


1/48 North American Bronco undercarriage instructions for ICM kits



Parts shown are the new parts cast in brass, these are the kit parts that have been assembled, they may need slight bending to insure correct positioning. Small extensions have been added to the brass parts that will allow these parts to be inserted into the slots and hole shown in the photograph below. These small modifications are required to the kit parts. However this allow the undercarriage parts to be added towards the end of the assembly sequence, and will offer more strength to the model. The kit parts are to be added to the brass parts to complete the undercarriage assembly.

It is suggested to do some test runs and fit trials before assembling to much of the model, and PVA glue is ideal for testing positioning and for you to confirm how you will add the undercarriage at the later stage. For final assembly epoxy glue would be recommended but a super glue could also be used.







Pictures show the kit parts attached to the brass, for this PVA glue or super glue is recommended.
