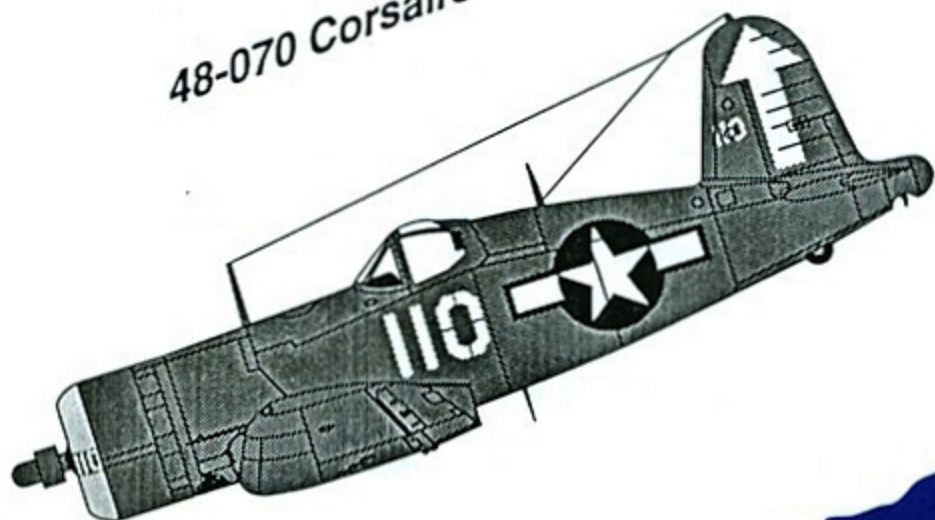

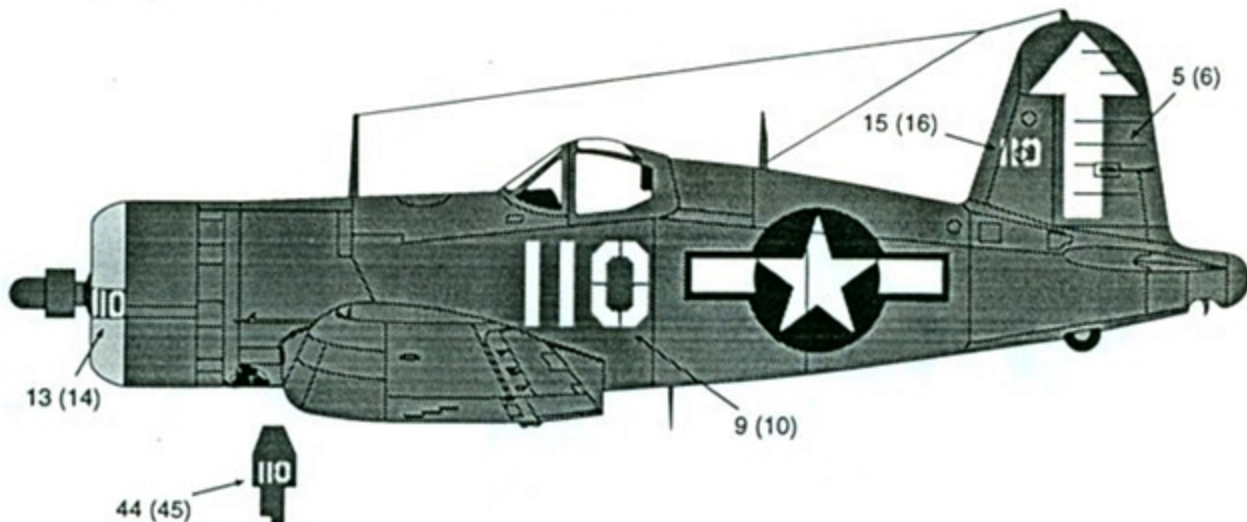

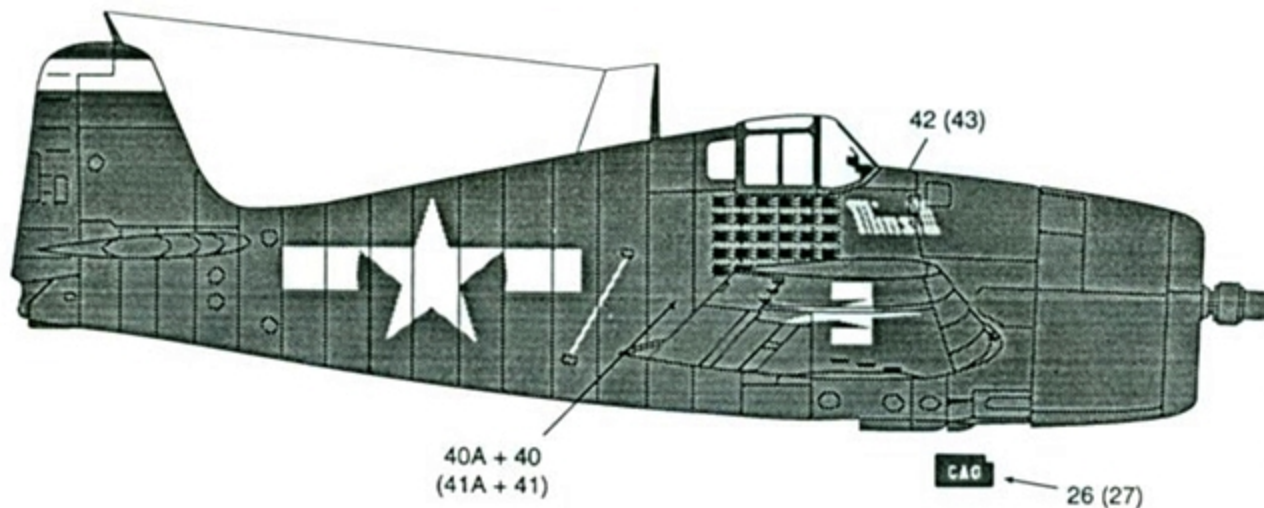
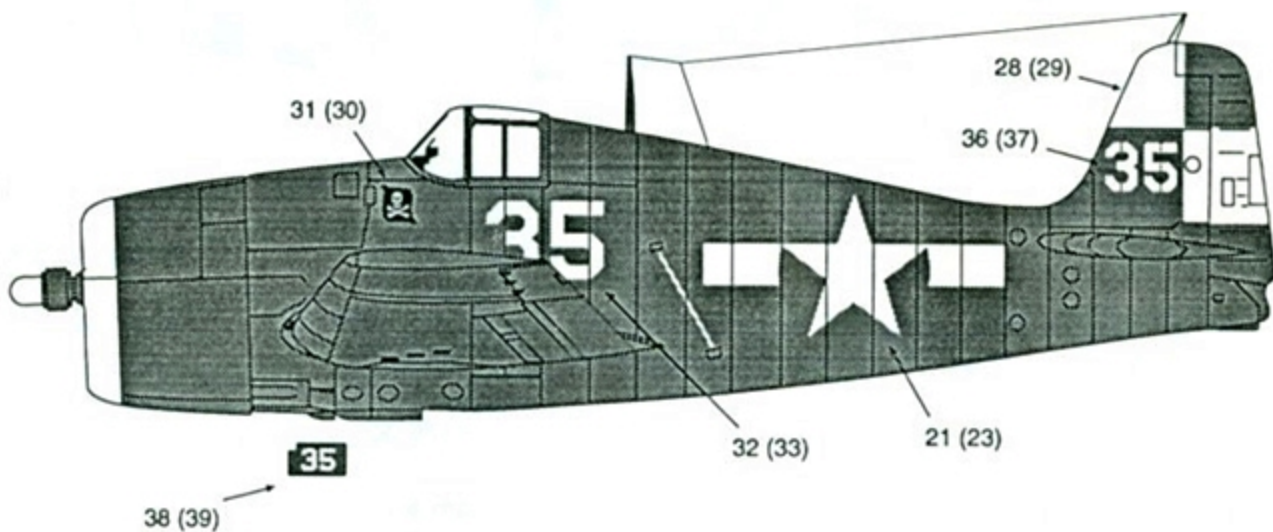

F4U-1D, VF-84, *USS Bunker Hill*, Feb. 1945. Aircraft overall glossy Sea Blue. Prop hub semi-gloss black. Note: front of cowling was painted yellow for operations over the Japanese home islands. Area surrounding number on nose was left glossy Sea Blue.



F4U-1D, VMF 212, MAG 12, Philippine Islands, 1944. Flown by Capt. Paul C. De Long. Aircraft overall glossy Sea Blue. Prop hub aluminum.

F6F-5, VF-17, *USS Hornet*, 1944. Aircraft overall glossy Sea Blue. Prop hub & front of cowling white. Note: cowling was painted white for a short time during the spring of 1944, exact dates are not known.



F6F-5, "Minsi III", Flown by Capt. David McCampbell, Commanding Officer of Carrier Air Wing 15 on the *USS Essex*. Aircraft overall glossy Sea Blue. White stripe on tail. Note: "Minsi III" & kill markings were applied to both sides of aircraft, see ref. 1. Also this aircraft had rear windows like the -3 model.
