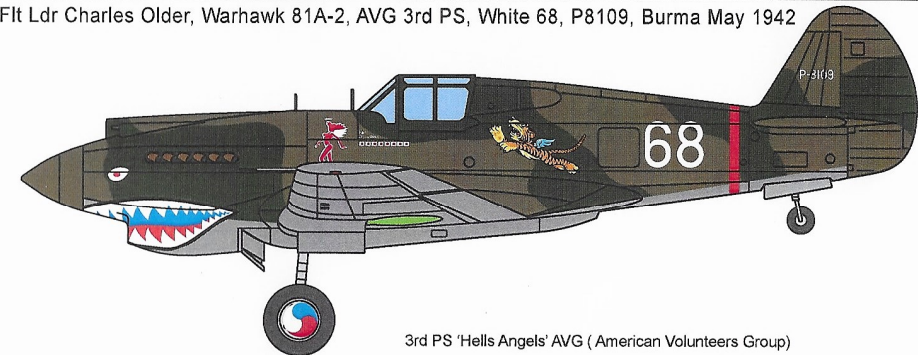

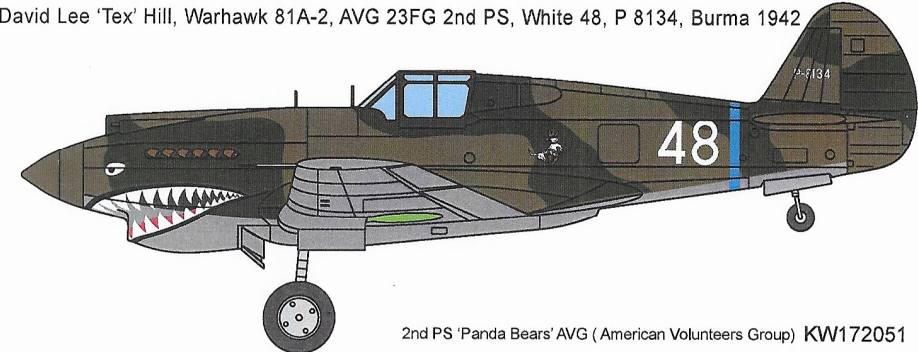
